Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third game in a six-game series with the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, the 271st all-time meeting between the two teams. Great Lakes ended Lansing's five-game winning streak with a victory in the Tuesday opener; the Lugnuts then halted the Loons' six-game win streak last night.

Starting Matchup: Lansing starts right-hander Joey Estes, the 2021 Low-A East Pitcher of the Year acquired via trade with Atlanta before the season, against Loons right-hander Carlos Duran, making his 11th start for Great Lakes.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Loons 3. Brayan Buelvas crushed a two-run homer and Joshwan Wright lined a two-run triple in a pivotal four-run fifth inning against Great Lakes right-hander Antonio Knowles, lifting the Nuts to victory in front of 3,218. In defeat, Great Lakes DH Diego Cartaya hit his 12th home run.

Skipper for the Series: Lugnuts manager Phil Pohl is away for this week; Veronica Alvarez steps in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Oakland Athletics.

A's System Report:

- In Oakland, 2018 Lugnuts lefty Zach Logue allowed seven runs in 4 1/3 innings today, striking out two, in the A's 10-3 loss to Texas.
- In Triple-A Las Vegas, 2021 Lugnuts slugger Jordan Diaz made his Triple-A debut as the designated hitter last night, going 0-for-4 with a strikeout.
- In Double-A Midland, 2021-2022 Lugnuts pitcher Jeff Criswell pitched the final six innings in relief of Ryan Cusick last night, whiffing four while allowing three runs on six hits and two walks in a 3-2 loss to Amarillo.
- In Single-A Stockton, 2022 Lugnuts left-hander James Gonzalez struck out six batters in five innings last night, but allowed three home runs in a 7-4 loss to Lake Elsinore.

Updated Prospect List: MLB Pipeline has updated its Top 30 A's Prospects, with Max Muncy moving to No. 7, Denzel Clarke jumping up to No. 11, Joey Estes remaining stable at No. 16, Euribiel Ángeles now at No. 16, Brayan Buelvas now at No. 23 and Cooper Bowman remaining No. 29. Jorge Juan fell off the list entirely (though if yesterday's three hitless innings with five strikeouts serves as an indicator, only temporarily). The Athletics' top five 2022 draft picks, all likely future Lugnuts, were each ranked: first-round catcher Daniel Susac at No. 5, second-round outfielder Henry Bolte at No. 6, compensatory second-round outfielder Clark Elliott at No. 13, third-round outfielder Colby Thomas at No. 16 and fourth-round pitcher Jacob Watters at No. 27.

Running Men: CF Denzel Clarke and and 2B Cooper Bowman each stole second base last night, giving the Lugnuts four steals in two games and 24 steals in 30 attempts through 14 games in August, averaging just a little over two stolen bases attempts per game. The increasingly aggressive Lugnuts had eight stolen bases in April. 14 steals in May. 18 steals in June and 31 steals in July.

Amongst the League Leaders: The Lugnuts are third in the Midwest League in team batting average (.244) and third in base hits (877). Reliever Kumar Nambiar has 38 appearances, second only to West Michigan's Andrew Magno. Infielder Euribiel Ángeles is sixth with 96 base hits.

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame by request.

Inside the Park and Out of This World: On August 2-3, 2022, CF Denzel Clarke joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Major Leagues.

Roster Crunch: The Lugnuts have used 51 different players this year: 25 position players and 26 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers.

From Far and Wide: The Lugnuts include players from 10 different countries: USA, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, Mexico, Panama and Venezuela in addition to Puerto Rico and 11 different states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawai'i, Idaho, New York, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Washington.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Athletics via trade: Cooper Bowman (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22); Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22); and Joey Estes (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22).

To the Show: Nine former Nuts have debuted in MLB in 2022, 170 all-time: A's pitchers Zach Logue (2018) and Zach Jackson (2017) and infielder Christian Lopes (2013); Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018), catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019) and pitcher Max Castillo (2018); M's reliever Danny Young (2016); and Red Sox pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) and Marlins pitcher Jake Fishman (2017).


Personal: Signed for \$497,500 with the Atlanta Braves as the 487th overall selection in 2019... notable names taken in the 16th round: Oraj Anu, Kona Quiggle, DJ Gladney and Jackxarel Lebron... first ever player drafted out of Paraclete H.S... at age 17, was one of the youngest players in the draft, but had velocity already touching 96 mph... signed by Braves away from commitment to Long Beach State... wearing his hair longer than he's ever worn it in his life, and says it's because of his mother, who also has very long hair.

2019 Professional Debut: Made first MiLB appearance on July 20, shutting out the GCL Rays on one hit in two innings, striking out three... gave up five runs apiece over the next two outings before recovering with three perfect innings vs. GCL Orioles on August 5... allowed .300 avg. to left-handed batters, .241 to right-handers.

2021 Breakout: Named 2021 Low-A East Pitcher of the Year... established himself as the ace of the Augusta GreenJackets, though he began season as the No. 5 starter... led Low-A East in strikeouts (127), ERA (2.91), average (.184) and WHIP (0.96)... struck out 11 Myrtle Beach Pelicans in 5 2/3 IP on June 9... twirled seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits, striking out seven vs. Myrtle Beach on July 9... whiffed 10 Columbia Fireflies in 5 1/3 IP on July 21... fired nine-inning CG vs. Kannapolis on August 14 (9 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 14 K)... emphatic home/road splits: at home in Augusta: 0.81 ERA in 10 GS, 1 CG, 55 1/3 IP, 30 H, 5 ER, 2 HR, 11 BB, 76 K, .153 avg., 0.74 WHIP... on the road: 5.56 ERA in 10 GS, 43 2/3 IP, 36 H, 27 ER, 5 HR, 18 BB, 51 K, .221 avg., 1.24 WHIP... limited lefties to .148 avg.; right-handers batted .213.

2022 to Oakland: Traded by Atlanta to Oakland with OF Cristian Pache, C Shea Langeliers and P Ryan Cusick in exchange for 1B Matt Olson on March 14, 2022... Pache is in the Majors, Langeliers is in Triple-A and Cusick is in Double-A.

- Made unofficial debut for the Lugnuts in the 2022 Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental, tossing four innings against Michigan State on April 6: two hits, one run (a Peter Ahn solo HR), one walk and five strikeouts, as the Lugnuts won, 3-2.
- Made official Lugnuts debut in Game 1 of a doubleheader at West Michigan, April 14... departed one out into the 5th with a 7-2 lead (though reliever David Leal then allowed an inherited runner to score); Nuts went on to triumph 8-5
- May 21 at Great Lakes: was spinning a gem (5 1/3 IP, 1 R, 7 K) before getting injured (hip) fielding a swinging bunt up the third base line... on the Injured List, May 23-June 12.
- Last time out: August 11 at Dayton... gave up two-run homer to Austin Hendrick with one out in the 4th inning but nothing further in five fine innings at Day Air Ballpark... struck out five Dragons after only whiffing one Whitecap in five innings in his previous start... 74 pitches, 50 strikes... Lugnuts rallied back from 2-0 deficit with a run in the 6th and four in the 7th for a 5-4 win.
- Outstanding at holding runners on; opposition has been caught stealing in four of five attempts.



- MLB Pipeline ranks Estes as the No. 16 prospect in the A's system and the No. 6 pitching prospect... grades: fastball 55, slider 50, changeup 45, control 50... "All of Estes' stuff is trending in the right direction. He averaged 93.5 mph with his fastball in 2021, a good tick or two harder than in 2019 when he first entered pro ball, and it has unique characteristics and good life. At times, he relied on overpowering Low-A hitters just with the fastball, and other times, he mixed in an effective slider with better depth as well. There was some variability to it, thrown anywhere in the 82- to 87-mph range, with Estes having more success with it when he started throwing it a little harder. His changeup also improved, though it's still his third pitch.'
- Keith Law had ranked Estes as the Braves' No. 15 prospect: "Drafted out of a California high school, Estes has gained about 2 mph since he was drafted, topping out now at 96 with good quality on the pitch and a slew of strikes. He struck out nearly a third of the guys he faced in Low A and did that mostly with his fastball, as his slider and changeup are still works in progress, with neither an average pitch yet. He has a super-short arm action and can come from a slightly lower slot, neither of which is ideal for a starter, but neither of which is a reason not to start him — they're just atypical. If he can improve those secondaries without changes to his delivery, which might in turn affect his control, he could be a back-end starter.'
- Fangraphs places Estes at No. 21: "In Estes, Oakland acquired one of the Braves' breakout players from the 2021 campaign. A 16th-round pick in 2019 out of a California high school, Estes signed for a bonus of just under \$500,000, and that investment looks to have paid off handsomely after he put up a 32% strikeout rate in his full season debut. Estes doesn't blow you away with his stuff, but all three of his offerings are average to a tick above. His fastball was up and down much of the season, as he sat in the low-90s in some outings and was more 93-95 mph at his best. His low-80s slider ranges from fringy to plus, as he'll show occasional ability to put big sweep on the pitch, while his changeup is a bit firm but features good tumble. The three-pitch mix is made all the more effective by unpredictable sequencing and command of the entire arsenal that is well advanced for a pitching prospect who doesn't turn 21 until October. Estes has a back-end starter ceiling, and only injury should prevent him from reaching that mark.
