**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones snapped a brief two-game slide on Thursday night with a 4-3 win over the BlueClaws... Brooklyn scored all 4 of their runs in the top of the 5th...LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided an RBI double and scored on an error to tie it at 2...1B **Joe Suozzi** collected a go-ahead run-scoring single and DH **Kevin Parada** added an RBI two-base hit...LF **Jared Carr** garnered a 2-run homer to right for Jersey Shore in the 4th...RHP **Wilkin Ramos** posted 3-shut-out innings of relief to earn his 2nd win...RHP **Manny Rodríguez** recorded the final 3 outs to pick up his first career save.

**WHAT'S RING-ING?:** Several members of the 2022 Florida State League champion St. Lucie Mets will receive their championship rings during an on-field pregame ceremony at Maimonides Park on Tuesday night...In total 32 members of the squad — players, coaches, and support staff — will receive rings prior to the contest...28 of the 32 recipients are players...St. Lucie went a perfect 4-0 in the FSL playoffs... They defeated the Palm Beach Cardinals, 2-0, in the East Division Championship and toppled the Dunedin Blue Jays, 2-0, in the Championship Series to win their first league title since 2006.

**WASHED OUT:** The Cyclones endured their 4th postponement of the 2023 season and their 3rd consecutive day washed away on Sunday afternoon due to rain...Since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in 2005, Brooklyn had never had 3-straight games rained out...From May 12-14, 2022, vs. Wilmington, the 'Clones had 3 games postponed, but were able to play game one of a doubleheader on May 14...The second game of the twinbill was rescheduled due to weather.

**NEW KIDS ON CONEY:** Brooklyn added INF **Mateo Gil** to the roster from Double-A Binghamton and RHP **Benito García** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...Gil, the son of 8-year Major League INF **Benji Gil**, slashed .143/.214/.204 in 14 games for the Rumble Ponies, adding 7 RBI...García made 5 relief appearances with St. Lucie, composing a 1-2 mark with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER in 9.1IP) and 5 strikeouts...INF **Brad Malm** was transferred to the Development List.

**IF THERE'S A WIL-KIN, THERE'S A WAY:** RHP **Wilkin Ramos** has been a force for Brooklyn out of the bullpen in 2023... The 22-year-old enters Saturday's matchup with a 10-inning scoreless streak dating back to April 13 at Winston-Salem... During the 4-game stretch, Ramos has permitted only 2 hits and walked 3 batters...The right-hander has whiffed 15 batters in that span (13.50 K/9)...Over his last 2 appearances, Ramos has punched out 11 batters in 6.0 innings (16.50 K/9)... The Dominican native is 7th in the South Atlantic League (min. 10.0 IP) in strikeout rate (39.0%).

**ALEX ALWAYS ON:** OF **Alex Ramírez** extended his team season-long hitting streak to 12 on Thursday...Only Greenville's **Blaze Jordan** has a longer active streak in the SAL at 13...The 20-year-old is 17-for-his-last-49 (.347) with 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 10 RBI, 5 walks, and 4 stolen bases... Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.283) and is tied with teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** for the lead in triples (7).

**THUNDERBOLT:** The Cyclones stole a season-high 6 bases on Wednesday afternoon at Jersey Shore...That was the most for Brooklyn since they stole 6 bags at Hudson Valley on April 20, 2022...3B **Jaylen Palmer** and DH/RF **Joe Suozzi**

**vs. ABERDEEN** Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds claim 5 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...2022 No. 1 overall pick — SS **Jackson Holliday** — is the top-rated prospect at No. 3 in the organization...OF **Dylan Beavers** (11), OF **Jud Fabian** (14), INF **Max Wagner** (19), and INF **Frederick Bencosme** (29) are also featured...The Cyclones were eliminated by the IronBirds, 2-1, in the 2022 South Atlantic League North Division Championship last September... Brooklyn is 116-105 (.525) all-time against Aberdeen.

swiped bases in both contests...Coming into Sunday, OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League with 10 and Palmer is tied for 5th with 9...More importantly, both are a combined 19-for-20 on attempts...The 'Clones are 9th in the league with 34 team stolen bases, but are 2nd in success rate (.895)...Only Hudson Valley (.912) has been more successful.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** blasted his 4th home run of the year on Tuesday night...Consuegra enters Tuesday's games on a 12-game on-base streak dated back to April 12...Since then, the right-handed swinger is slashing .326/.404/.696 with a stellar 1.100 OPS...Consuegra has 8 extra-base hits, 4 home runs, 13 RBI, and 5 walks in that span... He is tied for 8th in homers (4) and tied for 9th in extra-base hits (9)

**GO DJ:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 6 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 11...In 11 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 10.1 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 19 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 26 strikeouts in 20.2 innings.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 4 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision on Friday night vs. Wilmington...Permitted 2 runs on 5 hits over a career-high 5.2 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 6...Induced a double play and threw a wild pitch...Hurled 77 pitches (49 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with the bases empty and 2 out in the top of the 6th and Brooklyn behind, 2-0...Cyclones tied the game in the 9th on a DH **Joe Suozzi** single...Blue Rocks went on to win in 10 innings, 4-2.

**2022:** Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

**SOARING EAGLE:** Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

**NEW ROLE:** Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 5th professional start on Friday...In those outings, he has no record and a 2.25 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP), adding 23 strikeouts (12.94 SO/9)...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

**SUMMER NIGHTS:** The 23-year-old is no stranger to pitching in the northeast...Stuart tossed 6.0 scoreless innings over 4 appearances with the Bourne Braves of the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League in the summer of 2021...Was teammates with 2022 Cyclones LHP **Nick Zwack**...Also made 1 start with the Amsterdam (N.Y.) Mohawks of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.
