Last Time Out... Hudson Valley scored five runs in the bottom of the sixth inning to pull away from the BlueClaws in Fridays 7-inning game 7-1, handing Jersey Shore their sixth straight loss, matching their longest losing streak of the season... Anthony Hall had two hits and two RBIs in the win for Hudson Valley while Cam Schlittler earned the victory. allowing one run in six innings... BlueClaws starter Mitch Neunborn took the loss. allowing two runs. one earned in. in five innines of work.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws have dropped six in a row for the second time this season (they lost six straight through July 2nd to Greensboro [4] and Wilmington [2]...Still, since July 3nd they are 13-10 and are in fifth place, just three games behind first place Greensboro in the SAL North (and 1.5 games out of the second postseason spot)...The BlueClaws are two games under .500 in the second half for the first time since they were 7-9 after July 9th.

Hittin' Hendry...Hendry Mendez has hit safely in six straight games, over which he is 10-24...He is 27-74 since July 1st and had two hits on Wednesday and three on Thursday at Hudson Valley... He hit his first BlueClaws home run on July 6th...He had a four-hit game on July 4th, his first four-hit game of the year while driving in four of the BlueClaws 15 runs...He has six multi-hit games in the current stretch (he had one between May 30th and July 2nd)...The 20 year old came to the Phillies with Reading IF Robert Moore for Brewers IF Oliver Dunn in November.

Troy Going Deep...Troy Schreffler has two home runs in this series (Tuesday/Thursday) giving him six on the season...lersey Shore hit one home run from July 3th through July 29th (Schreffler on July 13th against Wilmington) after they hit four on July 6th, but they have three in this series – two by Schreffler and one on Wednesday from Felix Reyes, his sixth of the year (five of which have come since June 16th).

From the Plains to the Shore...Bryson Ware, the Phillies 8th round pick last year from Auburn, has joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater, where he was hitting .201 with nine home runs and 41 RBIs with 33 walks in 308 plate appearances...Ware has started games for Clearwater and 18. 28. 38. St. Ft. and C.

Welcome, Moisés...Moisés Chace will start Saturday in his organizational debut...Chace, who was with Aberdeen, has been acquired by the Phillies and assigned to Jersey Shore...Chace was in the deal that sent LHP Gregory Soto to the Orioles and came over with RHP Seth Johnson (now with Reading)...Chace, a 21 year old from Venezuela, was 2-2, 3.46 with Aberdeen, striking out 76 batters in 52 innings...He faced the BlueClaws in his last appearance, allowing one run in three innings with seven strikeouts on Thursday at ShoreTown Ballnark

Acquired by Trade...While the BlueClaws have had several players over years acquired via trade (including current BlueClaw Hendry Mendez (November 2023 from Milwaukee) and 2016 BlueClaw Harold Arauz (December 2015 from Houston in Ken Giles trade), Moisés Chace is the first in-season trade acquisition to play for the BlueClaws since IF Hunter Stovall (for LHP James Pozos from COL in April, 2019)...CI Henry was the last deadline acquisition make his organizational debut with the BlueClaws, acquired in the Bobby Abreu deal from the Yankees at the deadline in 2006 (he was with Charleston, then the Yankees Low-A affiliate in the South Atlantic League).

Zach Attack...Zach Arnold is now 25-68 since July 1st with five multi-hit games, nine RBIs and six walks (he hit .163 in June and .237 in May)...He also has two stolen bases since July 26th after having just one leading into that game...Arnold was a 14th round pick last year from the University of Houston.

The Hittin' Hawkeye...Keaton Anthony had three hits on Wednesday, his second three-hit game with the BlueClaws, and is now 34-93 (.366) with the BlueClaws since arriving on June 26" with 10 multi-hit games...He had a walk-off single last Tuesday against Aberdeen...He was hitting, 322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...At the time of his promotion, led the Florida State League in OBP (.446) and OPS (.916) while third in SLG (.470) and fourth in BA (.322)...He signed as an NDFA from the University of Iowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

Walk-Off, Wrong Way...The BlueClaws have lost two games in walk-off fashion since the break (July 19th at Brooklyn and July 31st at Hudson Valley), and five on the year...On Wednesday, they led by three and gave up four in the ninth...On July 19th at Brooklyn, they led by five and gave up five in the ninth, then lost in the 10th inning...The BlueClaws do have one walk-off win after the break – July 23rd vs Aberdeen on a Keaton Anthony RBI single in the 9th.

Strong From the Start...Jersey Shore is 13-10 in their last 23 games...In those games, BlueClaws starting pitchers are 8-6 with a 304 ERA...In 118.1 innings, they have allowed just 40 earned runs on 85 hits and 40 walks while striking out 119.

On Rehab... C Andrick Nava, who began the season with the BlueClaws, is back on a rehab assignment... He is 2-16 on his rehab assignment and hit. 314 with three home runs before his promotion to Double-A Reading in June... With Reading, he was 6-31 in 13 games before going on the IL on July 13th.

Three for Trent...Trent Farquhar of Michigan State University had three hits on Sunday, two doubles, and is now 6-31 with five walks and four HBPs so far with Jersey Shore...He was hit by three pitches in his BlueClaws debut on July 20th, matching a team record set by Nick Ward on 6/6/23 against Hudson Valley at ShoreTown Ballpark...Farquhar, signed as a NDFA last year from Michigan State, began the year with Clearwater, where he was hitting .314 in 32 games with 35 walks and 26 strikeouts through 32 games...He had been on the IL since May 30th before his promotion on Saturday.

Viars Joins the BlueClaws...Jordan Viars, a 3rd round pick in the 2021 draft (Reedy HS, Frisco, TX), joined the BlueClaws

last week (4-227so far)...He had an RBI single on July 20th and a hit and two runs scored on July 12th...Viars was hitting .252 with Clearwater, adding 12 home runs and 39 RBIs at the time of his promotion..He had a three home run and nine RBI game on 5/30 vs Lakeland.... At the time of his promotion, he was tied for third in the FSL with 12 home runs, first in slugging percentage (.491), and second in OPS (.846)...He turned 21 years old on Thursday, July 18th.

Paxton on the Mark...RHP Paxton Thompson joined the BlueClaws on July 2nd and has thrown 10 innings without allowing an earned run (one unearned) with Jersey Shore so far, including 1.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts on Tuesday at Hudson Valley...He threw two scoreless innings on July 3nd in his BlueClaws debut...He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he 1-2 with a 3.62 FRA in 19 appearances...He struck out 30 and walked nine in 27.1 innings with the Threshers...Thrompson signed with the Phillies last year from UNC-Charlotte where he helped them reach the NCAA Tournament last year and he threw three scoreless innings in the Regionals to eliminate #3 Clemson.

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (30 HRs in Lakewood and 33 on the road) have two this week from Trov Schreffler (6 on the season)...They got a home run from Felix Reves, his 6th, on July 31st (five have come since June 16th)... They hit four home runs on July 6th against Wilmington - one each from Emaarion Boyd, Justin Crawford, Hendry Mendez, and Leandro Pineda... Aidan Miller hit a leadoff home run in the game on July 4th...Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda (now with Reading) has eight.

Hitting Triple Digits...A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches seven times in a game this season - all seven are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading)

earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14th... Gunner Mayer has four while Charles King has two.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year - July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws got a two-out, two-strike hit from Keaton Anthony and a two-strike RBI double from Felix Reyes on July 21st at Brooklyn to tie the game, that they would win 9-6 in 10 innings...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15^{th} to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th - one by Justin Crawford (May 30^{th}), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9^{th}), and one by

Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws had five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his ex-teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester



From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017... Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Season Notes: Joined the BlueClaws on 7/31 from Baltimore after being acquired in a trade on Deadline Day...In his last appearance with Aberdeen, he gave up one run in three innings against the BlueClaws on 7/27 at ShoreTown Ballpark...Had five different outings with Aberdeen in which he threw four innings without allowing an earned run (all in April/May)...His final numbers with Aberdeen: 2-2, 3.46 ERA, 52 IP, 37 H, 30 BB, 76 Ks...First player to join BlueClaws via in-season trade since Hunter Stovall (from COL in 2019) and first to join via deadline trade since CJ Henry (from NYY in 2006).
