SATURDAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats dropped its first series of the season, falling to Portland 6-1. **Will Robertson** delivered his first two hits of the series, including his first home run of the season in the sixth, the only run of the game for the Fisher Cats. **Sebastian Espino** also collected his first hit of the season and threw out two runners trying to stretch singles into doubles from right field.

STRIKING OUT SEA DOGS: Fisher Cat pitchers have recorded 55 strikeouts in the five games of the series thus far. New Hampshire's pitching staff is second in the Eastern League in ERA (2.88) and fourth in the Eastern League in total strikeouts (84). The Fisher Cats have also allowed only one home run this season, which is the fewest in the Eastern League.

KING KLOFF: Sunday starter **Adam Kloffenstein** makes his second start of the series this week against Portland. He received the loss on Tuesday, April 11, pitching four innings, allowing five hits, six runs (four earned), four walks and striking out four. Last year, Kloffenstein struck out 21 Sea Dogs hitters over 17 innings pitched in four starts.

LATE-INNING MAGIC: The Fisher Cats have had a flair for scoring late in the game, scoring at least one run in the seventh inning or later in seven of their eight games this season. New Hampshire has scored 13 runs in the seventh inning or later to start off 2023.

ROSTER AT A GLANCE: The Fisher Cats active roster features five of the Top 30 Blue Jays prospects, according to MLB.com: **LHP Ricky Tiedemann (No. 1)**, **IF Orelvis Martinez (No. 4)**, **RHP Sem Robberse (No. 7)**, **RHP Adrian Hernandez (No. 23)**, and **IF Damiano Palmegiani (No. 29)**. Players come from 13 different states, one US territory (Puerto Rico), and four countries outside the US (Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Mexico, Netherlands).

MUST-SEE MARTINEZ: **IF Orelvis Martinez** is ranked the No. 4 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2023 season. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native hit a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010). Martinez was second in the Eastern League in home runs and had four multi-homer games.

CESAR MARTIN LEADS FIELD STAFF: Manager **Cesar Martin** is leading the Fisher Cats for a third straight season. Pitching coach **Drew Hayes** and hitting coach **Mitch Huckabay** are in their first season in New Hampshire, while position coach **Chris Schaeffer** returns for his third season in Manchester. The Fisher Cats hit a team-record 166 home runs in 2022.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (April 16, 2019) – New Hampshire won 4-1 in Binghamton, holding the Rumble Ponies off the board until the bottom of the ninth inning. Hector Perez went five scoreless with seven strikeouts for the win and Kirby Snead recorded the final out for his first save. Josh Palacios and Santiago Espinal each had a double an RBI and Kevin Smith homered off future Blue Jays Anthony Kay.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (10-5) defeated Tampa Bay 5-2 to win the weekend series. Yusei Kikuchi struck out nine in six strong innings of work... Buffalo (AAA) lost their fourth straight and their third in the series to Rochester 7-6. Former Fisher Cat Spencer Horwitz collected his first RBI of the season...Vancouver (A+) defeated Tri-City 5-3 in six innings due to rain....Dunedin (A) defeated Tampa 5-1 to take a three games to two series lead.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats hit the road for their second road trip of the season for a six-game series at Somerset, beginning on Tue. Apr. 18. The next home stand begins Tuesday, April 25 vs Hartford. Promotions include Bark in the Park night, Atlas Fireworks, Gatos Ferooces de New Hampshire night, and a Phone Grip Giveaway, courtesy of Coca-Cola Beverages Northeast.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his season debut on Tuesday (4/11) against the Sea Dogs. Allowed six runs, four earned, in his 4+ innings. Allowed five hits, walked four and struck out four.

v. PORTLAND – Losing pitcher Tuesday – also Made four starts against the Sea Dogs in 2022, going 0-2 with a 7.41 ERA. Allowed 25 hits in 17.0 IP, but did have 21 K's. Had a season-high ten strikeouts against Portland on 7/23 at Delta Dental.

2022: -Earned first Double-A win with 5.0 IP scoreless 8/16 at Hartford. Pitched season-high six innings in first quality start vs. Erie 8/10..Struck out 10 Sea Dogs in New Hampshire's 5-3 win July 23, but did not earn decision as Fisher Cats won the game late...Made Double-A debut in a relief outing in Erie May 21....Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

2021: Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

2019: Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Klof made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, 23 BB, 64 K. WHIP 1.09. .204 average against.

2018: Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

Obtained: Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus.

Personal: Ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
