SHRIMP DROP SERIES FINALE, SETTLE FOR SPLIT

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's offense struggled on Sunday in a 3-1 loss to the Nashville Sounds. Each side scored in the fourth inning, with a **Luke Adams** solo shot in the top of the frame followed by an **Agustín Ramírez** RBI double in the bottom of the inning to equalize. The score remained deadlocked at 1-1 until the eighth, when a double steal with runners on the corners brought in **Cooper Pratt** to put Nashville in front. The Sounds added a run in the ninth on **Eddys Leonard's** home run to set the final margin at 3-1, ensuring a series split between the two clubs.

MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point, however, has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 88 steals in the last 39 games are far and away the most in Triple-A since April 24. Second-place Gwinnett's 68 steals rank as close to 12th-place Sugar Land (48) as they do to the Jumbo Shrimp in first.

SWIPER NO SWIPING!

Jacksonville has recorded a caught stealing in three of the last six and nine of the last 18 contests in which an opponent has attempted a stolen base. This run has helped the club surge to becoming the Triple-A co-leader in runners caught stealing (31) while ranking fourth in caught stealing percentage (28.7 percent). The Jumbo Shrimp also excelled in these categories in 2025, ranking second in caught stealing percentage (27.6 percent) and third in runners caught stealing (56).

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen was strong all of last week during its series against the Nashville Sounds. Jumbo Shrimp relievers combined to work 24.2 innings out of the club's 54.0 frames (45.7 percent). Over the six-game set, Jacksonville relief pitched combined to surrendered only eight runs, all earned, on 16 hits (5.8 H/9) for a 2.92 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 25 strikeouts against 18 walks.

THE PENNANT CHASE

In 2025, Jacksonville overcame an 8.0-game deficit with 17 games to go in the first half to claim the IL's first half title en route to the club's Triple-A National Championship. With 12 games to go in this season's first half, the Jumbo Shrimp trail first-place Rochester by 3.5 games while also needing to vault over Memphis (0.5 GB), Nashville (0.5 GB) and Columbus (3.0 GB). Thus, if Rochester, which has 13 games remaining, were to even finish the first half 7-6 to reach 45 wins, Jacksonville, which loses a tiebreaker with the Red Wings, would have to go 11-1 while also hoping the Redbirds, Sounds and Clippers finish with worse records to claim the IL's first half championship for the second year in a row.

APRIL SHOWERS BROUGHT MAY (& JUNE) FLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp lost for the eighth time in 11 games on April 30 at Durham, dropping the club a season-high 6.0 games out of first place in the International League. Jacksonville responded by rattling off 18 wins during the 27 games during May - the first time a Jacksonville team won more than 17 games in May since the 2006 Suns, who went 20-10 in May. Including their contests in June, the Jumbo Shrimp have now gone 21-12 in their last 33 games. During this stretch, Jacksonville has outscored their opponents 192-160 (+32) and outhit them by a 294-248 margin (+46).

PINTAR-EST

Over his first 20 games on the season, **Andrew Pintar** was just 15-for-81 at the plate, slashing a woeful .185/.295/.235/.530 with two doubles, one triple, seven RBIs, 13 walks, nine runs and 24 strikeouts (25.3 strikeout rate). The BYU product has changed his season around significantly since then; over the last 28 games, Pintar is 30-for-103 (.291/.395/.534/.929) with five doubles, one triple, six homers, 22 RBIs, 17 walks and 23 runs. Since this run began on April 28, Pintar ranks 17th in the IL in OPS, 22nd in slugging and 23rd in OBP.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville hit a Triple-A-high 39 home runs in the 19 games from May 10-31. They have hit just one over the last six contests... The Jumbo Shrimp are just 3-for-32 (.094) with runners in scoring position over the last four games.
