Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Norfolk Tides in the final game of the 2023 first half and final game of the Sounds' 12-game homestand. Nashville hopes to salvage a series split after falling in 11 innings last night. Jason Alexander takes the mound for the Sounds on rehab assignment, while Garrett Stallings makes his Triple-A debut for Norfolk.

Jason Alexander: 30-year-old Jason Alexander makes his first start with Nashville and fourth start of his rehab assignment. The righty is recovering from a right rotator cuff strain. Last season, Alexander went 8-2 with a 2.84 ERA (63.1 IP/20 ER) in 13 games (10 starts) for the Sounds. He also made his Major League debut for Milwaukee, going 2-3 with a 5.40 ERA (71.2 IP/43 ER) in 18 games (11 starts). Alexander currently has an 8.21 ERA (7.2 IP/7 ER) in three rehab starts between ACL Brewers (2) and Biloxi (1). The California native was signed by Milwaukee as a free agent on November 17, 2021 and was originally signed by Los Angeles-AL as a non-drafted free agent on June 21, 2017 out of Menlo College (CA).

Garrett Stallings: 25-year-old Garrett Stallings will get the ball for Norfolk in his Triple-A debut. The right-hander went 3-2 with a 4.73 ERA (53.1 IP/28 ER) over 13 games (7 starts) for Double-A Bowie. In his last appearance for the Baysox on June 22, he allowed five runs (four earned) over 0.2 relief innings. Last season, Stallings went 6-10 with a 6.28 ERA (119.0 IP/83 ER) in 26 games (22 starts) for Bowie. The Virginia native was originally selected by Los Angeles-AL in the fifth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Tennessee. He was acquired by Baltimore from Los Angeles-AL alongside RHP Jean Pinto in exchange for SS Jose Iglesias on December 2, 2020.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 24, Fifth: 26, Sixth: 11, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Another Gas Gem: Robert Gasser turned in yet another quality start last night, spinning 6.1 innings, allowing just one earned run and striking out nine. He also continued his streak of scoreless first innings by striking out the side. Hitters are now batting .047 (2-for-43) with 16 strikeouts in the first against Gasser. Over his last five starts, the southpaw is 3-0 with a 2.23 ERA (32.1 IP/8 ER), 0.90 WHIP, just four walks and 36 strikeouts. Gasser ranks among International League leaders in strikeouts (1st, 87), winning percentage (T-2nd, .833), opponent average (3rd, .223), innings (T-4th, 74.1), WHIP (4th, 1.25) and ERA (7th, 4.00).

Turn It Up To 11: Brice Turang moved his hitting streak to 11 games with two knocks last night. It was the first multi-hit performance of his streak. He's batting .279 (12-for-43) with three doubles, three homers, 14 RBI, four walks and .898 OPS since the streak began. 14 RBI is the second-most in the IL dating back to June 13. It is the fourth longest active hitting streak in the league.

Steady Eddy: Eddy Alvarez extended his on-base streak to 10 games with a 1-for-6 performance last night. During the streak, which dates back to June 7, Alvarez is batting .355 (11-for-31) with six runs, three doubles, three homers, 10 RBI, more walks (9) than strikeouts (3) and three steals.

Quality Starters: Of the last three pitchers to start in the Sounds rotation, Thomas Pannone, Janson Junk and Robert Gasser have combined for a 1.35 ERA (20.0 IP/3 ER), 0.70 WHIP and 21 strikeouts this series.

Friendly Confines: On the attendance front, the Sounds lead all of Minor League Baseball in average home attendance (8,024 fans per night) and total home attendance (288,878) at First Horizon Park.

Putting the League on Lock: After holding the Tides to three earned runs in 11 innings last night, Nashville hurlers continue to have the lowest ERA in Triple-A (4.03), ahead of Norfolk (4.53). Nashville pitchers also lead the level in fewest hits allowed (569), runs allowed (328), WHIP (1.34) and opponent average (.240). This month, the Sounds have the lowest ERA (3.64), fewest runs allowed (tied, 88) and best WHIP (1.28) in Triple-A.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, right-handed pitcher Abner Uribe is the No. 9 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect, who is on the injured list.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 639-552 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Alexander made a start with Double-A Biloxi on June 20, surrendering eight hits in three innings vs. Chattanooga. He allowed five earned runs, walking one and striking out one. He threw 49 pitches, 40 for strikes in the Shuckers' walk-off 8-7 victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Alexander has four appearances against Norfolk - three with Nashville and one with Jacksonville. He is 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA (18.1 IP/5 ER) and 16 strikeouts in his four games (two starts).
