Noah Mendlinger had two hits and drove in three runs while Nathan Church and Jacob Buchberger extended their hitting streaks to nine and seven games, respectively. Nick Raquet gave Springfield 3.1 innings of shutout relief, while Andre Granillo picked up his third win and Matt **Svanson** his third save. The Cardinals improved to 8-0 at home this season.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

CARDS OFF TO BEST 17-GAME START SINCE AT LEAST 2005:

With a 14-3 record over their first 15 games, the Cardinals are off to the Texas League's best 16-game start since at least 2005, before which the day-by-day standings are no longer kept..

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week after a big series in Amarillo. The UC Irvine product went 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB. Church leads the Texas league in hits with 24, and also ranks in the top 10 in batting average, RBIs, total bases, and runs scored. In 79 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 5 times.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With

his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 204.

WE'RE GDING STREAKING!: Although Noah Mendlinger's 0-for-4 outing on Tuesday night snapped his 10-game hitting streak, there is a pair of Cardinals who are riding sizeable streaks. With a sixth-inning single on Wednesday afternoon, Nathan Church extended his hitting streak to 9 games, and has hit safely in 15 of the 16 games he has played in so far this season. Jacob Buchberger extended his own streak to 7 games with a single in the fourth inning.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 17 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in ten of them. Of those 10 games, the Cards have won 9, making them 9-1 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, the Cardinals have fallen into a 1-0 hole after the top of the 1st inning in six of their eight games at home. Springfield, of course, has come back to win all six of those games.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 17 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .284 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Bowie Baysox are next with a .271 average. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.378), OPS (.786), RBIs (98) and runs scored (108). Springfield has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally, with a league-high 11 sacrifice flies this season. The Cards' OBP is ahead of the next-best mark by 20 points (Tulsa Drillers, .358)

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cardinals have struck out just 122 times in 17 games, the fewest in the Texas League, five K's ahead of the Frisco RoughRiders. Springfield's total is the 4th-fewest total in MiLB, but the 2nd-fewest of clubs that have played 17 games, behind the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (High-A, Milwaukee Brewers) who have struck out 119 times. The Cards are averaging just 7.2 K's per game.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL: Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.09 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 20 HR so far this year, tied for the most in the Texas League with the Amarillo Sod Poodles.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the SprIngfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.

Cardinals skpper **Jose Leger** is back for his fourth year as manager in Springfield.


