LET'S RECAP

Oklahoma City guaranteed a series split with a 10-4 victory on Friday night at Dell Diamond. SS Andy Burns hit a double to score DH Jake Lamb in the fourth inning to start the scoring. CF Drew Avans followed suit with another double to make it 2-0. Then, back-to-back singles increased the lead to 4-0. The Express cut into the lead in the fourth. With two outs, newcomer 2B Diosbel Arias doubled to score two runs and Round Rock trailed 4-2. DH Nick Solak hit a line drive over the wall in left field and tied the game at four in the fifth inning. In the sixth inning, with Avans and C Tony Wolters aboard, 2B Michael Busch singled away from the shift to send his teammates home for a 6-4 advantage. Dodgers 3B Miguel Vargas hit a solo home run to open the seventh. In the next at-bat, Lamb made it back-to-back bombs. The Dodgers added two more in the seventh inning when Wolters hit a two-RBI single and extended the lead to 10-4 and the score stood final.

SBORZ STARTS

Express RHP Josh Sborz is slated to make his first start of the season on Saturday. He holds a 1-0 record and 0.00 ERA (0 ER/11.1 IP). The righty has struck out 15 and walked three in nine appearances out of the bullpen. It will be his 47th career start in the minors and his first start since 2017.

ALEXY GOES FOR FIVE AGAIN

Round Rock RHP A.J. Alexy made it through 5.0 innings for the fourth consecutive time yesterday. Alexy has now tossed five or more frames during six outings this season. The right-hander holds a 3-0 record in his last four starts.

WELCOME TO TRIPLE-A

Express 2B Diosbel Arias collected both his first Triple-A hit and RBI on Friday evening. He finished the night 1-for-4 with a double and two RBI. After being called up from High-A Hickory on Thursday, SS Frainyer Chavez made his Triple-A debut on Friday night, batting ninth and playing shortstop. He finished 0-for-4 with one strikeout.

REHAB APPEARANCES

On Saturday, fans will be treated to a start from Los Angeles Dodgers LHP Andrew Heaney and two-time MLB All-Star INF Max Muncy will play third base. Heaney is 33-38 with a 4.65 ERA in 123 games in his major league career. For Round Rock, Texas Rangers RHP Jonathan Hernández made his first Major League rehab appearance on the mound yesterday. The righty threw 0.2 innings and allowed two walks while recording one strikeout. On Wednesday, fans saw Rangers RHP José Leclerc toss 2.0 innings of scoreless baseball.

VILORIA ROLLS ON

C Meibrys Viloria recorded the only multi-hit game for Round Rock last night. He finished 2-for-3 with a run scored and a strikeout. It was the seventh multi-hit game of the year for Viloria. The catcher is slashing .333/.444/.484 in 27 games this season.

ROSTER MOVES

Round Rock LHP Kolby Allard was promoted to Texas on Friday afternoon. In a counter move, OF Zach Reks was added to the Express roster from Texas. RHP Jonathan Hernández was also added to the roster from the Rangers on a Major League rehab assignment. Reks was promoted to Texas from Round Rock on Monday and appeared in three games this week. He went 1-for-8. Hernández will make his Round Rock debut. The righty has a career ERA of 3.40 in 36 appearances for Texas.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
