- Bradenton took a second straight game from the Jays, 6-3 on Thursday night at LECOM Park.
- The Marauders tallied three runs on three hits in the bottom of the first inning to take an early lead. From there on, Dunedin starter Grant Rogers didn't allow another run in his next four innings, allowing just one hit.
- Manuel Beltre stole home on a double steal in the top of the second inning to trim the lead to 3-1.
- Cristian Feliz tied the game in the top of the third with his eighth homer of the season an inside the park liner to center that drove in
- The game remained tied until Bradenton scored twice in the bottom of the sixth, and added an insurance run in the eighth.
- Dunedin threatened in the ninth inning, loading the bases with two outs, but couldn't score.

### JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays have homered in nine of their last 11 games. Across that stretch, seven different players have gone deep. Dunedin is tied third in the Florida State League with 27 homers. Dunedin's 16 homers this month are the most in the FSL in May. Cristian Feliz's inside the park home run was the Jays' first of the year.

### FERNANDO'S FIP

Tonight's starter, righty Fernando Perez, comes into action with a 4.04 ERA, but a 2.83 FIP. FIP, fielding independent pitching, calculates what a pitcher's ERA would look like if the pitcher were to experience league average results on balls in play. The 1.21 point difference between Perez's ERA and FIP (the 3rd largest in the league), indicates Perez has been unlucky through seven starts.

### FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Blue Jays slugger Cristian Feliz hit his team-leading eighth homer of the season last night. After a slow April, Feliz is batting .235 with a .837 OPS. The 6-foot, 4-inch first baseman's eight longballs are second in the Florida State League, two behind Daytona's Ariel Almonte.

### **NOT LOVING LEFTIES**

Entering tonight's game against Bradenton southpaw Michael Kennedy, the Blue Jays are hitting .202 as a team against lefthanded pitching - the third worst batting average in the FSL.

### K COUNTER

The Blue Jays pitching staff tied a season-high with 15 strikeouts Wednesday night. Dunedin is tied for second in the FSL in punchouts with 440 this season (10.4 per game). On the flip side, the Jays lead the league with 216 walks issued (over 5 per game).

### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

29 of the Blue Jays 42 games this season (69%) have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 13-16 record in those games. Each of the Blue Jays' last four wins have required saves.

### LATE MAGIC

For the first time in 14 games, the Blue Jays did not score in the 7th inning or later last night. The Blue Jays hold a +11 run differential in the final three innings this season (74 runs scored, 63 runs allowed).

### **GAINING LITTLE GROUND**

Despite winning six straight games, the Blue Jays made little progress in the FSL-West standings, as first-place Clearwater also won six times in the last seven games. Entering action tonight, Dunedin trails the Threshers by eight games.

### **BIG TIME BELTRE**

Blue Jays No. 27 prospect Manuel Beltre has turned red-hot at the plate, hitting .317 over his last 10 games (13-41). Beltre has two hits in six of his last eight games. After hitting .236 in the opening month of the year, Beltre is hitting .282 this month - a team best in May.

### BACK IN THE SERIES WIN COLUMN

Last week's series victory was the Jays' first set win since April 9-14 at Tampa, when the team took five of six games. Dunedin's five game win streak is the team's longest since they won six straight from April 6-12.

- Signed by the Blue Jays as an international free agent out of Nicaragua in July 2022.
- Native of Rivas, Nicaragua located in southwestern Nicaragua. Also the hometown of MLB reliever Erasmo Ramirez (currently with Tampa Bay).
- Is a consensus top-30 Toronto prospect due to impressive command of strike zone... often described as "polished."
- Boasts best control in the Blue Jays' system, according to Baseball America's 2024 Best Tools list.
- Arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, changeup, curveball, and slider.

- Took no-decision on 5/17 vs Jupiter, allowed 3 ER for second straight start in 5.2 IP
- FIP (fielding independent pitching) stands at 2.83 1.21 points lower than his ERA the third biggest difference in the league (behind teammate Grant Rogers).
