LRST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (September 7, 2021) – Led by a stellar pitching performance and two timely home runs, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Rochester Red Wings 4-1 on Tuesday night at PNC Field. The win broke a nine-game losing streak for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

The RailRiders got an outstanding start from Matt Krook, who turned in 6.0 shutout innings on Tuesday. Krook (4-5) scattered five hits and struck out five without allowing a walk to the Red Wings. It was his second scoreless start in his last three outings, and was the first time he did not issue a walk in an appearance since May 12 with Double-A Somerset.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was held off the board until the bottom of the sixth when Donny Sands launched a two-run home run off Nick Wells into the bullpen in left. It was Sands' sixth home run of the season with the RailRiders and continued a streak of hot hitting, giving him five RBIs in his last two games.

In the bottom of the seventh, Chris Gittens lined a two-run homer to center off Diego Moreno to expand the lead to 4-0. Gittens finished the game 2-for-4 with two runs scored and his home run was his team-leading 11th of the season.

MLB rehabber Michael King allowed an RBI double to former RailRider Mike Ford in the top of the eighth, but nothing more in his 3.0 innings of work. King struck out six and recorded his first save of the season with SWB in closing out the victory.

Krook and King combined for one of the best pitching performances of the season for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, striking out 11 Rochester batters, while not allowing a walk.

NEWS & NOTES

JETER HEADS TO COOPERSTOWN: Yankees SS **Derek Jeter** will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame today, and in doing so will be the first player to suit up for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to make the Hall of Fame. Jeter played in seven games with the RailRiders on a rehab assignment in 2013.

WHILE THE GITTENS IS GOOD: RailRiders first baseman **Chris Gittens** launched his team-leading 11th home run of the season on Tuesday night against Rochester in only 111 at-bats, giving him an AB per HR ratio of 10.09 for the season. That pace is on par with MLB Hall of Famer Jimmie Foxx's 1932 season, in which he hit 58 home runs in 585 at-bats, which sits as the 27th-best AB/HR season of all-time in major leagues. The best mark by a RailRiders player with at least 100 at-bats in 2019 belonged to **Logan Morrison** who hit 15 home runs in 152 at-bats (10.13/HR).

IT IS OVER: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders snapped a nine-game losing streak with their win over the Rochester Red Wings on Tuesday night. The nine-game skid is the second-longest losing streak in franchise history, behind only a 10-game losing streak posted by the 1990 Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons from August 18-26. The RailRiders also had lost nine straight games at home, the longest home losing streak in SWB history, surpassing the marks of seven straight dubiously achieved by both the 1990 and 1991 Red Barons.

STOP THE STEAL: The Rochester Red Wings were 2-for-2 on stolen base attempts against the RailRiders on Tuesday night, continuing a troubling trend of teams running wild on the RailRiders. Opponents are an absurd 14-for-16 on stolen base attempts during the current homestand. Since the beginning of August, RailRiders opponents are a stunning 32-for-37 (86.5% success rate) when trying to steal against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. That is slightly better than the career success rate of Carlos Beltran, ranks third all-time in stolen base success rate.

CLOSE CALLS & BLOWOUTS: The RailRiders have played an extraordinary number of close games this season, with 52 of SWB's 106 games being decided by one or two runs (49.1%). Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has performed perfectly average in these close contests, going 15-15 (.500) in one-run games and 11-11 (.500) in two-run games. However, the RailRiders have also participated in their fair share of extreme blowout games, decided by eight-or-more runs. In 12 such contests, SWB is 10-2 (.833) on the season, and is part of the reason why the team is +115 in run differential this season, third-best in Triple-A East.

ONE OF THE BEST: Throughout the 2021 season, the RailRiders bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff, posting a 3.03 ERA as a unit and racking up 42 of SWB's 60 wins. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has the third-best bullpen ERA in full season baseball (minors and majors), trailing only Buffalo (2.77) and Somerset (2.81). The bullpen is posting impressive rates of 10.81 K/9, 4.05 BB/9, and has limited opposing batters to just a .204 AVG this season.

SWEET ESCAPE: Despite two consecutive losses to Lehigh Valley to end the last road trip, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders are 33-19 (.634) on the road this season, the second-best mark of any team in Triple-A this season. Only Jacksonville (33-21) can claim as many wins away from home in Triple-A East, and in the Northeast Division, Worcester (29-22) has the second-best road record. In Triple-A baseball, only Reno (35-19) has more wins on the road than Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

CERTIFIED STRIKEOUT BOYS: RailRiders pitchers struck out a season-high 17 batters on Friday night in a 1-0 loss against the Buffalo Bisons. That was the highest strikeout total of the year for SWB, surpassing the 15 K mark accomplished three times, most recently on August 8 against Worcester. The 17 strikeouts recorded by the RailRiders on Friday was the most since the staff struck out 18 on May 5, 2019 against the Syracuse Mets. That contest was also notable for SWB scoring 14 runs (10 earned) against Mets starter Mickey Jannis, and a 7 RBI performance from **Kyle Higashioka**. The RailRiders followed that up with a 15-strikeout performance on Sunday, and are striking out 10.09 batters per-nine innings this season as a staff.

THE FINAL STRETCH BEFORE THE FINAL STRETCH™: Wednesday continues the penultimate series of the regular season across minor league baseball, with most teams having 11 games remaining on their regular season schedules. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre hosts Rochester for five more games before finishing the season on the road at Lehigh Valley. Following that, the RailRiders return home for a five-game set with Syracuse to kick off the *Triple-A Final Stretch*, a 10-game, 2-week postseason "tournament" which is a tournament in the sense that a golf tournament is a tournament and less in the way it is traditionally used for postseason competition. The team with the best overall record over the 10-game period will be dubbed the Final Stretch Champion and receive a prize which is still TBA. Team and individual stats and records achieved during the *Triple-A Final Stretch* will be counted toward regular season numbers, as confirmed by MLB's statistics team.

LAST TIME OUT: Koerner had one of his roughest outings of the season in his last appearance in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader with the Buffalo Bisons. The first three batters he faced all reached base before Rodrigo Vigil lifted a sac fly to score a run and end Koerner's day. Sal Romano came in and allowed two mre runs to score against Koerner's ledger as he took the loss in an 8-4 defeat.

WELCOME BACK, KOERNER: After not playing in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Brody Koerner returns to the RailRiders for his third season with the club. He has the distinction of being the longest-tenured pitcher on the team who has stayed within the Yankees organization, with 50 appearances (34 starts) spread out since the start of the 2018 season. Only teammate Adam Warren (87 G) has made more appearances with SWB than Koerner, but left the Yankees organization on multiple occasions. Warren (55 GS) also has more starts with the RailRiders/SWB Yankees than Koerner.

STAFF WORKHORSE: During the 2019 season, Koerner logged 138.2 innings between Double-A Trenton and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tying him for most among Yankees minor leaguers (Miguel Yajure -- Charleston, Tampa). The right-hander also finished t-3rd in GS (22), 6th in AVG (.289) and Winning Percentage (4-8 combined), 7th in ERA (5.00) and WHIP (1.53), and 10th in K (109).

HEADING OVERSEAS: Following the 2019 season, Koerner left the country to play for the Gigantes del Cibao in the Dominican Winter League. It was the first time in his career that he played in a foreign winter league after the regular MiLB season. Koerner went 1-3 with a 2.17 ERA in seven starts with the Gigantes, striking out 21 and walking 17 in 29.0 innings. The right-hander was teammates with several former SWB RailRiders in the DWL, including Abiatal Avelino, Greg Bird, José DePaula, Anyelo Gómez and Adonis Rosa. Also appearing for the team were Wander Franco (No. 1 prospect in baseball) and Eloy Jimenez. Syracuse starter Jesus Reyes also played for the Gigantes.

- Graduated from Clemson in 2015 with a degree in Accounting and was a 2x ACC Academic Honor Roll member.
- Graduated from Jay M. Robinson HS (NC) where he lettered three years in baseball, three in basketball and one in football. Was a two-time All-State selection in baseball.
- Born in Winchester, VA but grew up in Concord, NC, a suburb of Charlotte.
