Tonight: The Lugnuts play the fourth in a six-game series through Sunday in Dayton, the fourth of 24 meetings this year between the two ballclubs. The Nuts won the first two games of the series, but Dayton struck back last night to drop Lansing one game out of first place in the High-A Central East Division. Former Wake Forest Demon Deacon **Colin Peluse** makes his first start of the season for the Nuts opposite Dayton right-hander **Spencer Stockton**, who is also making his first start of the season.

Last Night: Dragons 4, Lugnuts 2. Dayton starter **Graham Ashcraft** whiffed nine Lugnuts in 5 1/3 innings, **Jose Tello** homered, and Dayton halted Lansing's four-game winning streak on Thursday night. In defeat, **Richard Guasch** struck out six batters in four innings and **Jack Weisenburger** fanned two in a scoreless eighth, giving him 10 K's in four innings this season.

Ten Games, Nine Starting Pitchers. Tonight **Colin Peluse** will become the Lugnuts' ninth different starting pitcher utilized this season, with only **Brady Basso** (May 5, May 12) making more than one start in the first ten games of 2021. The other starters: **Seth Shuman** (May 4), **Richard Guasch** (May 6), **Reid Birlingmair** (May 7), **Jeff Criswell** (May 8), **Stevie Emanuels** (May 9), **Rafael Kelly** (May 10) and **Shohei Tomioka** (May 13). Basso, interestingly, was a reliever who was converted to being a starter in Spring Training, in contrast with the eight other pitchers.

1 and 2 in the High-A Central: Dayton's offense ranks 1st in the league in batting average (.263), slugging (.424), total bases (126), hits (78), runs (50) and home runs (11) -- but the Lugnuts are right there with the Dragons, leading the league in doubles (25) while ranking 2nd in total bases (121) and slugging (.394). The Nuts also lead the league in pitching ERA (2.56), innings pitched (81.0), fewest walks (21) and GO/AO ratio (2.07, best in all of Minor League Baseball).

LUG*NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020). The Athletics had previously partnered with Lugnuts rivals Burlington (1963-1974, 2011-2012), West Michigan (1994-1996), Kane County (1993-2010) and Beloit (2013-2020).

Meet the Boss: **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

A Trio of Michiganders: **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielders **Michael Guldborg** and **Jake Suddleson** are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** and first baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldborg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger**, Michigan; **Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year. On Saturday, Simoneit caught Peluse, forming a full Demon Deacon battery.

2012: A triple play in Dayton! With the Lugnugs leading 4-0 at Dayton in the bottom of the sixth inning, the Dragons put runners at first and second with none out. Ryan Wright attempts to lay down a sacrifice bunt, but popped it up. Catcher Carlos Perez grabbed it out of the air, fired to second baseman Jon Berti to double off Juan Perez and Berti relayed to first baseman K.C. Hobson for the third out. The Nuts won the game, 4-2, improving to 26-11.

2018: Kevin Smith delivered a game-tying solo home run in the eighth and then a game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth for a 4-3 win over the Dayton Dragons. He finished 3-for-4, raising his batting average to .387.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing. His command has always been solid going back to his days at Wake Forest, and it showed up in his debut season in the Class A Short Season New York-Penn League, walking just six batters across 24 innings. Approaching his first full season in the Minors in 2021, Peluse will get a chance to show what he can do with his improved repertoire. His repeatable delivery projects him to stick as a starter."

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of 10 Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McCall), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Last Outing: Piggybacked Jeff Criswell and Shohei Tomioka on the fifth day of the season, May 8th vs. Lake County, tossing three scoreless innings in the Lugnuts' 2-0 four-hit shutout victory... worked with catcher William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... entered in the sixth inning with a 2-0 lead, retiring the first two hitters with a strikeout of Jose Tena before walking Bryan Lavastida -- but promptly picked Lavastida off first base... bore down in the seventh after a two-base error by left fielder Shane Selman put George Valera immediately into scoring position, setting down the next three batters to strand Valera at third... allowed a leadoff single to Gianpaul Gonzalez in the eighth but again retired three straight hitters to strand the runner... opened the ninth with two straight walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the win with two strikeouts and a comebacker.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.

Hometown: Middletown, Delaware, is in New Castle County, located in the northern part of the state just across from the Maryland border... it hosts the Olde Tyme Peach Festival each August and the Big Ball Marathon every Labor Day (a 24-hour baseball marathon for charity played with an oversized softball, the "big ball")... St. Andrew's School in Middletown was the site for the filming of Dead Poets Society (1989), starring Robin Williams, with the theater scene in the movie filmed at Middletown's Everett Theatre... there was also an episode of The West Wing filmed at St. Andrew's School... Tampa Bay wide receiver Chris Godwin is from Middletown and attended Middletown H.S.
