GETTING TO THE PEN: After an 8-3 loss last night the Marauders have dropped three of the first four games versus Jupiter this week. The Hammerheads have been paced by dominant starting pitching. Over the four contests, their starters have combined for 20 innings while allowing just two earned runs (0.200 ERA) with 24 strikeouts and four walks. Meanwhile, the Hammerheads pen, has been solid, but has surrendered the majority of Bradenton's runs, allowing six over 16 innings of work.

LATE-INNING MADNESS: Through the first three games of the series with Jupiter, the ninth and tenth innings have decided every game with the Hammerheads erasing a one-run deficit in the top of the ninth on Tuesday while down to their final out, and Bradenton securing it's first walk-off victory of the season Wednesday on **Eddy Rodriguez**'s ninth-inning solo shot. On Thuesday night, both teams entered the tenth inning tied, before Jupiter rallied for four runs to win the game 5-2. Over the previous two days, both teams have secored 15 runs from the seventh inning on, with Bradenton outscoring Jupiter 8-7 in that stretch. Wednesday's win was just the Marauders second after trailing through six innings and finishing the eighth inning tied.

CRUSHING IN CLEARWATER: The Bradenton Marauders return to LECOM Park for a 12-game homestand. Last week at Clearwater, Bradenton earned the series victory, taking four of six from the Threshers. Throughout the week, Bradenton's bats exploded, out scoring the Threshers 57-34 (9.5 runs per game) and produced double-digit run totals in three consecutive games to finish the weekend. On Sunday, the Marauders dropped a heartbreaker to the Treshers, falling 15-12 in ten innings after initially erasing a 7-1 deficit. Despite the tough finish, the Marauders enter the homestand having played their best ball of the season.

CASTILLO TAKES THE BALL: Right hander **Clevari Tejada** is set to make his team-leading 13th start of the year. After a strong month of May, Tejada has struggled during his previous two starts, combined for six innings of seven-run ball, with both outings coming last week at Clearwater. Tonight marks his first start against the Hammerheads this season. He mixes in a sinker (93.4 mph), slider (84.2 mph), splitter (84.5 mph) and changeup (86.1 mph). Opponents are just 2-for-13 against his split-finger and have whiffed on 56.5 percent of their swings against it. They're also batting .182 against his slider.

WELCOME WYATT: On Tuesday (June 3rd), the Pirates promoted 2024 Second Round Pick Wyatt Sanford to Single-A Bradenton. In his first at bat, he launched a solo homer to right in his first Single-A at bat. He finished the night 1-4 with 3 RBI. On Saturday, he finished the night with two homers and five RBI to cap a sensational first week with Bradenton. At 19 years old, 2025 marks his first professional season. In 20 games in the FCL, Sanford went 14-for-54 (.259) with one homer run and six runs batted in. He also walked as many times as he struck out (15) and went 13-for-14 in stolen base tries. The middle infielder is highly touted for his defensive provess. After the promotion of Konnor Griffin, he becomes the highest ranked Marauder in the Pirates system. Sanford was drafted out of Independence High School in Frisco, Texas.

YOUNG GRASSHOPPERS: Pirates no. 2 prospect Konnor Griffin and 2024 fifth-round pick Will Taylor were both promoted to High-A Greensboro on Tuesday, joining Hunter Furtado as the only non-rehabbing Marauders to join the Grasshoppers this season. Griffin, last year's first round pick, dominated in his first taste of professional baseball, slashing .338/.396/.536 with nine home runs, 36 RBI and 26 stolen bases in 50 games. He leaves the FSL leading in hits (70), runs (49), average and slugging, and tied for second in homers, extra-base hits (21), and RBI, After spending much of April on the injured list, Taylor had a stellar month of May for Bradenton. In 29 total games in a Maruaders uniform, Taylor batted .333 with four homers, 19 RBI and eight stolen bases. In his final game with Bradenton (June 7), he blasted two homers (including a grand slam) and drove in seven runs.

RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK: The Marauders have been one of the best teams at controlling the running game this season. Their 53 stolen bases allowed entering the week are the fewest in Single-A. In the process, they've limited opponents to a .707 stolen base percentage, the second-lowest in the FSL and sixth best in Single-A. Marauders catcher **Derek Berg** has posted a 1.91 average pop time to second base they sear, the quickest mark in the FSL. As a result, he has thrown out 13 of 34 (38.2%) potential base stealers, the best rate of any qualified catcher in the FSL. In the month of May, he cut down 6 of 13 potential base stealers, including 3 of 3 at Clearwater on May 4.
