Home for the Holiday

The Fightin Phils return home for their final series at FirstEnergy Stadium before the All-Star Break through Sunday against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the 13th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and sixth-of-11 at America's Classic Ballpark. Entering play on Tuesday, Reading leads the season series over New Hampshire 7-5, which includes a 3-2 record in Reading and 4-3 mark in Manchester.

Series Victory

The Reading Fightin Phils closed out their road trip with a 9-4 victory over the Altoona Curve, scoring seven unanswered runs to earn their first road series win of the season and extend their winning streak to four games. Reading built an early 2-0 lead in the third on RBI hits from Alex Binelas and Erick Brito before Altoona answered with four runs, highlighted by Duve Gourson's three-run homer. The Fightins tied the game in the fifth on Raylin Heredia's RBI double and a Binelas groundout, then broke it open with a five-run seventh inning. Aroon Escobar delivered the go-ahead two-run homer, Brito added an RBI double, Kehden Hettiger lifted a sacrifice fly, and Bryan Rincon capped the rally with an RBI single to extend his on-base streak to 24 games. Braydon Tucker allowed four runs over five innings in a no-decision before Estibenzon Jimenez earned the win with a scoreless inning of relief. Every Reading starter recorded at least one hit, while Escobar, Binelas and Brito each drove in two runs as the Fightins improved to 34-41 overall and moved into a tie for first place in the Eastern League Northeast Division second-half standings.

Wood You Believe It

Phillies No. 2 Prospect, and top pitching prospect, Gage Wood makes his seventh start with Reading this season. Wood has posted a 3.92 ERA (9 ER, 20.2 IP), along with 29 strikeouts (12.63 SO/9.0 IP). Entering play on Tuesday, Wood ranks sixth amongst Phillies Minor Leaguers in strikeouts with 69 and is tied for second in games started with 14. Wood also is now ranked 55th in MLB Pipeline's newest Top-100 rankings, which dropped on Monday.

What a Week for Binelas

Alex Binelas completed a stellar week at Altoona with two-more hits on Sunday. Over the six games last week, Binelas slashed .407/.448/.889 (1.337 OPS), along with nine runs, four doubles, three home runs and eight RBI. Binelas had a hit in five-of-six games and collected two-or-more hits in four of the contests. The highlight of the week was a four hit and four RBI night on Saturday, which included his 18th home run of the season. Binelas is also currently riding a 19-game on-base streak, dating back to June 7 and has a .315 average and .412 on-base percentage over the streak. Entering play on Tuesday, Binelas is 10th in the Eastern League in average (.281), T-2nd HR (18), fifth RBI (47), 4th OBP (.398), 8th SLG (.554), 3rd OPS (.952), T-6th BB (43) and seventh total bases (128).

Bryan Gets on Base

With a base hit on Sunday, Bryan Rincon extended his season-best on-base streak to 24 games. The Phillies' 27th ranked prospect's on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil this season and is the tied for the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League amongst players who are still playing for their teams. The shortstop is has posted a .352 on-base percentage over the streak, which dates back to May 19. Rincon's 24-game on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil since Keaton Anthony had a 25 game on-base streak from May 11-June 10, 2025. It was a streak that never ended as Anthony was promoted to Lehigh Valley (AAA) on June 11, 2025.

Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia finished up a strong week at Altoona with two hits, and his 22nd double of the season on Sunday afternoon. Over six games against the Curve, Heredia slashed .310/.333/.552 (.885 OPS), along with four runs, one double, two home runs and four RBI. He had hits in the final five games of the week, along with multiple hits in the last three contests of the series. Entering play on Tuesday, Heredia is second in the Eastern League in hits (82), leads the league in doubles (22) and extra-base hits (37), while ranking second in total bases (148) and tied for ninth in runs (45).

What a Week for the Offense

It was a banner week for the Fightin Phils offense at Altoona. Through the six games last week, Reading posted an Eastern League-best .310 batting average, while scoring 7.8 runs per game, a mark that also led the league. After scoring just eight runs through the first two games of the week, both losses, Reading rattled off 39 runs over the final four games of the week, all victories.

Smashing Their Way into the History Books

The Fightin Phils hit a season-high six home runs on Saturday night at Altoona. It was the most home runs that Reading hit in a single-game since they also hit six on May 25, 2018, at Portland. The R-Phils slugged 12 more home runs last week, a mark that led the Eastern League. Through 75 games, Reading is second in the league with 98 home runs and is on pace for 180 this season, after hitting 118 in 205.

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters play today with a 38-35 record, along with a 4-2 mark in the second half. The Fisher Cats took four-of-six games against Somerset last week, and following this week, they return home to face Portland. New Hampshire's roster features seven of the Blue Jays top-30 prospects: Gage Stanifer (5), Victor Arias (10), Fernando Perez (16), Javen Coleman (22), Cutter Coffey (23), Danny Thompson (25) and Adrian Pinto (29).

New Hampshire Tone Setter

Blue Jays No. 15 prospect Nolan Perry (RHP) makes his Double-A debut on Tuesday night. Over 12 appearances (11 starts) between Dunedin (A) and Vancouver (A+) this season, Perry was 3-3, with a 2.61 ERA (15 ER, 51.2 IP), along with 78 strikeouts (13.68 SO/9.0 IP). Perry's last start with Vancouver came on June 23 at Hillsboro, where he allowed three runs over three innings, whils suffering the loss. Perry did not pitch in 2025, but spent his 20-year old season with Dunedin (A) in 2024, going 1-1, with a 2.93 ERA over 14 starts. He began his pro career in 2023 with the FCL-Blue Jays (ROK). The 22-year old was drafted by Toronto in the 12th round of the 2022 draft out of Carlsbad High School in New Mexico.
