RIDERS FALL IN WILD SERIES FINALE IN CORPUS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell 11-9 in a back-and-forth affair to the Corpus Christi Hooks, despite four hits and a home run from **Keyber Rodriguez** at Whataburger Field on Sunday. Rodriguez went 4-for-5 including a double and a go-ahead three run home run in the fifth inning. He also stole two bases and went 4-for-4 in steal attempts on the week. His four hits were a season-high in his 12th game played with Frisco this year. The Riders (22-17, 53-54) held three leads on Sunday but Corpus Christi (21-18, 54-54) took the lead for good in the sixth inning. Frisco had allowed just five runs through the first five games of the series but gave up 11 runs on 18 hits in the finale. Frisco totaled 12 hits. The first 10 pitchers of the game between the two clubs each allowed at least one run, until **Matt Bush** threw a scoreless eighth inning for Frisco and Jacob Delabio earned the save with a scoreless ninth for Corpus Christi. **Triston Polley** (2-2) took the loss, allowing two earned runs without an out in the sixth inning. Frisco had not scored on Saturday but pushed across a run in the first inning on Sunday. **Evan Carter** walked with one out in the first inning and later scored on **Kellen Strahm**'s two-out, two-strike base hit. Rodriguez led off the second inning with a double and came home on **David Garcia's** RBI single. After the Hooks matched Frisco's runs in the first and second innings, the Riders put two runs on the board in the fourth. **Jayce Easley** collected an RBI fielder's choice, and Frisco scored another run on a 4-6-3-5 triple play. Carter doubled in the sixth inning off the left center wall to score Easley from first base and make the lead 8-6. Easley doubled to lead off the eighth inning, his first hit in Double-A, and scored on **Aaron Zavala's** double. He also singled in the ninth inning and was the tying run at first base but was stranded to end the game. Corpus Christi finally put together productive at-bats against Frisco's bullpen, which had limited the Hooks to one run this series over 19.2 inning

NEW MONTH, NEW ME

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 12 games in August, (7-5 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 2.70 ERA while allowing a league-low nine home runs and .197 BAA. The bullpen has allowed just 13 earned runs over 59.1 innings, a 1.97 ERA with 87 strikeouts to 15 walks. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start on Wednesday, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat.

THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 40 games since, he is batting .301/.419/.503/.922 with 11 doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs and 32 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 39 points and his OPS 103 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 65 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.8 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 15 times in his last 14 games. His .406 OBP on the season is 10th in all of Double-A and among all 12 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 23 games, Hicks is batting .329 (27-for-82)/.421/.451/.872 with five doubles, a home run, 13 RBIs, 13 walks and 12 runs scored. In his last 10 games, he is batting .361 (13-for-36) with a .925 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 20 outings. During that stretch, he has 25 strikeouts to three walks over 21.2 innings while recording four saves. He has converted on all eight save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
