- Jupiter defeated Dunedin 3-1 on Sunday afternoon at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium to take a six-game sweep. The Blue Jays have now lost nine consecutive games.
- Gage Stanifer made his Single-A debut, starting for Dunedin on the bump. He made a strong first impression with a 1-2-3 first frame.
- Jupiter got on the board first in the bottom half, scoring twice. Colby Shade started the scoring with an RBI single, and Cristhian Rodriguez followed with a sacrifice fly.
- Eliander Alcalde took over for Stanifer after the second inning, and fired three scoreless, hitless frames.
- Jupiter added a run to its lead in the sixth, as Shade picked up another RBI knock to push the deficit to 3-0.
- The Blue Jays loaded the bases with two outs, and got a run on an error to make it 3-1, but left the bases loaded.
- The Jays went 0-10 with men in scoring position in the loss, stranding 11 runners on.

### SLLLLLLLIDING

After ripping off six consecutive victories from April 6 through April 12, the Blue Jays have dropped nine straight, dating back to last Friday (4/19) vs Clearwater. The nine-game skid is tied for the longest active losing streak in MiLB (Altoona, AA-PIT).

### SWEPT AWAY

Last week's sweep of the Blue Jays marked the first time Dunedin has ever been swept in a six-game series. The six-game series era began in 2021.

### OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

Dunedin's offense has sputtered across its nine game losing streak, scoring just 19 runs (2.1 per game) while batting .194 with an OPS of .544. In the eight games prior to the losing streak, the Jays tallied 63 runs (7 runs per game).

### IT'S GOOD TO SEE YOU

In the first series between Dunedin and Tampa (April 9-14), the Jays were dominant, taking five of six games while outscoring the Tarpons 47-19. The Jays batted to a team OPS of .732 in the set and stole 21 bases.

### DEATH BY PAPER CUTS

Of Dunedin's nine consecutive losses, four have been decided by two or fewer runs. All nine have been decided by four or fewer.

### LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

Today's starting pitcher, LHP Connor O'Halloran, is the son of former Major League catcher Greg O'Halloran, who had a brief stint with the Florida Marlins in 1994. Both O'Hallorans made their professional debuts with the Dunedin Blue Jays: Connor last season, and Greg in 1990.

### WALKIN' ON SUNSHINE

This week's series pit the Florida State League's leaders in walks drawn and walks issued against each other. Tampa's 115 walks at the plate lead the league, ahead of Dunedin's 107. On the mound, the Blue Jays and Tarpons share the league lead for walks issued with Bradenton at 111.

### POWER SURGE

Tucker Toman has belted three homers in 17 games played in 2024. In 2023, Toman homered just five times in 114 games. Despite a .182 batting average, Toman has hit the ball hard consistently, boasting a 44% hard hit rate (percentage of balls hit 95 MPH or harder). The mark ranks ninth in the FSL among players with more than 40 plate appearances.

### WHAT A RELIEF!

Blue Jays relievers were strong in last week's series at Jupiter, posting a 2.13 ERA (6 ER) in 25.1 innings of work. Dunedin's 3.35 bullpen ERA ranks second in the league behind Daytona's 3.08.

### YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoza joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

### COMING UP THE PIPELINE

The D-Jays roster is loaded with eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The 30-man roster includes the Jays' last two first round draft picks; LHP Brandon Barriera (2022) and Infielder Arjun Nimmala (2023). Nimmala is ranked as the third-best prospect in the system, while Barriera is ranked fourth. Opening Day starter Fernando Perez is Pipeline's No. 24 Blue Jays prospect, after leading the FCL Blue Jays in innings pitched in 2023.

### ABOUT CONNOR

- Selected by the Blue Jays in the fifth round of the 2023 draft out of Michigan... Played three seasons with the Wolverines.
- Native of Mississauga, Ontario - one of three native Canadians on the Dunedin roster. Played on the Canadian 18U national team for three seasons, from 2018-2020.
- Dad, Greg O'Halloran, was drafted by the Blue Jays in 1988. Made professional debut with Dunedin in the 1990 MiLB season. Eventually debuted and played 12 games as a catcher with the Marlins in 1994.
- Also played hockey and volleyball growing up, but chose baseball.
- Throws from a low, three-quarter slot... fastball sits in the low-to-mid 90s, with a slider in the low 80s, along with a mid-80s change.

### 2024 SEASON

- Marks first full season as a pro...
- Opponents have hit just .111 against Slider...
- Took the loss in last start, 4/23 at Jupiter. Allowed runs in first three innings of the game before finishing with two scoreless.
- Earned second straight victory on 4/16 vs Clearwater - allowed 2 ER in second inning before finishing outing with three scoreless frames.
- Made first start of season at Tampa on 4/9 - allowed first inning run and finished outing with four straight scoreless frames... struck out career-high 7 batters.

### 2023 SEASON

- Jumped FCL to make pro debut with Dunedin in August...
- Made six appearances with Blue Jays; five coming out of the bullpen. Posted 6.30 ERA in 10 innings... opponents hit just .205.
- Lone start came on 9/5 vs Jupiter - pitched two innings, allowed 2 ER while walking 3.

- Played three seasons at Michigan, pitching to a 4.98 ERA in 202.1 career innings as a Wolverine.
- Was named the Big 10 pitcher of the year for 2023, firing a 4.11 ERA across 103 innings of work. Struck out 110 batters while walking just 26. Pitched 7 or more innings six times, including a complete game vs Michigan State on 4/22. Struck out 10+ on three occasions.
- Made 18 starts in 2022, turning in a 5.44 ERA in 92.2 innings of work.
- Pitched just 6.2 innings in freshman season (2021). Allowed 9 ER.
- Earned scholarship offer after Michigan coaching staff saw him pitch in a game for Team Ontario against Team Michigan in 2018... Pitching coach Chris Fetter was originally there to scout Team Michigan.
