ALL GOOD THINGS MUST COME TO AN END: After winning a franchise record nine games in a row, the FredNats dropped the series opener Tuesday night to the Carolina Mudcats, Single-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. After the first home rainout of the year last night, the FredNats and Mudcats will play a 7-inning doubleheader onight, with FXBG taking on the Oatly Oat Milkers alter ego in game two. This is an MiLB initiative, and all 120 full-season Minor League teams have one night where they take on this alter ego. The FredNats send RHP Marc Davis to the mound in game one, followed by LHP Dannel Diaz in game two. Davis has allowed just one run in his last 15 innings, and the last time Diaz pitched at home, he spun four perfect frames and led a no-hit bid into the 9th inning for FXBG.

**ABOUT LAST GAME**: Fredericksburg was limited to just four hits and one run on offense, and two runs for the Mudcats in the top of the 8th inning were enough for them to steal one 2-1 in the series opener at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. Carolina only mustered four hits of their own, but an RBI double by Satchell Norman in the 8th against Mason Denaburg was the biggest swing of the game. Travis Sykora pitched five scoreless, hitless innings, and FXBG had the bases loaded in the bottom of the 8th, but could not score. The FredNats now fall back to 7-8 in series openers, and 3-4 against Carolina with still 11 games to play in the season series.

**DOMINANT ARMS**: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last three series. Since June 11, the beginning of the last Carolina series, FredNat starters have logged 117 2/3 innings and allowed just 21 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.61. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. Last series alone, FredNat starting pitching has allowed just 12 hits and four runs in 29 innings against Delmarva.

THIRTY SIX AND ONE: Last night's loss was the first time all season that the FredNats lost a game when leading after seven innings, pushing the team's record in that scenario to 36-1. FXBG remains a perfect 39-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

**OH SYKORA**: After making his professional debut on May 1 with Fredericksburg, 2023 Nationals third round pick Travis Sykora has taken the Carolina League by storm in the first two months of his professional career. He's pitched five complete innings in each of his last five starts, including five no-hit innings last night with seven strikeouts. He's allowed just four runs in that time frame with 40 strikeouts and nine walks, and has lowered his season ERA to 2.78 in 11 starts.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 36-6 this season when scoring first, including 31 out of the last 32 wins. FXBG was beaten for the first time in a month when scoring first in last night's game by Carolina.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 188-155 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Marc Davis is set to make his 15th start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

JUCO BANDIT: Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

**TWO-WAY TALENT:** Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

**AGAINST THE 'CATS:** Marc faced the Mudcats back on 6/15, and had to battle himself as he walked five men over 4.1 innings. Despite the command issues, Davis gave up just two runs, and only one of those was earned.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Davis went five complete for the third straight start, allowing just two hits and one run in a win against Delmarva.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Dannel Diaz joins the FredNat rotation for a pair of starts this week against the Carolina Mudcats. Tonight marks the second time the southpaw has started for Fredericksburg, and just the fifth start of his pro career.

**LONG STRANGE TRIP:** Diaz has bounced around the Washington system in his relatively brief pro career. After signing in September of '22, Diaz played all of the folllowing year with Wilmington. He made 38 appearances (three starts), and was largely effective with a 4.37 ERA in 59.2 innings of work. He struck out 83 batters but did walk 41, while opponents hit .208 off the lefty.

Dannel began 2024 with Wilmington, before being reassigned to the FCL in May. He then joined FXBG after two outings in Florida, stayed with the Nats through the end of May, and jumped up to Wilmington for three appearances in early June. Diaz was then sent back to Fredericksburg on June 11th, and has been here ever since.

**QUITE THE START:** Diaz got his first start as a FredNat back on July 1st, and it was a memorable one. The lefty spun four perfect innings with six strikeouts, and got the ball rolling for the FredNats to carry a no-hitter through 26 outs against Delmarva.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Diaz was sharp in his aforementioned start against Delmarva last week, but the Shorebirds tagged him for three earned runs in 1.2 IP the second time they faced him.
