### CAPTAINS LOG

**LAST TIME OUT:** On Wednesday night, Lake County tallied a season-high 18 hits and RHP **Trenton Denholm** went 8.1 innings, the longest outing by a Captain this year, in a 12-3 win against West Michigan at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

**Denholm** recorded his 4<sup>th</sup> quality start of the season, spinning a career-high 8.1 innings, allowing 3 runs on 5 hits, striking out none and walking just 1 in 91 pitches (66 strikes).

2B **Nate Furman** notched his 3<sup>rd</sup> 4-hit game of the season, tying his career-high for the 4<sup>th</sup> time (all with Lake County), and SS **Jose Devers**, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, hit a pair of 2-run home runs for his first career multi-home run game at the professional level.

After the game was tied 1-1 heading to the bottom of the 4<sup>th</sup>, the Captains outscored the Whitecaps 10-3 in innings 4 through 7.

**DOMINANT DENHOLM:** *Denholm's 8.1 innings pitched on Wednesday are the most by a Lake County pitcher since RHP Joe Colon also pitched 8.1 frames on 5/14/2012 vs. Great Lakes.* Denholm is the first Captain since at least 2005 to throw 8+ innings without recording a strikeout.

**THE DEVERS DOUBLE:** INF **Jose Devers's** 2 home runs on Wednesday marked his first multi-home run game in 209 professional games. The Samana, D.R. native had just homered once in his previous 128 High-A at-bats.

**JAKE RAKES:** CF **Jake Fox**, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, has recorded back-to-back 2-hit, 3-RBI games. Fox is batting .400 (4-for-10) with 2 doubles and 6 RBI so far this series.

**2024 VERSUS WEST MICHIGAN:** Lake County leads the season series 8-3 through 11 games. The Captains took 2 of 3 games from April 6-7 at home, and won 5 of 6 road contests from April 23-28. *Lake County is a perfect 8-0 in games that follow a West Michigan series-opening win.*

**2-OUT HITTING:** On Wednesday night, the Captains recorded 3 hits and 2 RBI with 2 outs. *Lake County's .284 AVG with 2 outs this season leads all High-A, Double-A, and MLB teams, and ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in Minor League Baseball.*

**21<sup>ST</sup> SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL:** 2024 marks the 21<sup>st</sup> season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,775 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,396-1,379 (.503).

**WINNING WAVES:** The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

### TRENDS & NOTABLES

**YOU MAY BE RIGHT, GUY'S MAY BE CRAZY:** But it just may be a Lipscomb that you're looking for. With his 11<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the year on Tuesday, *Captains OF Guy Lipscomb leads all of High-A with both a .452 AVG and a .527 OBP.* He has reached base in all 16 of his games played this month, and is sporting a 7-game hitting streak.

**FURMANATION:** Lake County INF **Nate Furman** extended his hit streak to 10 games in Tuesday night's loss versus West Michigan, tied with Beloit INF Josh Zamora for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. Furman is the only player in the MWL with multiple hit streaks of 10+ games. *He is batting .522 (22-for-46) with 5 homers and 13 RBI during the hit streak. Additionally, his 24 hits since May 10 are the most in Minor and Major League Baseball.*

**ALL ABOARD THE TUGBOAT:** On Tuesday, Cleveland announced the promotion of Lynchburg LHP **Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson** to Lake County. *Wilkinson, a 10<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2023 out of Central Arizona JC, leads Minor League Baseball with 71 strikeouts and 5<sup>th</sup> with a 1.12 ERA through 8 starts with Single-A Lynchburg.* The Vancouver, B.C. native fanned a season-high 15 batters on April 25 versus Myrtle Beach (Cubs Single-A).

**TOP QUALITY:** Through 41 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 12 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are tied for most in High-A and tied for 9<sup>th</sup> in MiLB. RHPs **Austin Peterson** (4), **Trenton Denholm** (3), and **Carter Spivey** (3) have each recorded at least 3, while LHP **Parker Messick**, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, has also recorded 1 this season (4/25 @ West Michigan, W).

**BASH BROS 2.0:** Captains INF **Alex Mooney**, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus**, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, have accounted for 31.0% of Lake County's RBI, while hitting 12 of the team's 31 home runs.

**STRONG STARTING PITCHING:** Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-4 in the Midwest League in: wins (14, 1<sup>st</sup>), fewest walks (49, 1<sup>st</sup>), innings pitched (196.0, 2<sup>nd</sup>), and WHIP (1.29, 4<sup>th</sup>).

**WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY:** Captains hitters have been having a strong season at the plate so far this season. The team ranks top-3 in the Midwest League in: AVG (.266, 1<sup>st</sup>), OPS (.761, 1<sup>st</sup>), OBP (.359, 1<sup>st</sup>), hits per game (8.9, 1<sup>st</sup>), fewest strikeouts (308, 2<sup>nd</sup>), runs per game (5.3, 3<sup>rd</sup>), and SLG (.402). *The Captains rank 4<sup>th</sup> in MiLB with a .284 AVG since April 30.*

**LAST TIME OUT:** On May 17 at Lansing, **Austin Peterson** (5-2) recorded his 1<sup>st</sup> loss since April 13 at Fort Wayne. He pitched a season-low 2.2 innings, allowing season-highs of 10 hits and 7 earned runs, while striking out a season-low 1 in the 8-4 loss. **Peterson** threw 44 of 57 pitches for strikes (77.2%), not surrendering a walk for his 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive start.

**QUALITY CONTROL:** 4 of **Peterson's** 5 starts since April 24 have been quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer ER). He is 1 of 3 Minor League pitchers with 4 quality starts in this span.

**OFF TO A STELLAR HIGH-A START:** Through his first 8 High-A starts, **Peterson** ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in: innings pitched (44.1, 2<sup>nd</sup>), wins (5, tied for 2<sup>nd</sup>), strikeouts (42, tied for 5<sup>th</sup>) and WHIP (0.99, 6<sup>th</sup>). The right-hander ranks also tied for 4<sup>th</sup> in all of Minor League Baseball with a 14.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

**AGAINST WM IN '24:** **Peterson** is 2-0 in 2 starts against the Whitecaps, allowing 2 runs while punching out 16 to just 2 walks in 11 innings of work. In his season debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 6, **Peterson** struck out a career high-tying 9 batters. In his 2<sup>nd</sup> start against the 'Caps while on the road on April 24, he posted his 1<sup>st</sup> quality start of the season in the 4-2 win.

**CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK:** **Peterson** was [named the third-ever Captain of the Week, presented by Official League](#) on May 6. He went 1-0 in two starts against Fort Wayne, pitching a combined 13.2 scoreless innings, allowing just 7 hits and 1 walk, and throwing 9 strikeouts in 150 pitches (115 strikes). **Peterson's** 13.2 shutout frames were the most from a pitcher across Minor League and Major League Baseball from April 30 through May 5.

**2023 IN REVIEW:** **Peterson** made 24 starts with Single-A Lynchburg last season, which were tied for the most in the Carolina League with RHP and fellow Hillcat Alonzo Richardson, as well as Charleston RiverDogs (TB) RHP Marcus Johnson. **Peterson** recorded 4 quality starts, which were tied for the third-most in the Carolina League.

**A STAR IN STORRS:** After making 25 appearances at Purdue in 2019 and 5 appearances at Wabash Valley Community College (IL) in 2020, **Peterson** was a 2-time All-Big East pitcher at UConn. In just 2 seasons with the Huskies, he struck out 226 batters, tied for the 6<sup>th</sup>-most in program history. In 2022, the right-hander was named a 1<sup>st</sup> Team NCBWA All-American, NCBWA District Co-Player of the Year, New England Pitcher of the Year, and 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Big East. In his final year with the Huskies, **Peterson** struck out a program-record 147 batters, the 3<sup>rd</sup>-most in the country. He also went 8+ innings in 3 starts. In 2021, **Peterson** was named 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Big East, ranking 4<sup>th</sup> in the conference with a 2.58 ERA, and leading the conference with 33 strikeouts looking.

Two former Lake County Captains have been promoted to the Cleveland Guardians during the 2024 season.

**OF Johnathan Rodríguez:** On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut at home against the New York Mets.
