CARDINALS SUCCUMB TO NATURALS' POWER SURGE: The NW Arkansas Naturals hit a season-high 5 home runs and the Cardinals fell in an early 10-0 hole as Springfield dropped its 4th straight game with a 14-3 loss on Thursday night at Hammons Field. The 11-run loss matched the Cardinals' largest margin of defeat in 2024. **Mike Antico** hit a two-run homer and drove in all 3 runs for Springfield and **Bryan Torres** had two hits. The Cardinals have now dropped 5 of their last 6 but still sit a half-game ahead of the Arkansas Travelers for first place in the North Division.



OPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Tyson Guerrero** makes his 9th start (11th appearance) of the season for NW Arkansas...Last pitched on Friday, June 7 against Wichita and allowed 4 ER on 5 H with 6 K over 4.0 IP...Over 2 starts in June has a 6.00 ERA but has struck out 16 with just 4 BB in 9.0 IP...Went 0-2 with a 9.92 ERA in 5 appearances...Took the loss against the Cardinals on May 10 at Arvest Ballpark allowing 2 ER on 5 H over 5.0 IP with 7 K...The Cards won the game 2-0...Made 3 starts with the Naturals at the end of the 2023 season and went 1-2 with a 6.55 ERA...Began 2023 at High-A Quad Cities going 2-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 18 appearances (17 starts), racking up 106 K to just 29 BB in 84.1 IP...Limited to just 6 starts with Quad Cities in 2022 because of shoulder injuries...Made 9 appearances between ACL and Low-A Columbia in 2021...Selected by the Royals in the 12th round of the 2021 draft out of Washington...Went 3-3 with a 2.96 ERA in his redshirt sophomore season with the Huskies...Pitched at Lower Columbia CC in 2020...Was a two-way player at Washington State as a freshman in 2019, going 1-2 with a 3.63 ERA in 19 appearances while hitting .277 with 2 HR and 5 2B in 94 AB...25 years old

CARDS HOST NATURALS TO START FIRST-HALF STRETCH RUN: Holding a half-game lead in the North Division with 12 to play to start the week, the Cardinals host the NW Arkansas Naturals (AA, Kansas City Royals) for the first of two series between the two clubs at Hammons Field. The Cards dropped 4 of 6 at Arvest Ballpark in Springdale at the beginning of May.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE: With just 9 games to play, the Cardinals are in a tight race for the 1st half title with the Arkansas Travelers and Tulsa Drillers. Springfield leads the division by just a half game over the Travs while the Drillers are 2.0 games back. While the Travelers and Drillers have three more head-to-head meetings this week, the Cards will not play either team again until the 2nd half. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

IN A FUNK AT HAMMONS: After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have struggled of late at Hammons Field. The Cards have dropped 15 of their last 20 games at Hammons Field, a stretch that includes a franchise record-tying 8-game skid at home. The Cardinals are now 13-15 with a 5.97 team ERA at Hammons Field. After playing 4 of their last 6 series away from Hammons Field, the Cardinals go into the All-Star Break with 21 of 30 at home.

LET'S FLIP THE SCRIPT: While the Cardinals have had success against most of the North Division so far this season, Springfield has struggled against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals. The Naturals lead the season series 7-2 and have outscored the Cards 58-32 in 9 games this season. The Cardinals are batting .238 as a team against the Naturals and have been out-homered 13-3 in the season series. The Naturals have a team ERA nearly a full run better than Springfield's on the series (3.53 to 4.52). Against the rest of the North Division the Cardinals are 26-13.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 423 whiffs in 60 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (404 K in 60 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.05 K's per game.

POWER OUTAGE: While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. Over their last 16 games, the Cardinals have hit just 2 HR over their last 16 games: **Mike Antico's** 2-run shot off Mason Barnett in the 6th inning on Thursday at Hammons Field and **Jacob Buchberger's** 3-run blast in the 5th on Saturday night in North Little Rock, which snapped a homerless streak for the Cards of 11 straight games. The Cardinals are tied for the fewest homers in the Texas League in home runs with 32 on the season.

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: The Cardinals during their 4-game losing streak have been struggling to generate runs. Springfield is 6-for-35 (.171) with runners in scoring position and has scored just 10 runs (2.5 runs/game).

BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL HAUNTING CARDS AGAIN: After not allowing a "big inning" in 11 of the 12 games on their road trip through Wichita and North Little Rock, the Naturals have used crooked numbers to win the first three games of the series at Hammons Field this week. The Naturals have four innings of 3+ runs this week, bringing the Cardinals' season total to 40 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 40 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 157 of the 312 total runs scored by the opposition, 50.3% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. In the other 473.1 IP Springfield has allowed 151 runs, which comes out to 2.87 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 24-6 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning".

After giving up 5 home runs on Thursday night, the Cardinals once again sit at the top of the Texas League for most home runs allowed. Their 68 HR surrendered is 3 more than the 65 allowed by Amarillo.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 213.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 30 straight games without a home run.
