LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were dealt another loss to open their season on Saturday afternoon when the Richmond Flying Squirrels staged a big ninth-inning rally to secure a 9-2 final. Making his Double-A debut, Brandon Young got the start for Bowie, and worked to the tune of 4.1 innings before being relieved. Young allowed only a solo home run to Michael Gigliotti. Each side would trade off the next three runs, with Bowie's Jordan Westburg delivering a line drive home run to left field in the eighth inning to tie the game at two. In the ninth, relievers Cameron Bishop and Shelton Perkins struggled to record outs, as the Squirrels hammered the pitchers for seven runs.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

While Richmond finished fourth in the tough Southwest Division standings, 2021 was one of the most successful seasons in recent history. With a win on the last day of the season, Richmond secured a winning record for only the fourth time in team history, and the first time since 2015. The Squirrels saw plenty of their success carried by their pitching staff, as they ranked third in the league in ERA, home runs allowed, and home runs allowed. As an organization, San Francisco follows the best season in their history, after capturing 107 wins in 2021. *MLB Pipeline* lists the Giants farm system as the 11th-best in the minors, but many of their headlining prospects are not slated to see Richmond on Opening Day. The Baysox will have plenty of time to see what prospects San Francisco has to offer, though, as Bowie and Richmond will square off 24 times in 2022.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Bryan Brickhouse will embark on his eighth season as pitcher after being signed by the Giants organization this past December. Brickhouse spent the 2021 campaign with Dodgers Double-A affiliate in the Texas League, and limited opponents to a 1.12 WHIP while collecting 51 strikeouts in 60 innings. Initially drafted by the Kansas City Royals out of The Woodlands High School in 2011 (The same school as Paul Goldschmidt and Jameson Taillon. Brickhouse was drafted only one year after Taillon.) multiple elbow surgeries led to a large gap in his playing career, as he did not appear in play between 2015 and 2017.

WELCOME WESTBURG

Infielder Jordan Westburg launched a solo home run in the eighth inning of last night's game for the first Baysox home run of the year. It's a faster start for Westburg, as he needed 12 games last season before hitting his first home run with Bowie. In those first 12 game with Bowie in 2021, Westburg only went 6-for-45 at the plate (.133), but has already collected three hits this season. Westburg was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at shortstop by MiLB.com for his 2021 season, as he finished second in the system with a .380 OBP and 74 runs scored, while his 79 RBIs, 121 hits, 27 doubles and five triples ranked third and his .479 slugging percentage and .868 OPS ranked fourth.

STILL LOOSENING UP

Bowie has started the season 0-2 for the second time in three years, and the fourth time in seven years. The last time Bowie opened their season against Richmond, they also dropped the first two games of the set. The four game series in 2015 was much closer than the current series in 2022 has been. With each side winning two games in the season-opening series, all four were decided by one run, with two of the games extending into the 14th inning at the Diamond. Bowie had an average start to that season as well, only going 11-9 in April, but finished the year 79-63, and won the Eastern League Championship.

GET IT OUT OF THE WAY EARLY

Bowie has taken the early lead in the Eastern League for most walks allowed in a game, as they gave Richmond 10 free passes yesterday, including five walks after the seventh inning. Bowie only recorded double-digit walks in a game twice in 2021, walking 10 against Reading on 5/15, and walking 13, the highest single game total in the league, against New Hampshire on 6/22. Currently, Bowie's 14 walks allowed is the second-most in the league, trailing Somerset's 16.

THE TOP STORY

For the first time, the Orioles have been selected as the best farm system in baseball by *MLB Pipeline*, including five players among the Top-100 Overall Prospects list. The publication cited how EVP Mike Elias, "revamped their Minor League operations, invested heavily in the Draft and began making splashes in the international market for the first time." during his current tenure to bring Baltimore on the cusp of contention again. In slight contrast to the top marks from *MLB Pipeline*, *Baseball America* has listed Baltimore as the fourth-best organization in baseball, trailing Seattle, Tampa Bay, and Pittsburgh. *Baseball America* lists a slightly lighter amount of depth in the Orioles system compared to its higher rankings, but still notes Baltimore as holding both the top pitching prospect in the game (Grayson Rodriguez) and the top overall prospect in the game. (Adley Rutschman) In 2017, prior to Mike Elias' tenure, *Baseball America* listed Baltimore as having the 27th-ranked organization in baseball.

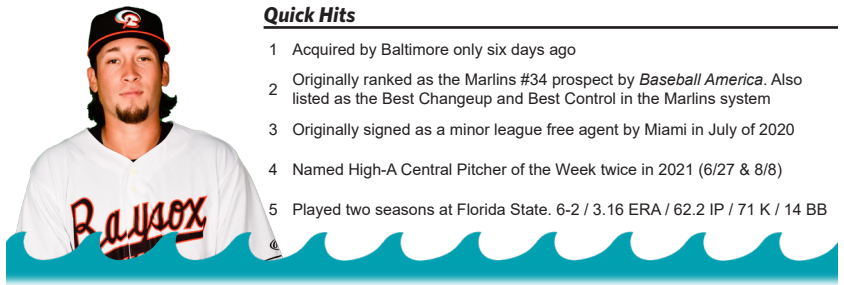

Coaching Staff

Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He spent three seasons as a player/coach (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds) before being named as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016 and the Keys hitting coach in 2017. Moore signed as a non-drafted free agent with the Orioles in 2010 after playing collegiately at the University of Alabama. He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
