**LAST TIME OUT:** Torres started the second to last game of the season for the Lynchburg Hillcats (Low-A). The right-hander went three innings, allowing four runs, four walks and adding one strikeout in a 4-2 loss to the Fredericksburg Nationals. Over 68.2 innings, Torres totaled 73 strikeouts with the Hillcats in 2021.

**TOMMY JOHN:** Torres had Tommy John Surgery and missed the entire 2019 season. “Going through that was very tough, but it was also good for my mental health. This was the first serious injury I’ve had, and absolutely the low point of my career to hear my life was being put on hold.” The rehab process took 12 months which is quicker than the usual 14 to 18 months process. The Guardians organization was “really supportive” and communication often with Torres during his recovery.

**DRAFT DAY WITH DAD:** Lenny Torres Sr. and his son Lenny Torres both shared an emotional moment when he was drafted on June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Torres Sr. told the Poughkeepsie Journal they both “cried a lot, tears of joy.” Torres Sr. commutes an hour and a half from Beacon, NY to Manhattan every day and works as a foreman for a construction company. Torres Sr. taught his son to play baseball and started playing catch with Lenny when he was four years old. “My company understands that if he makes it, every five days I’ll be taking two days off.”

**BEACON BEHIND HIM:** Born and raised in Beacon, NY, Torres pitched for four years with the Blue Demons at Beacon High School. A painting of him and teammate Rafael Figueroa was unveiled in 2019 and still is up along a hallway wall in the school building. Additionally, after being a final cut for the Team USA U18 team in 2017, Beacon residents stormed social media to voice their displeasure.

**ASTHMA:** At four months old, Torres was diagnosed with asthma after a “persistent coughing episode”. He took preventative medication as a toddler and had regular visits with a physician. He still owns an inhaler and occasionally requires it. “They caught it early and did a lot of preventative things that allowed me to play baseball.”
