LAST TIME OUT

Rochester, NY (September 1) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell 2-1 to the Rochester Red Wings in ten innings on Friday night. For the second straight night, the contest went into extras this time behind Will Warren's six shutout innings.

The teams worked a pitcher's duel through seven innings of work with just five hits allowed combined. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre got on the board first in the eighth inning. Estevan Florial smoked a double to left center field for his first hit of the night. Carlos Narvaez followed with an RBI single for a one run advantage.

The Red Wings punched right back with a run scoring base knock from Richie Martin to tie things up at one.

For the consecutive nights the game went into extras. In the bottom of the tenth inning, Jordy Barley was the pace of play runner on second. Cody Wilson laid down a sacrifice bunt, but Michael Gomez sailed the throw to third and Barley raced home to score. The Red Wings won 2-1 in ten innings.

Jackson Rutledge pitched five shutout innings for Rochester. He allowed two hits while striking out seven. Luis Reyes gave up a run in the eighth inning, but Tim Cate (W, 1-0) finished the game scoreless for the win.

Will Warren tossed six shutout innings in his start. He allowed just one hit and a pair of walks while striking out six. Anthony Misiewicz let up an unearned run in his inning and two thirds of work. Nick Ramirez had a clean outing. Michael Gomez (L, 1-5) gave up the winning run on an error in the tenth.

NEWS & NOTES

BEETER'S BEST - Clayton Beeter tossed a career high 99 pitches in his last start against Lehigh Valley. It was the second time he had thrown that many offerings in a contest. Beeter has seen Rochester once this season at PNC Field when he pitched six innings of one run ball. He didn't receive a decision as the RailRiders went on to lose that contest. The righty struck out seven and did not walk a batter in his first no free pass start of the season.

ONE RUN MAYHEM - The RailRiders have totalled 16 wins and 16 losses in one run ballgames this summer. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has won three of these tight contests against Rochester and lost two of them in 2-1 games this week.

SPLIT EXTRAS - The RailRiders and Red Wings played back-to-back pitcher's duels that went scoreless into extras. On Thursday night, the RailRiders played four runs in the top of the tenth to win their second extra innings contest of the season against Rochester. The first game in ten frames on June 16 at Innovative Field. Last night, the Red Wings took the contest walking things off on an error in the bottom of the inning. No team could plate a run through the first seven innings of the game.

STEALING SWIPES - The RailRiders have gotten on a roll taking extra bases on the diamond. They have totaled twelve in four games taking six yesterday. The team has combined for 151 steals with Estevan Florial leading the way for 23 total. Last summer, SWB set a new franchise record with 172 taken.

AHEAD ON THE FARM - Matt Bowman has recorded 44 appearances for the RailRiders out of the bullpen this season. It is the most for a reliever in the entire Yankees farm system. Bowman was placed on New York's 40-man roster on July 20th. Aaron McGarity has had 43 outings for second most in the organization. Andres Chaparro has each played a career-high 119 games this summer to lead all the Yankees Minor League affiliate players.

POST SEASON PROMISE - The RailRiders are now just 2.5 games back from first place in the International League with a 30-24 record. They sit in eighth place behind the leading Durham and Lehigh Valley. SWB made up ground after splitting the week with the WooSox and then taking six of seven from the Iron Pigs. The RailRiders go into the last month of the season at .500.

ANOTHER YOUNG DOWN - The RailRiders a handful of September birthdays on the calendar. Franchy Cordero turns 29 on September 2nd, while his teammate Jesus Bastidas has his 25th on September 14th. Defensive coach Jose Javier celebrates his birthday on the 16th and the RailRiders manager Shelley Duncan's occurs on September 29th.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb being the latest. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospects making their first appearances in Triple-A season. Will Warren (#10), Clayton Beeter (#16), and Edgar Barclay (#28) are all essential parts of the starting rotation for the majority of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's season.

ORIGINALLY DRAFTED: Selected in the Competitive Balance B-Round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech... received a \$1.2 million signing bonus, over the \$1 million slot value for the No. 66 overall selection... Competitive Balance Round B pick was acquired as part of the Dodgers' February 2020 trade with the Minnesota Twins

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2023: In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP, breaking his previous career mark of 5 IP, set in his final two starts of 2022. In the performance, Beeter started the Patriots' second shutout win of the season.
- 2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER)
- 2021: Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
