Today's Game

The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series at the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It is the sixth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and the last-of-six at Prince George's Stadium in Bowie. Reading went 3-6 against the Baysox in 2024, going 1-2 in Bowie and 2-4 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Chesapeake returns to Reading from Aug. 26-31. Chesapeake leads the season-series 3-2.

Game 83/84 Recap

The Fightin Phils split Saturday's doubleheader at Chesapeake, winning game one 3-2, then dropping the second contest 8-3. In game one, Jean Cabrera tossed a gem, allowing one run on three hits over six innings of work. Reading scored a run in the first from an Alex Binelas RBI single, then another in the second when Paul McIntosh doubled home Caleb Ricketts. The R-Phils picked up an insurance run in the sixth when Caleb Ricketts doubled home Hendry Mendez to make it 3-1. Jaydenn Estanista allowed one run in the seventh, but preserved the lead to earn his first Double-A save. In game two, Mitch Neunborn started and was roughed up. He allowed a career-high eight runs on eight hits, while also surrendering a career-most four home runs. He did strikeout a season-high six in the loss. Chesapeake got two home runs in the first inning from Carter Young and Doug Hodo. Then, Max Wagner homered in back-to-back at bats, with one in the third and fourth innings. Reading did plate three runs late, scoring two in the sixth and one in the seventh inning. Carson DeMartini doubled and Hendry Mendez launched a two-run home run, his seventh of the season. Mendez had three hits in the second game. In the seventh Cade Fergus, Erick Brito and Robert Moore hit three-straight singled, and Fergus scored on a Carson DeMartini doubleplay to make it 8-3.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller has become a threat on the basepaths this season. Miller is alone in first place in the Eastern League with 34 stolen bases, a mark that is tied with Lehigh Valley's Oscar Mercado for most in the Phillies organization. After his 34th stolen base on Saturday, Miller has stolen the most bases in a season by a R-Phil since Quintin Berry stole 48 in 2009. The last Fightin Phil to steal 30+ in a season was Johan Rojas in 2023 and the last to swipe 31 in more in a year was Roman Quinn in 2016.

Cabrera Cruising

23-year old Jean Cabrera, who is on the Phillies 40-man roster, turned in perhaps his best start of the season on Saturday night, earning his fourth win of the season. Cabrera allowed one run on three hits over six innings of work, with six strikeouts. After throwing 30 pitches, walking two and allowing a run in the bottom of the first, Cabrera managed to throw just 47 pitches over his final five innings of work, while allowing just two more hits and retiring the final 12 batters he faced. Over his last four starts, Cabrera is 3-0, with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER, 23.0 IP). If it was not for a ninth-inning blown lead at Somerset last Saturday, Cabrera would have four-straight wins. Entering play on Sunday, Cabrera ranks seventh in the Eastern League in ERA (3.47), 5th in strikeouts (85), tied for first in starts (17), tied for first in IP (90.2), third in opposing batting average (.199) and 8th in WHIP (1.20).

King of the Hill

Chuck King turned in yet another stellar start on Friday night for the Fightin Phils. King matched a season-high with six innings pitched, while allowing just one run on three hits. He also struck out a season, and career-best six batters. King sent the Baysox down 1-2-3 in five-of-six innings on Friday night. Friday marked the fifth quality start for King this season (6+ IP, 3 ER or less) for King this season, all coming in his last nine outings. It also was the ninth-straight outing for King that he surpassed five innings, this comes after not pitching more than 2.0 IP in an appearance in 2024. King enters play on Sunday tied for sixth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (79.2 IP) and tied for seventh in winning percentage (.571).

He's Fergalicious

Cade Fergus launched Reading's second grand slam of the season in Thursday night's game two win over Chesapeake. The R-Phils other grand slam in 2025 came from Trent Farquhar on May 10 at Binghamton, which also came in a doubleheader. Fergus' grand slam was the fourth of his pro career (dating back to 2022). Fergus also matched a career-high with four RBI in the game, as he also doubled, a mark that also tied a career-best for runs driven in for a game.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 13, 2018: At Reading, Adam Haseley explodes for 2 home runs, a double, 3 RBIs and 3 runs scored in his second Double-A game to lead the Fightin Phils to a 5-4 win over Bowie. He would later be named E.L. Player of the Week.

Down by the Bay

Chesapeake enters tonight with a 37-47 overall record and are 6-11 in the second half, which sits in last place in the Southwest Division. The Baysox dropped four-of-six games against Richmond, winning games on Wednesday and Thursday last week. After this week, Chesapeake is at Erie the weekend after the All-Star Break before going to Altoona for six games. Chesapeake's roster features nine of the Orioles' top-30 prospects: Enrique Bradfield Jr. (2), Patrick Reilly (9), Neston German (10), Creed Williams (11), Trey Gibson (14), Braxton Bragg (15), Juan Nunez (20), Trace Bright (25) and Alex Pham (29).

Hello Old Friend

2015 Fightin Phils and former Philadelphia Phillie Zach Eflin makes a rehab start this afternoon for the Baysox. Eflin was placed on the 15-day IL on June 30 by the Orioles with low back discomfort. Eflin pitched for the R-Phils in 2015 and went 8-6, with a 3.69 ERA over 23 starts that season. Eflin made pitched for the Phillies from 2016-22, making 127 appearances for Philadelphia over seven seasons. He was on the 2022 Phillies team that went to the World Series. Eflin was apart of the 2015 Fightin Phils team that lost to Bowie in the Eastern League Championship. Eflin spent 2023 with the Rays, and started '24 in Tampa Bay before being traded to the Orioles. This season, Eflin is 6-5, with a 5.95 ERA over 12 starts this season with Baltimore.

LAST OUTING: 7/4 at SOM: ND, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 HR, 3 BB, 7 SO, 93 pitches (57 strikes)... Reading lost to Somerset, 4-3, at TD Bank Ballpark. Jimenez turned in another excellent start his last time out, but did not pick up a decision as the bullpen surrendered the lead late in the game. He went a Double-A best, and season-high six innings, while matching a season-high with seven strikeouts. He held Somerset to just one run on three hits, with the lone run coming in the bottom of the first, before keeping the Patriots off the board for the next five innings. Jimenez left with Reading up 2-1 and in line for the win, but ultimately took a no-decision. Jimenez was relieved by John McMillon in the bottom of the seventh inning.

2025 Season:

- Began season Jersey Shore (A+); promoted to Reading (AA) on June 22
- Made Double-A debut June 22 vs Hartford (L, 5.0 IP, 7 H, 6 ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 2 SO); matched season-highs in runs (6) and walks (3)
