### JACKSONVILLE DOMINATES GWINNETT IN 14-2 WIN

The Jumbo Shrimp bashed four home runs en route to an easy 14-2 win on Wednesday over the Stripers. After Jacksonville scored two in the first inning, **Jared Serna's** three-run bomb made it 5-0 in the second. Both **Rece Hinds** and **Johnny Olmstead** blasted two-run shots during a five-run fifth. Hinds hit another two-run long ball during a four-run sixth to make it 14-0. Two late Gwinnett runs in the ninth set the final margin at 14-2, matching the largest margin of victory for the Jumbo Shrimp this season. **Braxton Garrett** went 6.0 shutout innings to earn the win.

### SO, ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Jacksonville had scored only 14 runs (2.3 per game) while hitting just .184/.286/.292/.578 as a team in their previous six games heading into Wednesday's contest with Gwinnett. The Jumbo Shrimp turned things around in a huge way, racking up 14 runs, their third-most in a game this season, in a 14-2 victory over the Stripers. During last night's contest, **Rece Hinds** became the fifth Jacksonville player to record a multi-homer game this season while the club matched single-game-highs this season in both home runs (4) and extra-base hits (7).

### APRIL SHOWERS BROUGHT MAY (& JUNE) FLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp lost for the eighth time in 11 games on April 30 at Durham, dropping the club to an overall record of 14-16 (.467). Jacksonville has responded by rattling off 22 wins in the last 35 games (.629 winning percentage), tied for the fifth-most wins in Triple-A since May 1. During this stretch, Jacksonville has collectively outscored their opponents 208-169 (+39) and outhit them by a 310-258 margin (+52).

### ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

**Matthew Etzel** got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 29 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 33-for-112 at the plate, slashing a robust .295/.383/.527/.910 with three doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 25 RBIs, 16 walks and 28 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks fifth in the IL in runs, tied for seventh in RBIs, tied for 15th in hits, tied for 18th in homers, 24th in OPS and 25th in slugging.

### MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point, however, has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 88 steals in the last 41 games are far and away the most in Triple-A since April 24. Second-place Gwinnett's 73 steals rank as close to eighth-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (58) as they do to the Jumbo Shrimp in first.

### THE SCRIPT HAS FLIPPED

In 2025, Jacksonville starting pitchers tossed only 603.1 of the club's 1,304.0 innings (46.3 percent), the seventh-fewest frames from lid-lifters for any Triple-A team. The approach fit the team's mold; the Jumbo Shrimp's 3.83 starting pitcher ERA ranked second in Triple-A, with the club's 3.64 ERA from its bullpen pacing the level's respective relief corps in 700.2 innings - the fifth-most of any bullpen. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has taken the lion's share of work. Jacksonville starters have worked 298.2 innings, the second-most of any starting staff in Triple-A (51.9 percent of the team's total of 575.0 innings). Thus, the 276.1 innings from the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen is tied for the third-fewest of any Triple-A relief corps. The difference in work has not made much of a difference in terms of results; Jacksonville starters have combined for the third-best ERA (4.16) at the level, with the bullpen ranking sixth at 4.20.

### PINTAR-EST

Over his first 20 games on the season, **Andrew Pinar** was just 15-for-81 at the plate, slashing a woeful .185/.295/.235/.530 with two doubles, one triple, seven RBIs, 13 walks and nine runs. The BYU product has changed his season around significantly since then; over the last 30 games, Pinar is 33-for-112 (.295/.396/.536/.932) with seven doubles, one triple, six homers, 23 RBIs, 18 walks and 24 runs scored. Since this hot streak began on April 28, Pinar ranks 16th in the IL in OPS and 18th in slugging.
