TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Sacramento prepare for the series opener on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond. River Cats RHP Tristan Beck is scheduled to start up against Express RHP Cole Winn. First pitch is slated for 7:05 p.m. CT.

BROADCAST INFORMATION

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone or on 91.1 FM from inside Dell Diamond. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.heart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Fans can also watch the game with a valid MLB.tv login. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while former MLB player and Atlanta Braves scout, John Flannery, provides color commentary.

SUNDAY SWEEP

Round Rock finished off a three-game sweep of Las Vegas thanks to a 2-1 victory on Sunday night. After a scoreless first three innings, Las Vegas plated the game's first run in the fourth. C Shea Langeliers found base on a two-out double before scoring thanks to a single from 1B Matt Davidson. Round Rock tied the game at one apiece in the fifth inning when LF J.P. Martinez launched a 421-foot home run into center field, earning the first Triple-A hit of his career. The Express kept three Aviators baserunners away from home plate during the final two innings as the game headed into the bottom of the ninth still tied at 1-1. Round Rock CF Steven Duggar walked to start the frame before 1B Andy Ibanez joined him on base with a single. DH Steele Walker moved both runners into scoring position with a flyout. The winning run came when a single from C Sam Huff landed just past the center fielder and scored Duggar for a 2-1 win.

LET'S WINN

RHP Cole Winn is scheduled to start for the Express in the series opener. In 16 starts for Round Rock this season, the righty is 6-1 with a 5.93 ERA (47 ER/51.1 IP). He has issued 48 walks while collecting 63 strikeouts. The E-Train own a 12-4 record in games that Winn has started this season.

THINGS ARE HEATING UP

The Express have won four consecutive games, marking their longest winning streak since winning four games from June 29-July 2. Over the last four contests, Round Rock pitchers have tossed to a 2.00 ERA (8 ER/36.0 IP) with 12 walks to 42 strikeouts and own a 1.08 WHIP.

MARTINEZ MAKES HIS DEBUT

Express LF J.P. Martinez made his second career Triple-A appearance on Sunday night. After going 0-for-3 with a walk in his debut on Saturday, the outfielder finished 1-for-3 with a home run on Sunday. He became the season's third Round Rock hitter to hit his first Triple-A home run while also earning his first Triple-A hit. OF Bubba Thompson went yard in his Triple-A debut on April 5 against El Paso before INF Ezequiel Duran accomplished the feat on June 30 against Las Vegas.

THOMPSON WALKS AND RUNS

While OF Bubba Thompson leads Triple-A with 46 stolen bases, he has shown a patient approach as of late. After walking only twice in his first 36 games this season, the righty has earned 19 walks in his last 37 games and has walked five times in his previous four. In July, Thompson owns a slash line of .339/.443/.576 with two doubles, four home runs and eight RBI.

BULLPEN STREAK

The E-Train bullpen remained steady on Sunday and has not allowed a run in their last 9.1 innings of work. The last time Round Rock allowed a run came in the eighth inning of Saturday's contest against Las Vegas. On Sunday, RHP Ryder Ryan, RHP Nick Snyder, RHP Spencer Patton, LHP John King and RHP Josh Sborz combined for five shutout innings that saw only three hits, two walks and four punchouts. Starter LHP Kolby Allard allowed one run and struck out seven during 4.0 frames.

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

While Round Rock has won their last four games, they still trail the Oklahoma City Dodgers by 5.0 games in the PCL East Division. The Express have remained in third place since June 10.

Alexy, RHP Justin Anderson, INF Sherten Apostel, RHP Kohei Arihara, RHP Jason Bahr, INF Ryan Dorow, OF Elier Hernandez, INF Yonny Hernandez, C Sam Huff, C Jack Kruger, LHP Jake Latz, RHP Tyson Miller, C Yohel Pozo, RHP Yerry Rodriguez, RHP Ryder Ryan, RHP Nick Snyder, OF Leody Taveras, INF Davis Wendzel and RHP Cole Winn. RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
