### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Matt Gorski launched a two-run home run in the bottom of the fifth inning, but a three-run first inning and early 6-0 advantage led the Omaha Storm Chasers past the Indianapolis Indians 8-5 in Sunday's matinee at Victory Field. The Storm Chasers opened the scoring right away, logging three runs courtesy of a sacrifice fly, wild pitch which led to a Jason Delay throwing error that scored Devin Mann from second base, and Nick Pratto RBI single that plated CJ Alexander. Between the third and fourth inning, Omaha combined for three runs thanks to an RBI double by Logan Porter and a fielding error by Jack Suwinski in the following at-bat. In the fourth inning, Alexander padded the lead with an RBI single. Gorski, Indianapolis' May Player of the Month, continued his hot stretch while leading the Indians' comeback efforts with a two-run blast in the fifth. Liover Peguero then roped an RBI single in the sixth to bring the Indians within three, but Omaha responded in the next two frames on a Porter solo home run and John Rave run-scoring groundout. Peguero notched his second hit of the contest with a two-run double in the eighth to cap Indy's scoring.

**TEAM OFFENSE:** As a team, the Indians lead the International League with a .270 batting average (489-for-1808). They also rank among top-10 team leaders in triples (2nd, 14), hits (5th), doubles (T-7th, 102), on-base percentage (T-7th, .353), OPS (8th, .780), slugging percentage (9th, .427) and RBI (T-10th, 273).

**GORSKI'S GOOD:** Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., carried a scorching-hot May into June on Sunday, launching his 10th home run in his past 18 games dating back to May 16. In that time, he leads all International League batters in home runs, RBI (27), slugging percentage (.906), OPS (1.276), extra-base hits (15), total bases (58) and triples (T-1st, 2). He hit nine homers in May, which were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and are the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.

**AT THE VIC:** Sunday's loss was Indy's sixth consecutive on the homestand, marking the first time in five home series that the Indians have been handed a loss at Victory Field. The Indians won each of their first three homestands (4-2 vs. Memphis, 5-1 vs. St. Paul, 4-2 vs. Buffalo) before splitting last homestand with the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-3. Indianapolis' first series loss at home comes on the heels of their first road trip with more than one win, splitting a six-game series at Iowa from May 21-26. The six-game losing streak also ties their longest from the 2023 season.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians continue their 13-game homestand with a six-game set vs. the Columbus Clippers, Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, tonight at 7:05 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians went 1-6 against the Omaha Storm Chasers to begin the homestand, and are looking to break a six-game losing skid tonight against the worst record in the International League. Beginning the series for the Indians tonight is LHP Michael Plassmeyer (1-4, 8.07), who has never faced Columbus in 41 IL appearances (38 starts) between Durham, Lehigh Valley and Indy. Countering for the Clippers will be RHP Gavin Williams (0-0, 9.00), making the second start of his rehab assignment in Triple-A. He faced Indy twice during the 2023 season, going 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA (2er/11.2ip) and 12 strikeouts.

**YOU SAY GOODBYE....:** The Indians sent a plethora of players to Pittsburgh ahead of today's series opener. Outfielder Jack Suwinski, infielder Liover Peguero and catcher Henry Davis were all recalled by the Pirates today, while right-handed pitcher Ben Heller had his contract selected. **THIS DATE IN 1982:** On a Friday night at Bush Stadium, the Indians gave up six runs in the top of the first against Wichita, only to respond with five in the bottom half en route to a thrilling 10-9 victory. The Indians went run-for-run with Wichita, countering a two-run top of the fourth with their own pair in the bottom half. Facing a two-run deficit entering their eventual final half inning, Indy plated three runs in the bottom of the eighth to complete the comeback. Ronnie Farkas was the player of the game, going 3-for-3 with a double and four RBI. Tom Lawless and Dallas Williams scored six of the Indians' 10 runs from the top two spots in the lineup.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER

**Michael Plassmeyer:** The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his ninth start of the season and fifth at Victory Field tonight vs. Columbus.

**Last Outing:** Plassmeyer took the loss against Omaha and surrendered eight runs while tossing 3.2 innings.

**Against the Clippers:** Plassmeyer has never faced Columbus.

**Walk It Off:** Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion – three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

**2023:** Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ... Made three rehab starts with High-A Jersey Shore and allowed one run with nine strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work. ... Reinstated from the IL on 8/27 and went 2-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4er/23.2ip) and 27 strikeouts in his next five games (four starts) with Lehigh Valley. ... Made his final start of the season with Philadelphia on 9/30 (2) at New York (NL) and surrendered a career-high nine earned runs in 3.2 innings.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Seattle (4th round, 118th overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft. ... Had his contract first selected by PHI on 8/22/22 and made his MLB debut on 8/23/22 vs. Cincinnati. ... Signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on 12/29/23.
