LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their second-consecutive contest to the Somerset Patriots by an 11-3 final on Thursday. Bowie matched a season-high by allowing five home runs to Somerset. Both Aaron Palensky and Trey Sweeney hit solo home runs, while T.J. Rumfield, Everson Pereira, and Jeisson Rosario each mashed a two-run bomb. All three of the runs scored by the Baysox were also via the long ball, as Anthony Servideo and Ramon Rodriguez hit back-to-back home runs to lead off the bottom of the third inning, before Donta' Williams added a solo shot in the fourth. However, Bowie struggled to capitalize on other chances throughout the night, as the Baysox left the bases loaded twice and stranded 11 runners altogether in the defeat. Right-hander Peter Van Loon went four frames and took the loss for Bowie, while Somerset's right-handed starter Richard Fitts picked up the win after 5.1 frames.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter tonight's game with a 44-26 record - the best across the Eastern League and good enough to clinch the first half title in the Northeast division. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has been powered by its pitching staff this season, which holds a league-leading 3.70 ERA, while allowing the fewest home runs (53) across the league and accumulating the most strikeouts (701). Offensively, the Patriots have hit the most home runs (108) and stolen the second-most bases (132) - both notable weaknesses of this Baysox team. Somerset's roster is highlighted by six of the Yankees' top 10 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY/ No. overall), C. Austin Wells (No. 2 NYY/ No. overall), OF Everson Pereria (No. 4 NYY), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), RHP Richard Fitts (No. 8 NYY), and RHP Yoendrys Gomez (No. 9 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Matt Sauer is set to take the ball for the Patriots tonight. It will be just the second start with Somerset in 2023 for Sauer tonight, as the right-hander opened the first two months of the season on the injured list. In his season debut with the Patriots this past Friday against New Hampshire, Sauer went 4.1 innings, allowing just one run on two hits with no walks and five strikeouts while throwing 52 pitches. Last season, Sauer started 18 games with High-A Hudson Valley, pitching to a 3.77 ERA before promotion to Somerset in August. There, Sauer pitched to a 7.84 ERA in four starts, being placed on the injured list just before the Patriots' championship run in early September. The No. 20 prospect in the Yankees' system, per MLB Pipeline, and a second round pick of New York in 2017 out of Righetti High School in Santa Maria, California, Sauer features a low-90s fastball, mid-80s slider, high-70s curveball, and a mid-80s changeup.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. At the midway point, Mayo leads Minor League Baseball with his 42 extra-base hits, while his 26 doubles pace the Double-A level. The No. 8 Orioles/ No. 80 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, is coming off back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards, hitting .440 across those two weeks with six home runs, seven doubles, and 13 RBI. Mayo also leads the Eastern League in both slugging (.594) and OPS (1.020), while sitting second in on-base percentage (.426).

TANDEM TROUBLES

The abundance of starting pitching experience on the Bowie roster has led to a reliance on tandems at times this season. Despite a collective starters' ERA of 3.79 - the best in the Eastern League and third-best at the Double-A level, when Baysox starters enter the game as relievers, they sport a collective 5.61 ERA. Bowie has utilized a tandem in 38 games thus far in 2023, going 19-19 in those contests. The back end of tandems have blown six leads for the Baysox this season, while failing to go two innings on nine occasions, and allowing four runs or more in 13 different contests.

HOME RUN HOBBLES

The Baysox pitching staff has struggled this season when it comes to the home run ball, particularly within the confines of Prince George's Stadium. Bowie arms have allowed 87 home runs overall this season - third-most in the Eastern League. Of those 87 home runs, 61 have come at home - the second-most allowed by a team at home in the league (Reading - 64). Meanwhile, Somerset leads the Double-A level with its 108 home runs. The Patriots have launched 22 more long balls than the second-highest total in the Eastern League (Erie - 86).

STAY HOT, SERVIDEO!

Anthony Servideo is 8 for his last 18 at the plate, with a pair of multi-hit games, and an extra-base hit in three-consecutive contests for the first time in his professional career. Last night, Servideo mashed his first career Double-A home run and just the third long ball of his career overall. Servideo has six multi-hit games in the month of June, after having just six in his entire three-year career entering the month. Servideo's June has seen his batting average jump 48 points and his on-base percentage climb 46 points.

QUICK HITS

- Opened the season with 13 consecutive scoreless innings, currently the longest scoreless streak for a Baysox pitcher this season.
- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft.
- Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- 4/12 Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- 4/18 Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- 4/25 Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- 5/2 Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- 5/7 Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- 5/13 Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escape bases loaded in the fourth.
- 5/19 12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning) Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hofman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.
- 5/26 For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.
- 5/31 Once again started with three hitless innings, but walked three batters. Walked a fourth batter in the fourth before allowing a single and sacrifice fly.
- 6/8 Allowed an early run through two early hits and a ground out. Only allowed one more hit over the next four innings.
- 6/11 Allowed runs in the second and third innings, both with two outs. Retired the side in the fourth.
- 6/17 Struck out seven batters over his first three innings. Allowed only run in the third inning, but stranded two runners in scoring position in the frame.
- 6/23 Used 22 pitches against the first four batters for two walks and two strikeouts. Needed 11 more pitches while allowing back-to-back singles, and had to be lifted in the first inning.
