### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound tonight, making his first start since 5/19 in Toledo. Iowa will counter with RHP **Adrian Sampson**. The Clippers are 12-16 (.429) against right handers this year. Sampson pitched for Indianapolis from 2014-15, starting against the Clippers six times and going 0-2 with a 4.60ERA (31.1IP, 42H, 16R, 16ER, 8BB, 23K).

### vs. the Cubs

Columbus has not played Iowa in the regular season since 1991, when the Cubs played in the American Association. From 1988-91, the two leagues played crossover games with the Clippers winning 11 of 21 against Iowa (also went 11-10 against Omaha and 11-10 against Nashville), including five of 10 at the first Sec Taylor Stadium in Des Moines (demolished and rebuilt after 1991 season).

### Turning a Corner

After starting the season 5-1, the Clippers went 4-18 from 5/12-6/5 (worst 22G stretch since 4-18 from 6/13-7/4/09), but have rebounded to go 4-1. The Clippers are hitting .300 (18x60) with runners in scoring position in the last five (.180, 34x189 in the 22G prior) and have attempted a sac bunt in each of the wins (successful thrice; had two attempts, both unsuccessful, in previous 22G).

### Offensive Offense

Columbus has posted eight multi-run innings over the last 32 (since the 5th on Tuesday), equalling the number of multi-run innings produced in the previous 123, dating to 5/22 at Toledo. The Clippers had three consecutive games with multiple multi-run innings from 6/8-6/10, but had zero multi-run innings last night. When the Clippers put at least two crooked numbers on the board, they are 7-1.

### Out of the Basement

After a brief stint at the bottom of the IL in run differential, the Clippers have moved up to 13th (-48). Three straight nights, from 6/8-6/10, they won after allowing the opponent to score at least four runs, improving to 4-18 in such games (.182, went from last to 11th). On Tuesday, the Clippers won their first game when getting out-homered (now 1-12), moving ahead of Memphis (now 1-14) in such games.

### Cursed at the Top

Heading into 6/4, Clipper leadoff hitters were hitting an IL-worst .198. **Oscar Mercado** went 3x4 that night, snapping a 12G streak in which the leadoff hitter did not have a multi-hit game (4x50 between multi-hit games) and has hit .367 (11x30) in his last 7G (leadoff now .230, 10th). However, the leadoff spot has the fewest runs scored in the IL (13), failing to have a multi-run game all season.

### Rough Series

**Andres Gimenez** has batted .067 (1x15) during the current series, after going 7x22 (.318) in Indianapolis. However, he has found a way to contribute, pushing a pair of runners over with sac bunts (3SAC on season, most since six Clippers had at least 4SAC in 2018). **Gavin Collins** has just one hit this series, which also happens to be his only hit of the roadtrip (.059, 1x17).

### Luplow Rehab

**Jordan Luplow** joined Columbus on a rehab assignment yesterday (0x2, BB), recovering from an injury to his left ankle (on the DL since 5/27). Luplow was hitting only .173/.331/.439 with 7HR and 20RBI at the time and was just 6x50 over his last 19G (15 hitless). With Columbus in 2019, Luplow appeared in just 13G, slashing .311/.456/.511 with 2HR and 7RBI over 45AB. He also swiped a pair of bases.

### Swinging Hard

The Clippers have two among the top four in the IL in strikeouts, as **Nolan Jones** ranks 2nd (47K) and **Daniel Johnson** is 4th (43K). Johnson's 3-hit game Thursday (first since 8/17/19) boosted him over .200 for the first time this month (also snapped 14G homerless streak). Jones has dropped below .200, going 0x5 since breaking .200 on 6/9 (went 0x14 after last time breaking .200, 5/28).

### Bullpen is Back

Despite last night's hiccup (6.1IP, 7ER), Clipper relievers have a 4.70ERA (36.1IP, 19ER) on the roadtrip (HR allowed by **Heath Fillmyer** was first on road by bullpen since 5/23 at Toledo). Removing 5/23's catastrophe in Toledo (5.0IP, 11ER, 3HR, 27BF), the bullpen has a 2.93ERA on the road (83.0IP, 27ER) and has allowed 2HR to 372BF (6.75ERA, 60.0IP, 45ER and 14HR to 279BF at home).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

6/12/2005

Columbus erased a 7-2 deficit, scoring six times over the final three innings, including a pair in the 9th to beat Pawtucket 8-7.

**Kevin Reese**, the 2005 Clipper of the Year, had four hits to lead the way, starting the comeback with a 3-run HR in the 7th and then scoring the tying run after a double in the 9th. Reese made his Major League debut two weeks later, starting in left field for the Yankees.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). In 2019, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (948 to 906).

## Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

## Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

From 2014-19, no team had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus and no team produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB was 2nd in win percentage, .338, and wins, 192). This year has seen the Clippers go 5-20 (.200) in games in which they trail, ranking 11th.

## Get What You Pay For

Columbus is the only team in the IL that has yet to play any free baseball this season, having played 73 straight games, including the postseason, since their last extra-inning rumble (7/31/19 vs. Louisville, an 11-8 loss in 11; only extra inning loss of the season, 8-1). Over the past 20 seasons, the longest the Clippers had previously gone between extras was 57 games from 8/12/08-5/17/09 (37 to start '09 season is longest stretch to begin in last 20 seasons). That streak ended with consecutive extra inning games.

## Trending Downward

The current staff ERA of 5.60 is on pace to be the worst in franchise history (5.08, 1983) and anything over 4.71 will mark the fifth straight season in which the ERA has gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 32 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016). The 7.00ERA at Huntington Park is by far the worst ever (5.29 in 2019, only time ERA has ever been over 5.00 at HP).

## Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

## Free Swingers

After three straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup is threatening for a fourth, as they currently rank 5th (325K, 46 off the pace, St. Paul). The 2019 squad obliterated the franchise record, as they struck out 95 more times than the previous high (1,392; each of last three seasons rank among franchise's three worst, totalling 3,979K in 422G). While the record appears safe due to the truncated schedule, this year's version is averaging 9.85K per game.

## That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

## One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

## Good Baseball

**Andres Gimenez** advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 6/10 at Iowa and the runner came around to score in the win (3-0 when advanced runner scores). During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department (12 successes), but when the advanced runners scored, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt (54 successes).

## International Accolades

**Bobby Bradley** was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes**, **Eric Haase**, **Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-79, **Joe Altobelli**-80, **Frank Verdi**-81, **Bucky Dent**-87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 43-66 (.394), 13-20 with Columbus (.394).

#### Young Vet:

Allen is the youngest member of the Columbus rotation, but had as many Major League starts in April (5) as the rest of the original rotation had at Triple-A coming into the season (**Kirk McCarty** and **Jean Carlos Mejia** had never pitched above High-A, while **Scott Moss**, 4GS, and **Eli Morgan**, 1GS, rounded out the rotation).

#### In the Show:

After a promising start to the season (3ER in 10.0IP), Allen was chased before the end of the 3rd inning in each of his next three starts with Cleveland (13ER in 5.2IP). Through his first 57TBF, Allen was a member of the No Homers Club, giving up a longball to only Whit Merrifield on 4/5 (there's allowed to be one). Following that batter, Allen kept 47 straight in the park until allowing 6HR over 12TBF from 4/23-4/28.

#### Coming Around as a Clipper:

Starting with his regular season finale at Louisville on 8/29/19 and including both of his IL Playoff starts, Allen won three straight starts in a Clipper uniform, posting a 2.08ERA (17.1IP, 14H, 5R, 4ER, 7BB, 14K). However, he allowed a solo homer in each of those 3GS. In Allen's first four starts after the trade from San Diego, he was 0-1 with a 9.92ERA (16.1IP, 26H, 19R, 18ER, 9BB, 12K), giving up 5HR.
