JACKSONVILLE SPLITS SERIES WITH CHARLOTTE

Despite long balls from C.J. Hinojosa, Jake Mangum and Peyton Burdick, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp blew three separate leads on Sunday and lost 9-8 on Evan Skoug's walk-off home run to the Charlotte Knights from Trust Field. Jacksonville (7-7) led 8-7 going to the bottom of the ninth. With one out, Erik González doubled to left against reliever Anthony Maldonado (2-2). Skoug then cracked a two-run homer to right to win it for Charlotte (8-7).

THE SOUND(S) OF MUSIC

After owning the Nashville Sounds in 2021 with a 5-1 record, the Jumbo Shrimp struggled in 2022 against the eventual IL West Champs. In 18 contests last season, Jacksonville finished six games below .500, winning just six total affairs for a .333 winning percentage. Nashville owned Jumbo Shrimp pitching, slashing .303/.373/.451/.824 with 42 XBHs (21 2B, 1 3B, 20 HR). Of the 10 International League teams the Jumbo Shrimp matched up against in 2022, the pitching staff owned the second-worst ERA (5.52) against Nashville.

GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than **C.J. Hinojosa**. Through 10 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 17-for-44, slashing a robust .386/.417/.750/1.167 with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 RBIs and seven runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for 13th in the International League in RBIs, fifth in batting average, eighth in slugging, 13th in OPS and tied for 14th in total bases. He also is tied for the fourth-longest hitting streak for Jacksonville this season (5) and owns the fifth-longest on-base streak which is also five-straight contests.

BYE-BYE BURDICK

Coming into 2023, **Peyton Burdick** hadn't recorded a multihomer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4, 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games, and his seven on the season lead the International League. Burdick is also tied for second in the IL in extra-base hits (12), tied for third in hits (20), fourth in slugging (.789), tied for fourth in both RBIs (15) and runs scored (15), fifth in OPS (1.211) and 20th in batting average (.351). Heading into play on Tuesday, Burdick has a hit in 13 consecutive games, the longest such streak in the circuit.

LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on April 14, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. Still though, over their last 13 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats nine times. Jacksonville has scored first over their opponent in eight of their 15 games thus far in 2023, going 6-2 (.750) when doing so. Conversely, the club has struggled when falling behind, going just 1-5 (.167). The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times during the 2022 season (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

THE *START* OF SOMETHING?

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in seven of their last eight games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp Iid-lifters have yielded 19 runs, 17 earned, on 40 hits in 39.2 innings for a 3.86 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registered just 28 punchouts (6.4 K/9). However, they have only issued nine walks during this run, a rate of 2.0 per nine innings.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

In all but two contest to start 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have had their leadoff man reach base to start the game. Of those 13 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Nine of those 13 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits. Of those other four leadoff baserunners, three were via walks and one on an error.

Jordan Groshans has at least one hit in eight of Jacksonville's first 13 games so far this season, going 11for-46 (.241/.317/.296/.613) at the plate with two doubles, five RBIs and six runs scored...Groshans' on-base streak has stretched to 16-straight... **Peyton Burdick** has two multihomer games this season...The Jumbo Shrimp played 39 one-run games in 2022, finishing 20-19. Through the club's first 15 games, Jacksonville is 3-2 in one-run games to start 2023

-GONZÁALEZ was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected GONZALEZ in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, GONZALEZ attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-GONZÁLEZ starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.

-GONZÁLEZ posted an 0-1 record with a 5.87 ERA in the 2022 regular season.

-GONZÁLEZ made Colorado's Opening Day roster and began season in Rockies bullpen.

-GONZÁLEZ then made a move to the starting roatation starting April 10, making seven starts for the Rockies.

-In his first stint in the rotation, Chi Chi went 1-4, 8.23 ERA (50.1 IP, 46 ER) through his last 11 starts (Rockies 4-7) from June 10 through his final start on Sept. 7. He was then placed on Injured List with a right oblique strain Sept. 8-Oct. 2 before electing to free agency.
