**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a six-game set with Reading.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Reading's Griff McGarry struck out 10 in 7.0 scoreless innings and the Curve dropped a 4-1 decision on Friday night. **Abrahan Gutierrez** had two hits and **Lolo Sanchez** accounted for the lone run with an RBI single in the 9th.

**THE BIG LEFTY:** Altoona welcomed lefty **Anthony Solometo** to their roster on Saturday, June 17 and he promptly struck out seven in 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut at Somerset. At 20 years, 6 months and 15 days, he is the 2nd-youngest player in the Eastern League behind Somerset's **Jasson Dominguez** (20 years, 4 months and 10 days), however, Solometo struck him out three times in their matchups on June 17. Solometo tossed 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings early in his Curve career, a streak that ended on July 6. He leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.51 ERA and 96 strikeouts.

**MARTIN'S BIG IMPACT:** First baseman **Mason Martin** matched his career-high with three walks and knocked a critical solo homer in the 8th inning to help Altoona secure a 4-3 win over Reading on Thursday, July 20. Martin matched his career-high in walks for the fourth time this season and also made his first professional appearance in the outfield since his debut season in 2017 when he made 13 appearances for the GCL Pirates. Through 66 games this season, Martin's .371 on-base percentage is the highest mark of his professional career since his debut season in 2017 when he recorded a .457 OBP in 39 games. Since June 29 (14 games) he's batting .298/.431/.574/1.005 OPS with 1 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI, 8 BB, 22 K and 1-2 SB.

**A GROUP EFFORT:** Altoona's fourth shutout win of the season came on July 18 against Reading as seven Curve pitchers combined on the 4-0 win. **Braxton Ashcraft**, **Sean Sullivan**, **Noe Toribio**, **Justin Meis**, **Grant Ford**, **Tyler Samaniego** and **Oliver Garcia** set the franchise record for most pitchers to throw in a Curve shutout win in a 9-inning game.

**SECOND HALF SWINGS:** Since beginning second half play on June 28, the Curve have several players among the Eastern League Leaders. **Matt Frazier** has hit safely in 8-of-11 July games and ranks 11th in the EL in Batting Average (.302), and 13th in OBP (.393). **Mason Martin** is 3rd in the league in OPS (.987) and 4th in OBP (.424) and **Matt Gorski's** 4 HR's rank T-4th.

**TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH CURVE, PA:** With Pittsburgh's promotions of **Endy Rodriguez**, **Quinn Priester** and **Liover Peguero** over the last three days, the Pirates roster features 15 Curve alumni as of play on July 18. In Priester's debut on July 17, all but one player in the starting 10 suited up as a minor leaguer for Altoona (Carlos Santana). 9 of the current 25 Pirates have suited up for Altoona since the beginning of the 2021 season.

**EXTRA RUNS:** The Curve have allowed the most runs in extra innings this season in the Eastern League, allowing 19 runs in 10 extra innings. Altoona has scored 13 runs of their own and are 5-4 in games that have gone to extras.

**STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE:** Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Saturday, July 22, Altoona has struck out 686 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 4th-fewest in minor league baseball.

**THE FIGHTINS BABY, THE FIGHTINS:** Al Pedrique manages the 2023 Reading Fightin Phils, a former major league infielder with the New York Mets, Pittsburgh Pirates (1987-88 where he was a teammate of Barry Bonds) and Detroit Tigers, he previously managed in the Eastern League with the Trenton Thunder in 2015. He also managed the Diamondbacks on an interim basis in 2004. He spent the last two seasons with the Marlins managing the Triple-A Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in 2021 and as the Marlins third base and infield coach. Top prospects for the Fightins include: No. 2 RHP Mick Abel, No. 4 RHP Griff McGarry, No. 9 OF Carlos De La Cruz, No. 14 OF Ethan Wilson, and No. 17 RHP Andrew Baker, No. 18 PF Jhailyn Ortiz, No. 20 RHP McKinley Moore and No. 21 RHP Orion Kerkering.

**THE FIRST FIGHTER:** David Parkinson, the organizational leader in strikeouts with 80, takes the ball for the Fightin Phils on Saturday night. Parkinson struck out 10 in 6.0 innings in his first start following the All-Star Break last Friday against Portland. Parkinson was Philadelphia's 12th round pick in 2017 out of Ole Miss and is back on the mound after sitting out the 2022 season for Personal Reasons.

## TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2006 - Ron Chiavacci pitches five innings of relief during a 4-0 loss at Bowie and strikes out nine hitters, the most in a game by a reliever in team history.

2007 - Steve Pearce tied Ronny Paulino's franchise record 33-game on-base streak with a 3-hit, 3-RBI game; Went 0-for-4 on 7/23 to break it.

2021 - Rodolfo Castro plays his final game with the Curve, going 0-for-3, at Somerset before joining the Pirates taxi squad and eventually the active roster when Adam Frazier is traded to San Diego. Castro batted .300/.349/.527 with 12 2B, 1 3B, 11 HR and 41 RBI in 53 games with Altoona.

Matched his career-long outing with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball against Akron on May 11... Did so again in his next outing on 5/17 at Bowie, retiring 15-of-16 batters to begin his start... Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on 5/23 vs. Hartford, took a no-decision after leaving with a 3-0 deficit and Altoona rallied for 6 runs in the 8th in a 6-3 win... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Placed on 7-Day IL on 6/9 (retro 6/8) with a calf injury, activated on 6/16... Matched his career-high with 7 runs allowed (4 earned) on 6/22 vs. Bowie... Made his first appearance post-All Star break in a one-inning relief outing on July 18 vs. Reading...
