Today is a Grand Slam School Day, the second of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the Quad Cities River Bandits, High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The Lugnuts won the opener yesterday in memorable fashion and enter today on a three-game winning streak.

Yesterday: Locos 7, River Bandits 4. Steven Echavarria set a new career high with 6 2/3 innings, and Rodney Green Jr. broke a 4-4 8th-inning tie with a 490-foot home run into a balcony on the second floor of the Outfield Loft apartments, the longest tracked home run of the 2026 MiLB/MLB season, to launch Lansing to victory.

LUG-NOTES

Milestone Watch: Lansing is two wins from the 2,000th victory in Nuts history and two players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster boasts four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**).

Welcome to Lansing: The 998th Lugnut was 21-year-old **Myles Naylor**, who joined the Lugnuts from Single-A Stockton and made his Midwest League debut as the Nuts' left fielder yesterday, going 0-for-2 with a pair of walks. The 39th overall selection in the 2023 draft, Naylor was batting .375/.464/.708 in six games this month for the Ports, with three doubles, one triple and one home run. Overall, he slashed .274/.373/.476 with four doubles, two triples, three homers and three stolen bases in 22 games for the Ports.

Green Power: Rodney Green, Jr.'s home run was the longest in Lansing since a Joshua Mears 504-foot home run on Sunday, April 24, 2022, for the Fort Wayne TinCaps, which soared to left-center over Good Hops. It was also Green's first home run since he blasted a pair on Opening Day against Dayton on April 2.

Moving On Up: Bobby Boser and **Davis Diaz** were each promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday, making their debut this morning as the RockHounds' No. 7 and No. 8 hitters... and they hit back-to-back home runs in a 9-7 victory! Boser and Diaz became the first two Lugnuts position players to be promoted to this season. Boser and Diaz were not the only players to make strong first impressions with a new team; **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** made his 2026 Triple-A debut yesterday for Las Vegas, going 3-for-5 with a double.

Bolting to the Show: 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte** put together a remarkable 12-for-12 streak from May 7-9 for Triple-A Las Vegas en route to a Major League callup to the Athletics. The streak was part of a ridiculous hot stretch for Bolte: 25-for-42, five doubles, one triple, five homers, .595/.622/1.119 in the month of May. Should the 22-year-old Bolte make his debut tonight for the A's against the Cardinals, he will become the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season.

That's Quality: Steven Echavarria's 6 2/3-inning gem yesterday not only marked a career long for innings pitched, it was his second quality start of the season against Quad Cities and the Lugnuts' third consecutive quality start, following on the heels of **Tzu-Chen Sha** (6 IP, 3 R) and **Nathan Dettmer** (6 1/3 IP, 0 R) on May 9-10 at South Bend.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with the Giants before landing on the Injured List on April 21. The 202nd Lugnut to reach the Majors was 2024 southpaw **Eduardo Rivera**, who was called up for emergency relief purposes and tossed 3 1/3 scoreless innings against the Yankees on April 22.

2025: Down to their final strike against South Bend, the Lugnuts rallied to force extra innings on a Joshua Kuroda-Grauer two-run double, and Rodney Green, Jr. lined a walkoff RBI single in the 10th for a 7-6 win.

Last Game / Stats Dive: turned in his second start of the year with five scoreless innings, blanking South Bend on Wednesday, May 6: 77 pitches, 45 strikes (3 hits, 2 walks, 2 K)... overall 9.75 ERA/.411 avg. at home, 1.84/.185 on the road... allowing .328 avg. with bases empty, .269 avg. with runners on base... lefties are hitting .321 / righties .278.

Before College: Batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI as a senior at Westbrook Christian High School, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first time in school history)... threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K... Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American... pitched for 2019 USA Baseball 16U National Team Development Program.

College: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.

Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 as the 290th pick in 2025, the fifth pick of the 10th round... one of seven Tigers drafted, led by Orioles first-rounder Ike Irish... made pro debut on August 21, 2025, vs. Lake Elsinore with one hitless innings, one walk, two strikeouts... after two scoreless relief appearances, finished the year with three short starts, fanning five in 1 2/3 innings vs. Visalia on September 7 in final appearance... right-handers were 3-for-17 (.176) with eight strikeouts, lefties went 4-for-12 (.333) with five strikeouts.
