Today: It's a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday, with \$3 domestic drafts and \$5 craft drafts, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third in a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. These are the only meetings between the two teams this season; Cedar Rapids won nine of 12 meetings between the two teams last year.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live with an the audio stream via StreamGuys, Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call. Midwest League colleague Calvin Christoforo handles the call for Cedar Rapids.

Last Night: Kernels 7, Lugnuts 3. Noted Lugnuts killer Agustin Ruiz, who drove in eight runs in a game against the Lugnuts in 2021 to set the Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise record, went 3-for-4 with four RBIs to help the Kernels win their second straight game in the series. In the losing cause, Lansing leadoff hitter Jonny Butler went 2-for-3 with two walks and two doubles, scoring a pair of runs.

On Deck: Tomorrow is Peanuts Night, with specialty uniforms, a Jordan Diaz Bobblehead giveaway presented by Jackson National, and LAFCU postgame fireworks.

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 25), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 28) and outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 30).

Welcome to the Show: Southpaw Brady Basso, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021, underwent Tommy John, and returned successfully last season, became the third former Lansing player this season to reach the Majors on May 31 (joining Max Schuemann and Brett Harris). Brady is the 187th Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

Double Time: The Cedar Rapids Kernels have collected the most doubles of any team in the Midwest League, lashing four more last night to give them 107 for the year. In second place? The Lansing Lugnuts, who knocked six doubles last night and now have 106 for the year.

On the Other Hand: No team in the MWL is close to the Lugnuts' 28 triples, good for third among all Minor League Baseball teams, trailing only El Paso (31) and Albuquerque (29), each of whom have played six more games than the Nuts.

Hit Parade: The Lugnuts' offense has piled up 512 hits this season, tied with the Lake County Captains for the most base hits in all of High-A. The Nuts rank 2nd in all of High-A in runs scored (319), total bases (800) and team OPS (.759), each of which ranks atop the Midwest League.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2000: The Clinton LumberKings' Scott Dunn fired a 7-0 perfect game, the first time that the Lugnuts were no-hit in franchise history.

2007: Great Lakes southpaw Clayton Kershaw, the future NL Cy Young Award winner, fired seven scoreless innings with eight strikeouts, allowing four singles and two walks, and the host Loons topped the Lugnuts, 7-3.

2015: Jesus Tinoco allowed four hits and three runs before he could record an out, but then struck out 10 Cedar Rapids Kernels in seven innings in the Lugnuts' 3-1 loss at Perfect Game Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... can often be seen at this time of year wearing his Boston Bruins Patrice Bergeron uniform.


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Retrospective: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of California League Pitcher of the Week with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win... finished with 18 appearances, 84 1/3 IP.

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, infielder Casey Yamauchi and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last lowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3... notable splits:

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 lowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-lowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With lowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
