

**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, this week at PNG Field. Manager Raul Dominguez is back to guide the Patriots for a third season after leading them to playoff appearances in each of the last two seasons. The Yankees prospect group is highlighted by OF Spencer Jones, ranked as the No. 2 prospect in their minor league system according to MLB Pipeline. Former Penn State Nittany Lion Bailey Dees is back with Somerset as well. No. 12 RHP Cam Schlittler, No. 17 C Rafael Flores, and No. 25 RHP Trystan Vrieling round out the prospect group.

\*THE\* Baron Stuart takes the ball for Somerset on Friday night. Stuart played collegiatelly at South Florida (3 years) and at Pitt (1 year) before signing with the Yankees in the summer of 2022. After dominating out of the bullpen for Pitt, Stuart has coverted into a starting pitcher in pro ball and has made 42 of his 44 appearances as a starter. Stuart was one of Hudson Valley's top arms in 2024, earning a 3.63 ERA in 22 starts and striking out 102 batters in 109.0 innings. Stuart hails from Okeechobee, FL.

**JE-"BB"**: Curve utilityman, Mitch Jebb, enters play on Friday, August 18 2nd in the Eastern League with 11 walks drawn. Jebb has used his selective eye at the plate to give him more opportunities on the base paths where he's picked up 5 stolen bases in 6 tries to begin the season. He's reached base via hit or walk 18 times and has a .400 onbase percentage in 10 games.

**DAY GAME BATS**: Altoona earned 28 baserunners in a 10-1 win over Somerset on Wednesday, April 16. The team drew 11 walks, the most since May 25, 2018 against Harrisburg (12 BB), and picked up 14 hits. Four different Curve hitters had multi-hit games and everyone in the lineup reached base at least twice.

**RAISIN BRAN**: Infielder **Jack Brannigan** has reached base safely in 9-of-11 games played for the Curve swatted his first homer of the season on Wednesday, April 16 vs. Somerset. Brannigan has two 3-hit games in his first 10 games played this season, he had three last season in 77 games at Greensboro.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson became the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve, when he arrived on August 27, 2024 in Curve, PA. This season, Johnson opens as the youngest in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson's 85 walks last season were 9th-most by a minor league player and he's reached base safely in 18-of-24 games with the Curve. Johnson has a hit in 9-of-10 games to begin the season.

**OUT FOR A WALK**: Altoona hitters are T-1st among all Double-A clubs with 67 walks in their first 12 games of the season.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters have a 0.99 WHIP, 1st among Double-A staffs and 3.04 ERA, 4th among Double-A clubs.

**PROSPECT PARTY:** Seven Curve players are ranked among the Pirates Top 30 according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Termarr Johnson (No. 4 MLB/No. 5 BA) headlines the group, which also features LHP **Hunter Barco** (No. 7/No. 10), INF **Jack Brannigan** (No. 11/No. 14), INF/OF **Mitch Jebb** (No. 13/No. 14), LHP **Anthony Solometo** (No. 14/No. 15), RHP **Alessandro Ercolani** (No. 21 BA), RHP **Wilber Dotel** (No. 27 BA).

THE TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH ALTOONA: Three Curve alums, RHP Thomas Harrington (4/1, PIT), LHP Omar Cruz (4/1, SD), and INF Tsung-Che Cheng (4/9, PIT) have all made their major league debut this season, totaling 220 alumni who have gone onto the major leagues.

**WE'LL SEE THEM ALL**: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.



### **ALTOONA CURVE COACHING STAFF**

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

### Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

### Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor.
