WEEK OF THE WALKOFF: For the second time this season, Hub City has won back-to-back games via a walk-off. Back in May, Dylan Dreiling and Jhocsuanth Vargas his game-winning singles to beat against Rome. Two days later, Quincy Scott piled on with the third walk-off of the series. This week, Arturo Disla and John Taylor have knocked game winners to help Hub City come from behind and win each of the first two games

RANGERS REINFORCEMENTS: For the first time since 2018, the Rangers used their first round draft pick in the 2025 MLB Draft to take a high school prospect. Texas took Gavin Fien, a shortstop from California, with the 12th overall pick. The Rangers then progressed toward college pitchers with three of their next four picks: AJ Russell (Tennessee), Mason McConnaughey (Nebraska), and Ben Abeldt (TCU). Spartanburgers fans can expect to see several of these new acquisitions before the end of the year. Hub City has rostered 9 of last year's picks already this year.

STRONG START: The Spartanburgers hold a three-game lead in the SAL South Division second half standings. Hub City has won two of its first three six-game series to begin the second half, matching the first half total. Increased offensive production has helped. In the first half of the South Atlantic League 2025 season, the Spartanburgers ranked fourth worst in average (.215) and runs per game (4.05). The Spartanburgers have the league's second best batting average (.242) since the start of the second half.

MIDSEASON MOVES: Leandro Lopez is the latest call-up from Hub City to Frisco. The Tuesday starter for the Spartanburgers finished in High-A with a 2.19 ERA, lasting at least five innings in 10 of his 14 starts. Lopez ioins Keith Jones II. Josh Mollerus and David Davalillo as Spartanburgers to make the move to Double-A in the last month.

BATTLIN' BROOKLYN: Hub City welcomes the Brooklyn Cyclones to Fifth Third Park for the first time. The Cyclones have already secured a playoff spot in 2025, winning the north division in the first half by a half game over Greensboro with a 46-20 record. Brooklyn will return to the postseason for the first time since 2022.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
