LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn could not snag the series' opening game against Jersey Shore, falling 7-2...The loss marks the Cyclones' first home defeat in a series opener this season...Brooklyn's pitching staff limited Jersey Shore to only five hits, but a season-high-tying four errors proved costly down the stretch when Jersey Shore plated two in the seventh to grab a 4-2 lead it would not relinquish...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** spun 4.1 innings of two-run ball, while RHP **Jimmy Loper** was handed a tough-luck loss over 1.2 innings of relief work...LF **Emaarion Boyd** scored three of the Phillies' affiliate's seven runs, while also collecting a pair of hits and walking once...LF **Jefrey De Los Santos** posted a multi-hit game for Brooklyn, reaching three times with a walk...SS **William Lugo** was on base four times thanks to a double, a throwing error, and two free passes.

SAY IT AIN'T SO, KID: The entire MLB and MiLB community continues to mourn the loss of **Willie Mays**, who passed away on Tuesday at the age of 93...Widely considered one of the best players to ever step on the diamond, Mays spent the final two seasons of his illustrious career with the Mets in 1972 and 1973...Known not only for his ability on the field, but his outstanding character off of it, Mays' career spanned over 20 years (1951-1973), during which he collected 24 All-Star nods, 2 National League MVPs, and 12 Gold Gloves...The legend is sixth in all-time home runs (660), seventh in runs scored (2,068), 10th in RBI (1,909) and 12th in hits (3,293)...In 56 lifetime games at Ebbets Field in Brooklyn, Mays was a .355/.419/.786 hitter with an astounding 1.205 OPS...Mays blasted 28 of his 660 home runs in Brooklyn, adding 60 RBI...The 28 home runs are third-most by a visiting player in Ebbets Field history, trailing only St. Louis Cardinals legend **Stan Musial** (37), and former Pittsburgh Pirates star **Ralph Kiner** (30)...Mays' pro career kicked off in 1948 at the age of 17 with the Birmingham Black Barons...On Thursday, the Giants are set to play the Cardinals from historic Rickwood Field in Alabama to honor the Negro Leagues and its contribution to baseball.

SUPER STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old tallied a career-high-tying four hits in last Sunday's loss at Hudson Valley...Consuegra has accomplished the feat four times, most recently on April 13, 2023, at Winston-Salem...He is also the second Cyclone to reach that mark in 2024, joining OF **Nick Morabito** (5/28 @JS)...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .302/.404/.573 with a .977 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 63 points (.171 to .234) and his OPS by 219 points (.519 to .738) during the stretch...Since that date, the right-handed slugger is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for fourth in doubles (8), and fifth in total bases (55)...Consuegra set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (184) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has been one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League throughout 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for seventh in the circuit in extra-base hits (23), tied for eighth in RBI (35), and 10th in total bases (96)...Lorusso is tied for third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in extra-base hits (23)...He is also tied for third in triples (3), fourth in OPS (.836) and slugging (.475), tied for fourth in home runs (9) and tied for fifth in RBI (35).

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is sixth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (32), tied for eighth in on-base percentage (.447), and tied for 16th in batting average (.333)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick leads the league in steals (21), is second in runs scored (29), and ninth in on-base percentage (.395) and hits (40).

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilién** enters play with the second-longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 23 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...Greenville OF **Ailen Castro** has the longest streak in the circuit at 24 games...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .279/.369/.407 slash line with a .776 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, and 13 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilién also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series, including the final three games of the season's first half, against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore boasts seven of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Aidan Miller** (2), OF **Justin Crawford** (4), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23), RHP **George Klassen** (28)...The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests...Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn dropped the season series to the Jersey Shore, 15-11...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 52-44 (.542).

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped the last home series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 21 of 22 games, hitting .280/.427/.453 with an .880 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 20 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 19 walks...Since that date, Suero is tied for fifth in the SAL in walks (19), tied for eighth in runs scored (20), and ninth in on-base percentage (.427).

OH, HENRY!: The Cyclones added RHP **Henry Henry** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his New York Mets' organizational debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 14 at Jupiter...Henry retired all three batters he faced, striking out one, on 10 pitches...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect **Henry Henry** or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee **King Henry**.

WALK THIS WAY: INF **William Lugo** has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 47 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 20.3% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 200 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits third in walk rate...Major League Baseball's top prospect and Triple-A Norfolk's (Baltimore) SS **Jackson Holliday**, as well as Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF **Ryan Clifford** are tied for the MiLB lead (22.0%).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones last Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 60 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-3 record with a 2.37 ERA (26 ER in 98.2 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 24 and striking out 87.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss in his first affiliated start last Wednesday night at Hudson Valley...Surrendered six runs (three earned) on eight hits over 5.0-plus innings...Walked two and struck out five...Charged with a pair of wild pitches...Permitted a two-run home run to DH **Rafael Flores** in the bottom of the first inning...Threw 93 pitches and 56 strikes (60.22%)...Relieved by RHP **Josh Hejka** with runners at first and second and nobody out in the bottom of the sixth and Brooklyn trailing 5-3...One of two bequeathed runners scored...The Cyclones had opportunities to take the lead in the seventh and eighth, but fell to the Renegades, 6-5.

CHANGE OF PLANS: Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager **Paul Fletcher** that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dugout and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look," said Pintaro to the *Daily Inter Lake*...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit...Pintaro was teammates with 2024 BlueClaws INF **Chad Castillo** with the Range Riders.

REMEMBER ME?: Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

SHORTER STACK: Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' AdventHealth Stadium.
