FROM THE CROW'S NEST

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Jackson Glenn has reached base safely in each of his first 9 games at Low-A, batting .406 with a .525 OBP. The Pirates' fifth-round draft pick out of Dallas Baptist has hit safely in 8 of the 9 games, and has walked 8 times while striking out just 5 times.

THE HERMANATOR REIGNS: Jack Herman was named Low-A Southeast Player of the Week for the week of August 16. During the week, Herman hit .333 with 2 home runs, and 6 RBI, and had a 4-hit game on Tuesday that matched his careerhigh. In August, he's batting .307 with a .867 OPS. In 35 total games with Bradenton, Herman has 8 home runs, 30 RBI, 10 multi-hit games, and 16 of his 38 hits are for extra bases (7 2B, 1 3B, 8 HR).

STUCK IN A RUT: The Marauders have lost 4 of their last 5 games, the first time that has happened since July 25-30, when the team dropped 4 of 5 against St. Lucie and Dunedin. Bradenton still sits at 22 games over .500, 9 games ahead of the third-place Mighty Mussels

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodriguez is batting .357 over his last 4 games, including 3 doubles and 4 RBI. The 21-year-old from the Dominican Republic is batting .304 since the beginning of July (37 games), posting a .395 OBP and a .873 OPS during that stretch.

GUTI GOT IT: Abrahan Gutierrez has reached base safely in 7 straight games, posting a .452 on-base percentage during that stretch. In 17 games since joining the Marauders on July 30, Gutierrez is batting .302 with 4 RBI, drawing 12 walks while striking out just 8 times.

MAGIC WANDI: Right-hander Wandi Montout is turning in an effective month of August out of the Marauders bullpen, posting a 1.93 ERA while holding opponents to a .229 batting average in 6 appearances. The 24-year-old from the Dominican Republic has allowed an earned run in just 2 of his last 9 appearances, stretching back to July 23 at St. Lucie.

THE OPPONENT: The Mighty Mussels are coming off a series split at Dunedin and snapped a three-game losing streak on Sunday. The Marauders are 10-9 against Fort Myers this season, splitting two series and winning one.

TOP PROSPECTS: Per midseason ranking updates, the Marauders roster currently includes four prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: Hudson Head (#12), Jared Jones (#15), Endy Rodriguez (#19), and Maikol Escotto (#20). Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the Joe Musgrove trade in January, while Escotto was one of four prospects obtained from the Yankees in the Jameson Taillon trade.

<u>UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:</u> New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bradenton pitchers' 1,047 strikeouts are 11th in all of MiLB (San Jose leads with 1,192)... The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +64 (Tampa's +241 leads all of MiLB)... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top seven in home runs: **Hudson Head** and **Jase Bowen** are T-3rd with 12 HR, **Endy Rodri**guez is T-5th with 10 HR, Sammy Siani is T-7th with 8 HR, and Alexander Mojica is T-8th with 7 HR.

2021: Made professional debut in relief on May 25 vs Palm Beach: 3 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 K... Did not allow an earned run through first seven innings of career... First career start, June 5 at Dunedin: 3.2 IP: 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB/3 K, 66 pitches/41 strikes... June 27 vs Jupiter: career-high 11 K, struck out 11 of 14 batters faced... His 11 K are the highest single-game total by a Marauder in 2021 (topping Santiago Florez, 10 K on June 2 at Dunedin) and finished just two shy of matching Nick Kingham's franchise record 13 K on 4/28/13 vs Brevard County... That day, Jones combined with Domingo Gonzalez for 18 strikeouts, matching the franchise record (18 K in 14 innings on 6/23/11 at Fort Myers)... July 11 vs Clearwater, hit Rixon Wingrove in the leg with a pitch, sparking a benches-clearing incident... Two weeks ago vs Fort Myers, battled high pitch count but powered through 3 IP scoreless... Last Saturday vs Clearwater, held Threshers scoreless through 3 IP but labored in 4th (2 BB and INF-1B loaded the bases, 2 BB forced home a run each, 2-run single allowed by Carlos Campos in relief)... Has allowed 9 BB in last 3G (11.2 IP) after allowing just 16 BB over first 11G (41 IP)... Has a 1.37 WHIP, .237 BAA.

2020: Drafted in the 2nd Round (44th overall) out of La Mirada High School... From the Long Beach *Press-Telegram*: Jones: "I was standing right next to my dad (Keith) and we both just really broke down and started crying. It was a moment to remember forever." ... Was committed to the University of Texas before being drafted... Before Covid shutdown: 3 GS, 2-1 record, 0.82 ERA, 28 K in 17 IP... Was also hitting. 409 and was 8 for 8 in stolen bases... Also from the *Press-Telegram*, La Mirada head coach Jimmy Zurn: "What this kid's been able to do from a pitching standpoint ... and not just that, I'm talking in all areas of the game — hitting, stealing bases, the way he plays center field. And No. 1 is his competitive nature. I think that's what separates him from a lot of these people in this draft. This kid is a winner and he wants to win and he expects to win."

PERSONAL: Was a two-way standout at La Mirada HS, playing center field when not pitching... Father, Keith, played baseball at Fullerton College (CA) before spending two seasons as an infielder in the Diamondbacks organization (Rookie-level and Low-A, 1997-1998)... Mother played college softball...
