PITCHING SHINES IN SERIES-OPENING WIN:

Ryan Garcia tossed six no-hit innings and the Frisco RoughRiders blanked Corpus Christi Hooks 6-0 in a one-hitter on Tuesday at Whataburger Field. Garcia struck out six over six innings, walking two. He induced a double play ball to end the third inning and faced just one over the minimum overall. He is the first Frisco (19-15, 50-52) pitcher to last more than 5.1 innings in a start since Garcia himself went seven innings in Corpus Christi (19-15, 52-51) on June 10th. **Reid Birlingmair** kept the shutout alive in the eighth and ninth innings, although he did allow one hit in the seventh to end the no-hitter. He faced one over the minimum while striking out the side in the seventh and going 1-2-3 in the eighth. **Triston Polley** pitched a hitless ninth inning to complete the one-hitter. The Riders scored in the first inning on a two-out rally started by **Trevor Hauver**. With the bases empty, two outs and an 0-2 count, Hauver came back to work a walk, advanced to second on a passed ball and scored on **Kellen Strahm**'s single. Frisco added to the lead with **Frainer Chavez**'s home run to left field in the fifth. The solo shot to lead off the inning was his first long ball since joining the club last week. **Josh Hatcher**'s sacrifice fly extended the lead to 3-0 in the 6th inning to score Hauver, who tacked on one more run the next inning on a two-out single to bring home **Chris Seise**. In the ninth inning, Hauver recorded a sac fly and **David Garcia** picked up an RBI on a bases-loaded hit by pitch.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the seven games in August, the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 2.55 ERA while allowing a league-low two home runs and .170 BAA. The bullpen has allowed just five earned runs over 38.2 innings, a 1.16 ERA with 47 strikeouts to 11 walks. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. In two starts against Corpus Christi, he is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 61 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 78 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.9 percent walk rate this year is third-highest in the League as well. He has walked 11 times in his last nine games. His .407 OBP on the season is tied for fifth in all of Double-A and among all 13 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 17 games, Hicks is batting .371 (23-for-62)/.443/.532/.975 with five doubles, a home run, 12 RBIs, eight walks and 10 runs scored. He is riding a six-game hitting streak, batting .476 (10-for-21).

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 18 outings. During that stretch, he has 23 strikeouts to three walks over 20.1 innings while recording three saves. He has converted on all seven save opportunities this season.

TRADE SEASON:

The Rangers and the Mets made a major trade on Saturday evening, being reported as completed during the sixth inning of that evening's Riders game, when the Mets sent three-time Cy Young winner and eight-time All-Star **Max Scherzer** to Texas in exchange for RoughRiders shortstop **Luisangel Acuña**. Acuña exits the Rangers franchise hitting .315/.377/.453/.830 with a team-high 25 doubles, 114 hits, 68 runs scored and 42 stolen bases. On Sunday, a second trade for the Rangers impacted Frisco with **Thomas Saggese** and **Tekoah Roby** going to the St. Louis Cardinals organization in exchange for LHP **Jordan Montgomery** and RHP **Chris Stratton**. Saggese was one of the best bats for Frisco, hitting .313/.379/.512/.891 with 22 doubles, 15 home runs, 78 RBIs and 67 runs scored over 93 games while Roby, who has been out with injury since early June, went 2-3 with a 5.05 ERA in 10 starts.

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 29 games, he has driven in 29 runs and in July, Hatcher hit .318/.360/.545/.905 with five homers and 23 RBIs in 17 games.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
