YESTERDAY: The Captains lost to Dayton in 11 innings, 4-1. Christian Cairo hit a solo homer to put the Captains ahead in the first inning, but James Free tied it for Dayton with a solo shot in the eighth. The game remained tied until the 11th. Jack Rogers knocked in free runner Victor Ruiz with a single and moved to second on an error by right fielder Quentin Holmes. Later in the inning, Ivan Johnson and pinch-hitter Jonathan Willems hit back-to-back RBI singles. The Captains loaded the bases with nobody out in the bottom of the 11th, but Dragons reliever Vincent Timpanelli came in from the bullpen and retired all three Captains he faced to end

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.0 game behind the Great Lakes Loons and Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, the Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 3.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 12.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

TIEBREAKER WATCH: The following are the tiebreaker scenarios for the High-A Central League Postseason.

- Head-to-head record
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Great Lakes Loons for the final playoff spot, Great Lakes clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (15-9 vs. Lake County)
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Dayton Dragons for the final playoff spot, Lake County clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (13-7 vs. Dayton)
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the final playoff spot, the playoff berth will be decided by the second or third tiebreaker rule.
- Best overall winning percentage over the final 20 games
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the team with the better winning percentage over the final 20 games of the regular season will win the playoff berth. If this situation arises, the Captains would win this tiebreaker because Lake County trailed Cedar Rapids at the 100game mark. A tie between the two teams at the end of the season means the Captains would have the better record over the final 20 games.
- If teams have identical winning percentages over the final 20 games, playoff berth will be decided by best overall winning percentage over an additional game (i.e., the last 21 games, the last 22 games, etc.) until one emerges with a better winning percentage in that span.

José Tena: Since August 1, Tena has slashed .291/.352/.547 (.899 OPS). Tena is tied for third in the league in slugging percentage since the start of August

Christian Cairo: 13-for-42 (.310) with two homers and two doubles in 12 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24

Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .324/.378/.632 (1.011 OPS) in his first 17 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in batting average (.361), wRC+ (174), OPS (1.051), slugging percentage (648), BABIP (.396) and ISO (.288).

Kevin Kelly: Kelly has not allowed a run in eight consecutive appearances, spanning 10.0 innings. Since August 13, the right-hander has a 0.52 WHIP and a .100 opponent's batting average

Xzavion Curry: Has a 1.44 ERA across his last five starts (4 ER, 25.0 IP) with 29 K against 4 BB.

TRAFFIC CHECK: Since August 1, the Captains' pitching staff owns the best WHIP (1.18) in the High-A Central League (secondbest in all of High-A).

BORN TO RUN: The Captains lead the High-A Central League in stolen bases (41) since August 1 (second in all of High-A)

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

LAST TIME OUT: Curry posted his third consecutive scoreless start, holding the South Bend Cubs without a run over 5.2 innings on Thursday at Four Winds Field. The right-hander struck out seven, walked two, hit one batter and scattered four hits. Curry left with the Captains leading, 4-0, but the Cubs came back to tie the score against the Lake County bullpen. Curry settled for a no-decision in an 8-5 Captains win.

SCORELESS STREAK: Curry has not given up a run in 17.1 innings. The right-hander has posted three straight scoreless starts, all of which have lasted five innings or longer. Since the streak began on August 13, Curry has struck out 24 batters and walked just two. He has a WHIP of 0.58 (8 H, 2 BB, 17.1 IP).

LONG BALL: Seven of Curry's 10 home runs allowed this year came in the month of July. He has only allowed one home run since July 28.

**HOME-ROAD:** Curry has posted a 1.22 ERA on the road, compared to a 4.00 ERA at Classic Park. Most of that difference can be attributed to the long ball. Eight of the nine homers Curry has allowed with Lake County have come at home. His other numbers are better at home where he has a 15.0 K/BB rate, compared to a 5.88 on the road.

AIRBORNE: Curry has the highest flyball percentage (52.4%) among Cleveland minor leaguers who have pitched 50+ innings.

RED HOT START: Curry made five starts for Low-A Lynchburg to begin the 2021 season. At the time of his promotion, Curry was leading the Low-A East League (LAE) in ERA (1.07), FIP (1.94), WHIP (0.63), K-BB% (36.2%), batting average against (.135) and BABIP (.220). He was second in K% (40.4%) and LOB% (83.3%).

**DURING 2020:** Spent part of quarantine living and training with 2018-19 Captains outfielder **Will Benson** in Atlanta. Curry and Benson have known each other since they were seven years old. The two were part of a group of Atlanta area professional and college ballplayers who trained and played pick-up games together after the Spring Training shutdown. The group included 2020 American League Rookie of the Year Kyle Lewis and his Mariners outfield teammate Taylor Trammell, as well as Atlanta's No. 14 prospect Trey Harris. The Atlanta training sessions began with a small group playing on a field behind a local church. As more players joined, they started playing full-fledged pick-up games and moved to LakePoint, where each player chipped in \$10 for field usage fees so the group could make use of the complex's eight major league-sized turf fields.

RAMBLIN' WRECK: Curry was Georgia Tech's Friday night starter each of his three seasons and became the first Yellow Jacket in the modern era (1973-present) to win three straight Opening Day starts. Since 2002, Curry ranks third at Georgia Tech in strikeouts looking (84) and fourth in total strikeouts (241). The right-hander was a Third-Team All-ACC selection as a junior in 2019.

SHOWING FLASHES: Curry recorded four double-digit strikeout performances in his junior season at Georgia Tech (2018). The right-hander struck out 11 at NC State, fanned 12 at home against Miami, struck out 12 again at home against Wake Forest and struck out 10 at home against Duke. His 12-K performance against Wake Forest was arguably the best start of his college career, in which Curry pitched a complete game, nine-inning, two-hit shutout. The following season, Curry had another marquee performance. Facing then-No. 4 Louisville on the road, Curry pitched eight innings and held the Cardinals to one run on one hit with nine strikeouts for the win. Curry retired 16 straight batters at one point.

**TWO WAY:** Curry registered six at-bats as a true freshman at Georgia Tech and went 3-for-6. He even started one game as a designated hitter. Prior to college, Curry was rated as the 27<sup>th</sup> ranked shortstop recruit in the country by **Perfect Game**.

HIGH SCHOOL: While at Mays High School in Atlanta, Curry was a 2016 *Perfect Game/Rawlings* Third-Team All-American and a 2016 *Perfect Game* Southeast All-Region First Team selection. Curry was also a 2015 *Perfect Game* underclass First-Team All-American and 2014 underclass high honorable mention All-American. Curry threw five no-hitters during his high school career and holds Mays school records for wins (32) and home runs (25). Mays was also the quarterback on the Mays High School football team for two years.
