Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the 11th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and 11th-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Fightin Phils won the first series between the teams 4-2 from May 13-18. Reading heads to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading leads the season-series 6-4.

Game 59 Recap

It was an all-around win for the Fightin Phils on Friday night as they captured back-to-back victories for the first time since May 25-27 in an 11-1 win over New Hampshire. The Fightin Phils came racing out of the gates with five runs on five-straight two-out hits in the first inning. The inning was highlighted by a two-run double from Paul McIntosh and two-run home run from Seth Beer. Reading hit four home runs in total on the night, which matched a season-high. Felix Reyes and Leandro Pineda each homered in the fifth inning, and Cade Fergus added a two-run shot in the seventh. On the mound, Wil Crowe was spectacular once again. The 30-year old allowed one run on three hits over five innings, with seven strikeouts, earning his second-straight victory.

When There's a Wil, There's a Way

Wil Crowe turned in another spectacular start on Friday night, allowing one run on three hits over five innings, with seven strikeouts. Before Rob Brooks hit a solo home run in the fifth inning, Crowe had tossed 15.1-straight scoreless innings on the mound. It's the longest scoreless-inning streak since Brett Schulze went 15-straight from June 14-July 22, in 2023. It's the longest scoreless-inning streak by a R-Phils starter since Ethan Martin went 19.2-straight scoreless from Aug. 16-Sept. 3, of the 2015 season. Crowe's seven strikeouts on Friday were the most he's had in an affiliated game since striking out nine, with Pittsburgh against Cincinnati, on Oct. 1, 2021. Over his last four starts, Crowe is 2-0, with a 0.56 ERA (1 ER, 16.0 IP), with five hits, four walks and 12 strikeouts.

Flex on Them Felix

Felix Reyes continued his impressive week with three hits, two runs, a double and home run on Friday night. Through three games this week, Reyes is slashing .583/.643/1.417 (2.060 OPS). He's added six runs, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and four RBI. With Keaton Anthony's promotion to Triple-A, Reyes now leads the Fightin Phils in average, slugging percentage, OPS; and is tied for the team lead in home runs.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases on Wednesday night, Miller is alone in first place in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases, three clear of second place. In the Phillies organization, Miller is second, behind Oscar Mercado, who has 25.

Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas' strong week continued with another hit, run and RBI on Friday night. This comes after he turned in the best game for Reading on Thursday night since signing with the Phillies on May 26. He had two hits, a run, his first Reading home run and a career-high five RBI. His five RBI marked the third time Fightin Phil posted five RBI in a game this season. Over three games this week, Binelas is slashing .444/.500/.778 (1.278 OPS), with two runs, a home runs and seven RBI.

Beer, Beer, Beer

Seth Beer has turned it on as of late for the Fightin Phils after a home run, two runs and two RBI on Friday night. Following a stretch in which he went 0-for-27 over seven games (May 23-June 3), Beer has followed that with a six-game hitting streak since June 4. Over the hitting streak, Beer is slashing .346/.379/.538 (.917 OPS), with four runs, two doubles, one home run and four RBI.

Hammering Homers

After four-more home runs last night, the Fightin Phils lead the league in home runs hit since the start of last week (June 3) with 15 total. Reading's four home runs on Friday night tied a season-high.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 14, 2023: At Reading, Tyler Phillips goes six no-hit innings and the R-Phils come just four-outs shy of the 14th no-hitter in franchise history. But seven-unanswered runs for Hartford give them a 7-2 win in ten innings.

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 27-33 record, which is fourth in the Northeast Division and 12.5 games out of first place. The Fisher Cats were home against Altoona last week and took five-of-six games, shutting out the Curve in the first four contests. After this week, New Hampshire hosts the Somerset Patriots. New Hampshire's roster has six players on the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Trey Yesavage (2), Charles McAdoo (12), Juanon Watts-Brown (15), Jace Bohrofen (22), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

Pitching for the Fisher Cats

Righty Ryan Watson makes his 11th start and 12th appearance of the season. Watson is 4-3, with a 3.90 ERA (26 ER, 60.0 IP). He suffered the loss Sunday at Altoona, allowing four-earned runs over 4.2 innings, which came after going 6.2-scoreless vs the Curve the prior Tuesday. At Reading on May 17, Watson allowed six runs on 10 hits, but earned the victory. Watson split 2024 between three levels in the Blue Jays' system, going 2-3, with a 4.70 ERA over 13 appearances. The 26-year old signed with Toronto in May of 2024 after spending 2023 with Florence in the Frontier League following graduation from Georgia State.

King turned in his fourth-straight outing over five innings, as he proves to be a reliable arm in Reading's rotation. He matched a season-high with five strikeouts for the second-straight outing, but did issue a season and career-high three walks in the loss. King made quick work of the Senators in the first three innings, before being tagged for a run each in the fourth and fifth innings. The run in the fourth inning was unearned due to a fielding error at shortstop. In the fifth, a walk and hit by pitch led to a single from Carlos De La Cruz which played the second run off King, and his only earned run. King was relieved by John McMillon in the bottom of the sixth inning.

2025 Season:

- After not starting, nor pitching more than 2.0 IP in a game prior to this season, King has started nine-of-11 games this season and has gone over two innings in each outing
- First, and only, win of season came on Apr. 13 at Somerset when he pitched in relief (3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 5 SO)
- Tossed a season and career-high six innings twice in back-to-back starts: May 22 at Portland and May 29 vs Erie
- On May 22 at Portland: 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 SO
- Allowed a season and career-high 11 hits May 29 vs Erie over six innings
- Has allowed a career-high three home runs three times this season: May 2 vs HBG, May 17 vs NH and May 29 vs ERI
- Went five-shutout innings Apr. 24 at Portland
- Issued a career-high three walks June 9 at Harrisburg
- Struck out a season/career-high five batters four times this season, including back-to-back starts on June 3 & 8 at Harrisburg
- Has gone 5+ innings in his last four starts and five of his last six starts on the mound
- Over seven away games, has a 3.00 ERA (11 ER, 33.0 IP), which is compared to a 9.35 ERA (18 ER, 17.1 IP) over four home contests; also 10-of-12 home runs have been allowed at home
- Posted a 3.60 ERA (6 ER, 15.0 IP) in four April outings and a 7.11 ERA (20 ER, 25.1 IP) across five May appearances (all starts); has a 2.70 ERA (3 ER, 10.0 IP) over two June starts
- With RISP, opposing hitters slashing .191/.200/.213 (.413 OPS)
- Has allowed the most home runs (12) of any pitcher in the Eastern League

- Spent majority of season with Jersey Shore (A+), making 31 appearances out of the bullpen
