BIRDS CLIPPED BY ROCKHOUND RALLY, DROP SIXTH STRAIGHT:

The Midland RockHounds struck for six runs in the top of the eighth inning to erase a 4-1 Springfield lead as the Cardinals fell 9-4 on Friday night at Hammons Field. The loss is the Cards' sixth in a row, and eighth straight at home. The Midland rally spoiled a sparkling start by **Ian Bedell** who allowed just 1 R on 3 H over a career-high 7.0 IP. **RJ Yeager** homered for the Cards and **Bryan Torres** drove in a pair. **Mike Antico** went 2-for-4 for Springfield to extend his hitting streak to six straight games.

The two teams met just once last season as well, with Midland winning four of six at Hammons Field from April 18-23.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

HEARTBREAK AT HAMMONS: The RockHounds' eight runs in the final two innings of Friday night's game sent the Cardinals to their 6th straight loss, and their 8th in a row at Hammons Field. Springfield's 8-game skid at home matches the longest home losing streak in franchise history, mactching an 8-game home skid from May 23-June 6, 2013.

SKID SENDS BIRDS INTO RED NUMBERS: During their current sixgame losing streak, the Cardinals have been outscored by 21 runs sending their overall run differential to -4, the first time Springfield has been in the negatives in 2024. The Cardinals have reached +33 twice this season, last on April 24 when the Birds were 14-3. Since that time, the Cardinals have gone 6-13 and have been outscored by 37 runs.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 269 times in 36 games, the 4th-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (257 K's in 356 games, fewest in all of the Minor Leagues) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Birds are averaging just 7.5 K's per game.

BEDELL PLAYS STOPPER: With 7 innings of one-run ball in his start for the Cardinals on Friday night, Ian Bedell put an end to what had been a tough go-around for the Springfield rotation over the past week. Before Bedell's outing, the Cardinals' starting rotation had struggled during their last turn through the 5-man group. In their previous 5 outings, Cardinals starters had combined for just 18 IP (3.2 IP on average) allowing 32 H, 31 R with 13 walks and 13 K's. Of the 31 runs scored, 22 were earned, giving the Birds' rotation an ERA of 18.00 during the five-game stretch. The Cardinals' bullpen, meanwhile, sported a 3.08 ERA (9 ER in 26.1 IP) during that same stretch.

The tables turned, however, on Saturday when Bedell allowed just one run but two Cardinal relievers were tagged for 7 R (5 ER) in just 2.0 IP.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 29 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 29 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 113 of the 202 total runs scored by the opposition. In summation, the Cards have allowed 55.9% of the runs scored against them in 2024 in just 9% of their innings pitched. In the other 280.2 IP Springfield has allowed 89 runs, which comes out to 2.85 runs per 9 innings.

WELCOME BACK TO SPRINGY: Since returning to Springfield on April 25 after beginning the season with Triple-A Memphis. Cardinals OF Mike Antico has picked up where he left off in 2023. In 13 games in the month of May since returning to the Springfield regular lineup, Antico is batting a team-high .362 (17-for-47) with 2 2B, 2 HR and 10 RBIs, tied with Bryan Torres for the most on the club during that time, and has hit safely in 6 straight games. Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, Antico is 4th in the Texas League in hitting in May.

The former Texas Longhorn led the Cardinals in hits (126) and stolen bases (52) last season.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, Bryan Torres and Nathan Church, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, Torres and Church are batting .307 (81-for-264) with 43 R, 14 2B, 22 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 36 times compared to 29 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .284 which ranks 3rd in the Texas League, and .294 out of the 2-hole, tied for the top mark in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals are tops in the league batting .289 between the two spots in the lineup.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.
