WALCOTT HOMERS IN LOSS TO WICHITA:
The Frisco RoughRiders were edged by the Wichita Wind Surge 3-2 on Saturday night from Equity Bank Park. Wichita (14-12, 51-44) struck first in the bottom of the third when Kala'i Rosario plated Ben Ross on a fielding error to take a 1-0 lead. The Wind Surge then added on in the bottom of the fifth on a Walker Jenkins sacrifice fly, expanding the lead to 2-0. In the top of the seventh, Sebastian **Walcott** drilled a solo home run to pull Frisco (9-17, 47-47) to within a 2-1 deficit. Wichita then answered in the bottom of the seventh when Kaelen Culpepper stole third and scored on a throwing error, extending the lead to 3-1. Frisco pulled closer in the top of the eighth when **Alejandro Osuna** corked an RBI single to pull within a 3-2 margin. After **Josh Hatcher** singled with one out in the top of the ninth, the Riders brought the go-ahead run to the plate twice. But Wichita reliever Mike Paredes struck out Aaron Zavala to notch the three-inning save. Wind Surge reliever Joel Cesar (3-3) picked up the win, spinning 1.2 scoreless innings. Frisco starter **Jose Corniell** (0-1) took the loss, allowing just one unearned run.

PICKING UP THE OFFENSE:

After a tough month in June on offense, hitting .218/.308/.306/.614 with a league-worst 3.4 runs per game and just 13 homers (tied for second-fewest in the league), the Riders have been better in July. The Riders are fifth in batting average (.239), fourth in slugging (.365), fifth in OPS (.672), third in home runs (18) and fifth in runs per game (4.5). The Riders are also 28-for-34 in steals during the

HE IS ABIMELECTRIC:

Abimelec Oritz has been on fire at the plate in July. In the month, he is hitting .290/.359/.551/.910 over 17 games with six doubles, four home runs, 10 RBIs and seven walks. In his last eight games, he is batting .406 (13-for-32)/.429/.750/1.179 with five doubles, two home runs and six RBIs.

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:

In their last 13 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 11 of the 13 games, but they are 5-8. The Riders have blown six saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A

K-ROD ON FIRE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 25 games, he is hitting .337 (31for 92)/.413/.413/.826 with seven doubles, five RBIs, 11 walks, 11 runs scored, 11 walks and just 13 strikeouts. In July, he is batting .304 (17-for-56) over 15 games.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 62 games since May 7th, he is batting .276/.336/.464/.800 with 17 doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBIs and 15 stolen bases. In his last 26 games, he is slashing .300/.345/.518/.863 with seven doubles, five home runs, 14 RBIs, 19 runs scored and eight steals.

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 24 of their last 27 games. Over those 27 games, they have stolen 46 total bases, which is tied for second in the league. Sebastian Walcott is first in the league with 12 steals in that span while Cam Cauley is seventh with eight. Overall this season, the Riders are fourth in the league with 114 stolen bases.

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are Elvis Andrus (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. Over an 12-game on-base streak, he is hitting .277 (13-for-47)/.358/.532/.890 with one double, one triple, three home runs and
