TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Salt Lake Bees (Los Angeles Angels affiliate) meet for the first time this season in a six-game series beginning Tuesday night. The Express claimed their third series victory on Sunday night with an 8-7 win over the El Paso Chihuahuas. Round Rock jumped out to a 3-0 lead with two runs in the first, followed by a solo homer from INF Richie Martin in the second. El Paso nabbed a lead with four unanswered runs. C Anthony Vilar tallied a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the second and DH Will Wagner hit a three-run homer in the third. The Express plated three in the fifth, and the Chihuahuas followed with one. The Chihuahuas tied it at seven with a pair of runs in the seventh. In the top of the ninth, Round Rock broke the tie on an INF Diego Castillo RBI single and held on for an 8-7 victory.

WHERE WE STAND

The Express won their 3rd series of the season and 2nd against the Chihuahuas, taking 4 out of 6 last week...had lost their 3 previous series...are now 3-6-0 in series play this season...are 11 G below .500 and 10.0 G behind first-place Sacramento...7-7 in their last 14 G...7-14 in May.

WELCOME BACK, BLAINE

After being designated for assignment by the Colorado Rockies, INF Blaine Crim was claimed by the Texas Rangers and optioned to Round Rock on May 23...is slated to make his 296th start at first base for the Express, which is the most in club history...in Round Rock's Triple-A era (since 2005), ranks 2nd in RBIs (247), 3rd in walks (186), 4th in home runs (60) and T-4th in doubles (85).

GO, DIEGO, GO

INF Diego Castillo finished the El Paso series slashing .407/.484/.556 with 11 H (11-for-27), 4 2B, 8 RBI and 4 BB...since making his E-Train debut on May 1, has led the club in batting average (.300), hits (24) and RBI (13)...has hit safely in 12 of 21 G and tallied 14 G without a strikeout...his 10.9% strikeout rate ranks fifth and is T-3rd with 69 balls in play among PCL hitters this month (min. 75 PA).

BULLPEN BRILLIANCE

Last week against the Chihuahuas, the Round Rock bullpen posted a PCL-best 2.78 ERA with the most innings pitched (32.1 IP) and tied for the least earned runs (10)...RHP Michel Otañez threw 4.0 SHO IP without allowing a base hit...RHP Emiliano Teodo also posted 3 scoreless appearances (3.2 IP).

CODY'S RETURN

The 2025 Round Rock Express MVP and PCL All-Star is set to start at second base on Tuesday night after having his injury rehab assignment transferred from Double-A Frisco...Freeman led all of Minor League Baseball in batting average (.336) while pacing the club in hits (129) after making his Triple-A debut in 2025...began the 2026 season on the injured list due to a lumbar stress reaction...appeared in 7 G with ACL Rangers (4 G) and Double-A Frisco (3 G) prior to tonight.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, MAY 26, 1972

On a Friday night at Anaheim Stadium that drew only 6,325 fans, 24-year-old Nolan Ryan took the mound to face the Kansas City Royals. Despite lasting only 5.2 innings and walking nine batters while striking out just two, Ryan did not allow a run and earned the win as the California Angels defeated Kansas City, 10-5. Ryan walked nine or more batters in a game 10 times during his career, going 6-0 with a 2.30 ERA in those outings.

The Angels scored three runs in the first inning. "I guess Ryan just didn't know how to pitch with a lead," Angels manager Del Rice said. Rice was later ejected in the fifth inning for arguing balls and strikes. "I asked him where the pitch was, and he came over and challenged me. Those guys think they're God Almighty."

The Angels scored four times in the sixth inning on walks by Leo Cardenas and Sandy Alomar, singles from Bob Oliver, Lee Stanton and Ken Berry, a sacrifice fly by pinch-hitter Jim Spencer, and an error by Royals third baseman Paul Schaal. That proved to be plenty of run support for Ryan, as the Royals stranded 17 baserunners while Ryan threw 130 pitches in 5.2 innings. Andy Messersmith earned the save with a scoreless ninth inning. Here was the opening line written by Sid Bordman of The Kansas City Times: "Nolan Ryan, a fireballing right-hander who doubles as an escape artist."

LAST TIME OUT: vs SAC (5/14/26) (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 4 SO, 63 pitches, 43 strikes) surrendered a pair of runs on 3 hits in the 1st...in the next 4 frames, allowed 2 baserunners via a single and fielding error in the 5th ... went to his fastball 63% of the time (40 pitches) and tallied 7 of his 12 whiffs on the heater.... generated a 39% (14-36) whiff rate in his first start on 5/8 at DUR... Express lost 4-3 on walk-off walk by RHP Alexis Díaz for 8th consecutive loss.

- Opened 2026 on the Injured List with thoracic outlet syndrome... finished 2025 making his Triple-A debut appearing in three starts before making his MLB debut in Rangers regular season finale on September 28 at Cleveland (1.2 IP, 3 H, 4 R, 3 ER, BB, K)
- Did not see official action in 2024 after undergoing 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery in June 2024. Returned to the mound on July 3, 2025 in the Arizona Complex League before appearing in 6 starts with Double-A Frisco before his promotion to Round Rock.... It was the first time he had seen official game action since March 9, 2024 during Cactus League play.
- Owned a 3.65 ERA (5 ER/12.1 IP) in three starts for Round Rock to end 2025.... Went a combined 9.1 IP in final two starts and allowed just 1 ER.
- In 2023, set career highs in wins, innings, strikeouts and games as he claimed the Nolan Ryan Pitcher of the Year award at season's end... paced all Texas minor leaguers (min. 100.0 IP) in strikeouts per 9.0 (10.53), while also ranking highly among organization pitchers in strikeouts (2nd) and wins (T-3rd).
- Originally acquired by Texas from the Seattle Mariners, along with a player to be named later (SS Andres Mesa), in exchange for RHP Rafael Montero on December 15, 2020. Corniell was traded before he ever threw a pitch in the Mariners organization.
- Originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent out of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic on July 2, 2019. His signing bonus was the fifth-largest of the 2019-2020 international free agent class (\$630,000).
