

ON THE PLUS SIDE: Brooklyn sits 61-58 which is three games better than .500 for the first time since April 22 when the team was 8-5. At Brooklyn's lowest point, the Cyclones were nine games under at 22-31 on June 10.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have 13 games remaining and three series: one more game at Jersey Shore, six games vs. Wilmington, and six games at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in second place just a half game behind first place Hudson Valley.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF Jose Peroza has a OPS of .921 over his past 39 games with a 26-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 37 of the past 39 games, hitting .331 with a .418 OBP. In August, Peroza leads the league with 32 hits and nine doubles.

**TOP 30 UPDATE:** MLB Pipeline's new rankings that were released last Wednesday: OF Alex Ramirez at No. 4, RHP Mike Vasil at No. 11, RHP Dominic Hamel at No. 12, RHP Junior Santos at No. 16, OF Stanley Consuegra at No. 23, RHP Christian Scott at No. 28 and LHP Keyshawn Askew at No. 30.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate sits in last place in the North Division of the at ShoreTown Ballpark in Lakewood, New Jersey. Against the BlueClaws, the Cyclones are 21-5 in 26 games. Jersey Shore hosts three of Philadelphia's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 6 INF Hao Yu Lee, No. 21 RHP Christian McGowan, and No. 27 SS Casey Martin. The BlueClaws own a North Division worst -115 run differential.

CRACKING THE CRABS: OF Alex Ramirez leads all Mets minor leaguers with 124 hits. In eight games against Jersey Shore, the No. 4 Mets prospect is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with five doubles, two home runs, and 13 RBIs.

JT JOLTING: Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B JT Schwartz is hitting .324 with a .895 OPS, going 12-37 with four doubles, a home run in nine games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the ranking.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and the fourth-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 476 runs in 119 games (4.0 runs/game).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 479 runs in 119 games (4.0 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for sixth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

BRETT THE BAT: Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B Brett Baty homered again for the New York Mets Friday night against Colorado. He is also the first from the 2019 Mets draft class to make his debut with New York and the 91st Cyclone to make the majors.

**BOOKENDS:** Former Clemson Tiger Keyshawn Askew makes his second start of the week after six scoreless on Tuesday against the BlueClaws.

TOP 30: Askew has been ranked as the No. 30 Mets prospect, according to MLB Pipeline thanks to the reshuffling of the list earlier in August.

PROMOTION!: Askew made 13 appearances with Low-A 4/20 St. Lucie and four starts, tossing 46.1 IP and posting a 1.93  $^{4/2}_{6/7}$ earned run average. Askew struck out 64 batters and walked  $_{678}^{672}$ 19, allowing six hit batters and three home runs. In his final 6/25 outing before the promotion, Askew struck out eight Palm 7/18 Beach Cardinals on July 30th.

INJURED LIST STINT: Askew made four appearances with \*Indicates start appearance Low-A St. Lucie this spring before landing on the injured list, missing April 28-June 6.

MEET THE METS: The Mets selected Askew in the 10th round in 2021 out of Clemson University in the Atlantic Coast Conference, signing him for \$125K. Askew was one of six Tigers selected last year. Only Seattle SS James Parker was selected higher (eighth round).

COLLEGE: Was a weekend starter for Clemson in 2021, working his way back from missing the first 12 games of the season with a leg injury. Made a total of 21 starts and 33 appearances across three years with Clemson.
