Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, in their third season as the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, look to complete a season-opening three-game sweep in the series finale at the Great Lakes Loons, the High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Whichever team prevails today would break a 138-138 tie in the all-time series between the two clubs.

Starting Matchup: The Athletics' 2022 fifth-round selection, **Jack Perkins**, makes his Lansing debut, opposed by Loons left-hander **Justin Wroblewski**, a college teammate of Lansing outfielder **Caeden Trenkle** while at Oklahoma State and the Dodgers' 11th-round choice in 2021. Perkins has his own connection in the other clubhouse; he began his college time at Louisville, where he was teammates with the Loons' **Dalton Rushing**, before transferring last year to Indiana.

On Deck: Following a day off tomorrow, the Nuts open their home schedule with the first of a six-game series on a Tacos and Tallboys Tuesday, April 11, against the West Michigan Whitecaps, affiliated with the Detroit Tigers. The home opener will feature a Dixieland Band, a caricaturist, a magician, and more, raising the curtain on the Lugnuts' 27th home schedule since moving to Michigan's state capital from Springfield, Illinois.

LUG•NOTES

Meet the New Boss: **Craig Conklin**, the Nuts' Assistant Hitting Coach last season, is the 18th manager in Lugnuts team history. Hailing from Malibu, Calif., Conklin entered professional baseball as an area supervisor at the Major League Baseball Scouting Bureau. He then spent four years scouting Southern California for the Athletics before serving on the Triple-A Las Vegas Aviators' staff in 2019 and on the Single-A Stockton Ports' staff in 2021. This is his first season managing in Minor League Baseball.

Brooms at the Ready: The last time the Nuts swept a season-opening series was 2017, a four-game home-and-home sweep of these very same Great Lakes Loons. At that series' end, 18-year-old **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was hitting .417 with a 1.338 OPS while 19-year-old **Bo Bichette** was batting .400 with a 1.204 OPS, a sign of things to come. The Lugnuts also swept a season-opening series in 2012 from Great Lakes.

Singles Club: The Loons have nine hits through the first two games of the season. None are extra-base hits. Only the Quad Cities River Bandits among the MWL's other squads have yet to collect an extra-base hit this season.

Ready for a Roundtripper? No home runs have been hit in the first two games of this series, with the cold conditions having something to do with that. Number of games it took to see the first home run in a Lugnuts season: 2022 - four; 2021 - one; 2019 - three; 2018 - two; 2017 - one; 2016 - two; 2015 - two; 2014 - one; 2013 - one; 2012 - four; 2011 - one; 2010 - one; 2009 - six; 2008 - one; 2007 - one; 2006 - five; 2005 - two.

Fast Start: The Nuts lead the MWL with seven stolen bases, led by **Lazaro Armenteros's** four steals, more than eight of the 11 other teams. Meanwhile, **Max Muncy** is first in the league with three doubles (and for that matter, three extra-base hits period) and is tied for first with a .500 batting average.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: The Dragons walked off the Lugnuts for the second straight day to start the year, winning 4-3 on a throwing error by 3B Oliver Dominguez. The Lugnuts committed seven errors in the loss; 3B Mark Sobolewski made two, P Matt Fields made two, and there was one apiece on 2B Ryan Schimpf, C Karim Turkamani and 3B Oliver Dominguez, plus a passed ball charged to Turkamani. The miscues led to three unearned Dragons runs, including the game winner. (Note that this is not the franchise record. That's nine errors, committed June 13, 2003, vs. Fort Wayne.)

2018: Piggybacking reliever Donnie Sellers struck out 12 Fort Wayne TinCaps in five innings, and the Lugnuts opened up a four-game series at Parkview Field with a 10-1 win. The TinCaps' only run came from their first batter of the game, Jeisson Rosario, who hit an inside-the-park home run off Maverik Buffo. Kevin Smith and Cullen Large homered for the Nuts in the victory.

In a Nutshell: Jack Perkins makes his Lugnuts debut today, becoming the 905th all-time player to suit up for the franchise... one of four 2022 draftees on the roster; the others are 1st-rounder Daniel Susac, 4th-rounder Jacob Watters and 9th-rounder Caeden Trenkle... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann, Jeff Criswell, Jack Weisenburger and prospect OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading before being released... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother.

Glory Days: Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by the Cubs, but elected to attend college instead.

Study Skills: Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

Draft Day: Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
