SEA DOGS FALL SHORT The Sea Dogs fell to the Fightin Phils last night, 6-5 at Hadlock Field. Reading took a 5-0 lead in the top of the first after three homers. A leadoff homer from Gabriel Rincones Jr. ignited the scoring before a three-run blast from Otto Kemp extended a 4-0 lead. A solo homer from Leandro Pineda capped off the inning. Sikes homered in the bottom of the second inning to put Portland on the board. In the bottom of the third inning, Portland continued the momentum, scoring two. Mayer doubled to leadoff before a pair of RBI doubles from Kyle Teel and Blaze Jordan put Portland within two, 5-3. Anthony hit his team-leading 11th homer of the season in the bottom of the fourth inning. Carson Taylor countered with a solo homer in the top of the fifth to extend the Reading lead. Teel joined the home run party in the bottom of the fifth inning with his ninth long ball of the season. A solo shot to the bullpen kept Portland within reach but Portland fell, 6-5.

THREE HOMERS NOT ENOUGH The Sea Dogs smashed three home runs in last night's loss to Reading. Phillip Sikes, Roman Anthony and Kyle Teel all hit the long ball for Portland. The most home runs in a game hit by the Sea Dogs was four against Reading in the first game of a doubleheader on April 13th.

TEEL FINISHES TRIPLE SHY OF THE CYCLE Kyle Teel had a standout night at the plate going four-for-five with two singles, a double and home run. He was just a triple shy of the cycle. A Sea Dog has hit for the cycle since Manuel Margot on September 6, 2015 against New Britain.

HOME AT HADLOCK In 44 games at home this season, the Sea Dogs are hitting .275 with 112 doubles, 12 triples and 32 home runs. In the last two games at Hadlock Field, the Sea Dogs have five home runs.

COMING UP NEXT The Sea Dogs will an off day tomorrow before facing the Somerset Patriots for a six-game series beginning on Tuesday, July 23rd in New Jersey. The Patriots are currently in first place of the Northeast Division while the Sea Dogs are in third place, 1.0 games behind Somerset. The Binghamton Rumble Ponies are in second place, 0.5 behind the Patriots.

THIS DAY IS SEA DOGS HISTORY July 21, 2008 - Dave Gassner (2-5) hurled six innings on two runs (one earned) and three hits as Portland beat the Connecticut Defenders 8-2 in the start of the "Big Papi" era in Portland. Ortiz had two hits and scored the first run and knocked in Portland's 8th tally in the sixth inning. The 'Dogs scored six runs in the first two innings off Joey Martinez.

PITCHING PREVIEW RHP Hunter Dobbins will start today for the Sea Dogs. Dobbins last pitched on July 14th in Hartford and tossed 2.0 shutout innings allowing one hit while walking one and striking out two. He has made three starts against Reading this season. In the three outings, Dobbins is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA. In 16.0 innings, he has allowed five runs (three earned) on 12 hits while walking six and striking out 15. The Fightin Phils are batting .207 against him.

Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

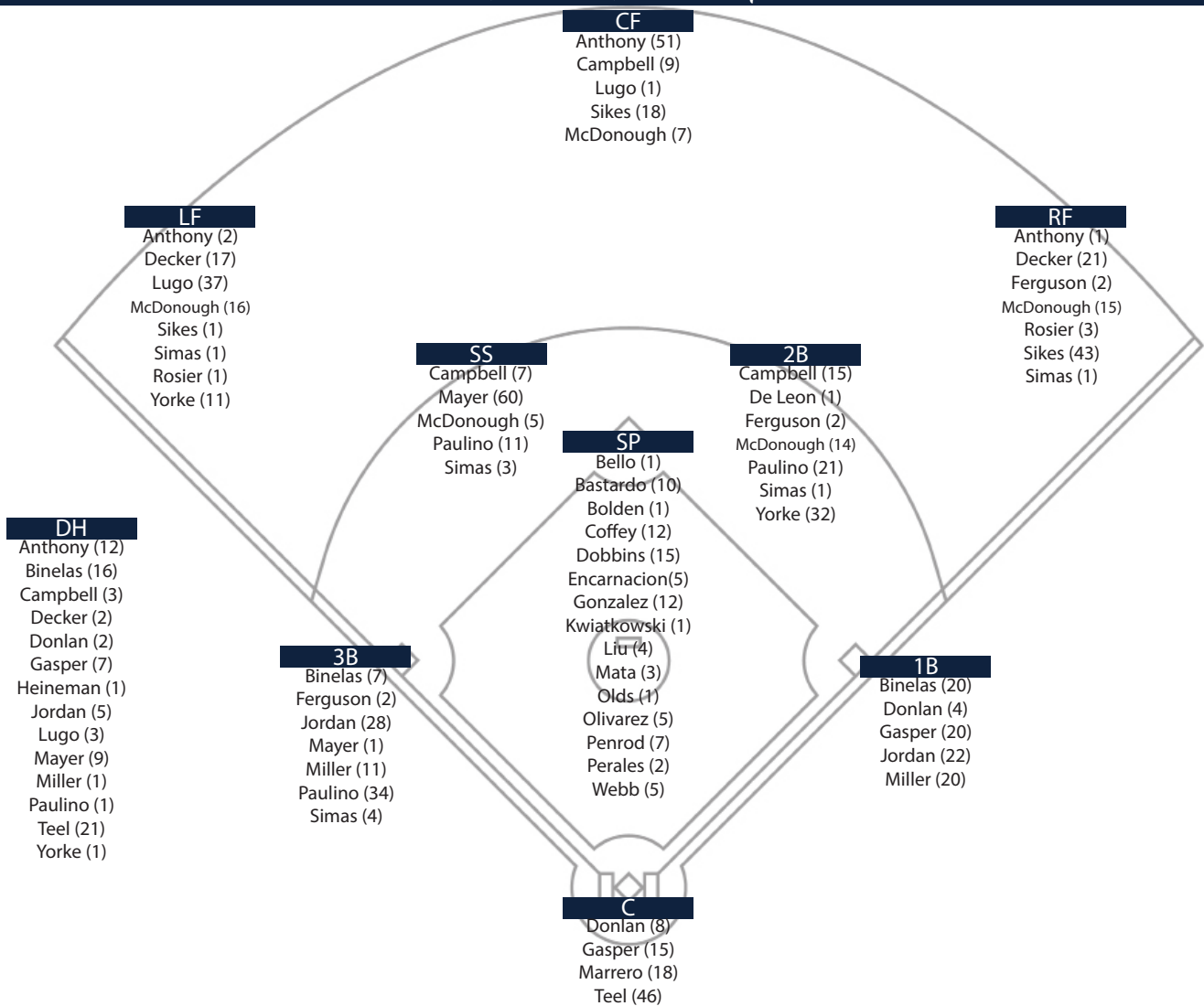
