Buffalo Bisons RHP Lazaro Estrada (2-5, 5.08) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Jose De Leon (0-3, 7.40)

Staycation – The Worcester Red Sox remain home for the second straight week/weekend as they continue their 12-game homestand tonight with the opener of a 6-game set against the Buffalo Bisons (AAA-Toronto) at 6:45 pm at Polar Park. Tonight's game can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. The WooSox began this homestand by taking 4 of 6 from the Lehigh Valley IronPigs last week/weekend to improve to 7-8-5 in their first 20 series this season...seven wins, eight losses, and five splits. Beginning with these 6-games vs. Buffalo, Worcester's remaining seven series of the season are all 6-game sets (4 at home and 3 on the road) as the Sox have 24 home games at Polar Park (including tonight) and 18 away games left this season.

This Series – This series features night games tonight & tomorrow at 6:45 pm, a Thursday matinee at 12:05 pm, a Friday night 6:45 pm affair, and weekend starts of 4:05 pm on Saturday and 1:05 pm on Sunday. From July 29 through August 24, the WooSox are playing 18 of 24 games at Polar Park (they are 4-2 thus far).

Payton's Place – LHP **Payton Tolle** (TOLE-ee), Boston's top pitching prospect according to MLB Pipeline (#3 overall for Red Sox and #92 in MiLB) and *Baseball America* (#49 overall in Minor League Baseball), will join the WooSox tomorrow following his promotion from Double-A Portland. The 6'6", 250 lbs. southpaw has been outstanding since joining the Sea Dogs on June 24 as he posted a 1-1 record with a 1.67 ERA in 6 games (5 starts) for Portland – 27 IP, 13 H, 8 R, 5 ER, 7 BB, 37 SO – holding opponents to a .144 batting average against. The 22-yr-old was Boston's 2nd round choice (#50 overall) in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft. He began this season with Greenville (high-A) going 1-3 with a 3.62 ERA in 11 games (10 starts) – 49.2 IP, 44 H, 20 R, 20 ER, 14 BB, 79 SO. Overall this season he has a 2.93 ERA with 116 SO in 76.2 IP. Tolle had an outstanding collegiate career...first as a two-way player at Wichita State University from 2022-23 and then at Texas Christian University as a pitcher only in 2024. During his sophomore year at Wichita St. he was a top five finalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award and during his junior year at TCU he was a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy given to the Best Amateur Player in the U.S. and the National Collegiate Player of the Year respectively. The Oklahoma native comes from an athletic family as his mother, Tina, was a standout golfer at Wichita State and his father, Chad, competed in track & field at Oklahoma State University.

Pats vs. Bills? – Buffalo is making their second visit to Worcester this week/weekend and this 6-game series marks the final meetings of the year between the clubs. The WooSox lead the high-scoring season-series, 7 games to 5. The Sox have averaged 6.5 runs per game (78 runs in 12 games) while the Bisons are averaging 6.9 runs/game (83 in the dozen games of the season series thus far).

Season Series vs. Buffalo – Worcester leads the season series, 7 games to 5 (going 4-2 here at Polar Park from June 17-22 to close out the first half). The Sox and Bisons split a 6-game series in Buffalo from May 13-18 during Worcester's only visit of the season to Western New York. WooSox wins have come by scores of 10-7, 8-4, 10-3 (in Buffalo) and 5-4, 9-4, 7-1, and 12-10 (at Polar Park). The Bisons victories have come by scores of 12-1, 6-5, 8-4 (in Buffalo), and 14-1 & 10-6 here in Worcester.

Stats vs. Bisons in 2025 – WooSox batters are hitting .271 (110-for-406) in the first 12 games vs. Buffalo this season with 19 HR and 78 runs scored while Sox pitchers are 7-5 despite a 6.86 ERA (80 ER in 105 IP) allowing 18 HR and 83 runs to the Bisons.

We do our Best Work During the Week - Worcester has winning records during each of the four weeknights they play games – going 11-4 on Tuesdays, 10-8 on Wednesdays, 9-8 on Thursdays, and 11-9 on Fridays. They are 10-10 on Sunday, but their only losing record comes on Saturdays when they are 4-13 this season.

What Have You Done for Me Lately – Worcester has won 4 of 6, 8 of 12 and they are 12-10 since July 6.

Home is Where the Heart is – The Sox have won 18 of their last 28 games at home since May 23. Overall the WooSox are 28-22 at Polar Park after reaching a season-high 8-games over .500 at home three different times this season (on June 20 & 22 and July 2). Worcester won a club-record 8 straight at home from May 25 – June 18.

Above Board – At 55-52 on the year, the Sox are over the .500 mark after being exactly .500 for a total of 17 different times this season...1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, 21-21, 24-24, 25-25, 26-26, 27-27, 28-28, 47-47, and 48-48.

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 14-19 to start the 2nd half (final 75 games of the year), but they are 28-24 overall since June 1. Worcester finished the first half of the season with a 41-33 good for 4th-place in the International League East (7th overall in the 20-team IL) and 5½-games back of first half champ Jacksonville.

Series Matters – Worcester is 7-8-5 in their first 20 series played this season...seven wins, eight losses, and five splits. Their remaining seven series of the season (including this one) are all 6-game sets (4 at home and 3 on the road) as the Sox have 24 home games at Polar Park (including tonight) and 18 away games left this season.

Road Repair – Worcester has won 4 of their last 6 road games after losing 10 of their previous 15 on the road between June 24 – July 13. The WooSox are 27-30 on the road after dipping to a season-high of 6-games below .500 on the road on July 5 & 12.

Sox Standouts

-INF **Kristian Campbell** has a 13-game hitting streak – the longest on the WooSox this season - (19-for-48, .396) with 2 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 7 BB, and 13 runs scored.

-INF/OF **Nate Eaton** has hit in 13 of his last 16 games (18-for-58, .310) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, and 11 runs scored.

-OF **Jhostynxon Garcia** was named International League Player of the Week for the week of July 28 – August 3. Played in 6 games during the week and batted .417 (10-for-24) with 4 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI, and 8 runs scored. Also has homered in three straight games (G2 on Friday, Saturday & Sunday). Has also hit in 15 of his last 17 games (24-for-69, .348) with 5 2B, 5 HR, 18 RBI and 17 runs scored.

-INF **Vaughn Grissom** has hit in 14 of his last 18 games (22-for-69, .319) with 3 2B, 6 HR, 17 RBI, and 16 runs scored. In his last 25 games he is batting .340 (32-for-94) with 7 doubles, 7 HR, 21 RBI, and 22 runs scored. He is tied for 7th in the International League in hits (99), tied for 9th in doubles (24), 3rd in the league in runs scored (68), and 10th in total bases (162).

-1B **Nathan Hickey** has hit in 13 of his last 15 games (17-for-53, .321) with 4 2B, 1 HR & 8 RBI.

-OF **Trayce Thompson** is 13-for-46 in his last 13 games (.282) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, and 8 runs scored.

-C **Seby Zavala** has hit in 3 of his last 4 games (6-for-13) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 1 RBI, 2 runs scored.

-LHP **Jovani Moran** has allowed 1 ER in his last 8.2 innings with 12 strikeouts in his last 5 relief appearances.

Home Show – This current 12-game homestand is the second longest in terms of games for the WooSox this season. The WooSox went 6-7 on a 13-game homestand this past April 22 – May 4 that included a 7-game series vs. Syracuse thanks to a make-up doubleheader (Sox went 3-4) and then a 6-game set vs. Toledo (Sox went 3-3). Worcester has played eight extended homestands of 12 games or more - featuring two series each - during their first four and a half years of existence. They have had four winners and four losers during their “long” homestands in WooSox history. This week and next week marks number nine.

Buffalo Bites – The Bisons won the season-series over Worcester by a 15-9 count last year including an 8-5 mark at Sahlen Field in Buffalo along with a 7-4 record at Polar Park in Worcester. The 15 losses were the most the WooSox suffered to any opponent last season. Ironically the year before, Worcester went 15-8 vs. the Bisons (including a 10-2 mark at Polar Park compared to 5-6 in Buffalo) as those 15 victories were their most over any IL foe in 2023.

Weather Getting Better and not Wetter – The WooSox had two home rainouts and one road rainout in July while going 10-13. Worcester finished 15-10 in June with no postponements. The Sox went 13-14 in the month of May (with one home postponement) after going 1-1 in March (with one home postponement) and 13-13 in April (with two home postponements & one home cancellation along with one road postponement).

Goodbye to July – Ironically, the WooSox began the month of July with a home rainout on July 1 vs. Syracuse and they ended July yesterday with another home rainout on July 31 vs. Lehigh Valley. Worcester finished 10-13 in July. Sox batters hit .264 (199-for-753) with 29 HR while Sox pitchers were 10-13 with a 5.44 ERA (115 ER in 190.1 IP) and 38 HRA in July. The Sox were out-scored by their opponents, 124-122 during the month.

Tough Finish to a Winning June – Worcester posted a winning June with their 15-10 record that began with their 9-game winning streak from June 1-11 and was 14-5 prior to the start of the 2nd half (1-5 to end the month). The WooSox out-scored their opponents, 140-124 in June while batting .240 with solid production including 49 doubles, 7 triples, 34 HR and 140 runs scored. WooSox pitchers were 15-10 with a 4.72 ERA in June with 23 HRA & 124 runs allowed.

Other Month to Month - WooSox hitters batted .246 in May with 29 HR & 114 runs scored while Sox pitchers were 13-14 with a 4.84 ERA during the month with 32 HRA and 132 runs allowed. Worcester hit .273 in April with 25 HR & 145 runs scored and WooSox pitchers were 13-13 in April with a 4.74 ERA along with 26 HRA and 128 runs given up.

Highs and Lows – Worcester has been a season-high of 8-games over .500 on three different occasions (last on June 22 at 41-33). Those are their best marks since finishing last year with a 79-71 record. The WooSox have been at the .500 mark 17 different times this season...1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, 21-21, 24-24, 25-25, 26-26, 27-27, 28-28, 47-47, and 48-48. The Sox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11.

Ups and Downs – Worcester's stretch of winning 14 of 18 from June 1-22 was one of their best of the season along with an April 13-24 stretch when they won 10 of 11 games. Their worst stretches have come recently (lost 15 of 21 from June 24 – July 20) and from April 25 – May 11 when they lost 11 of 15 games.

Doing One Better – The WooSox are 13-13 in 1-run games on the year and 5-4 in extra innings.

Home Run Derby – Worcester has maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 66 of their total 127 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted (61) solo HR, (42) 2-run homers, (16) 3-run blasts & (8) grand slams.

Streaks Appeal – The WooSox enjoyed a season-high and Worcester club-record 9-game winning streak June 1-11. They fell two wins shy of matching the longest winning streak for a Red Sox Triple-A affiliate in 55+ years...since the Pawtucket Red Sox won 11 straight in 2014. The WooSox have also had two 5-game winning streaks (from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24). Worcester had a season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30.

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored and also led the IL with 786 walks. Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359. Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795.

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league. Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (15-16)/(49-49) open a 6-game series at Harrisburg tonight.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Boston Red Sox on Saturday reinstated reliever **Zack Kelly** from his injury rehab assignment with Worcester and then optioned him to Worcester. Kelly has been added to the active WooSox roster today. The WooSox on Monday released RHP **Wyatt Mills** to make additional room on their roster for LHP **Brennan Bernardino** and RHP **Cooper Criswell**. Bernardino was optioned from Boston on Friday when the Red Sox added newly-acquired LHP Steven Matz to their roster. Criswell was optioned from Boston on Saturday when the Red Sox added newly-acquired RHP Dustin May.

Bernardino, 33, has pitched in 47 games (one start) for Boston this season, posting a 3.09 ERA (15 ER/43.2 IP) with 36 strikeouts. He was working on a 13-inning scoreless streak at the time of his option to Worcester. Originally selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 26th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft, the California native owns a 3.47 ERA (57 ER/147.2 IP) in 161 career Major League games (10 starts) with the Seattle Mariners (2022) and Red Sox (2023-25).

Criswell, 29, started Friday night against the Houston Astros and allowed one run over 7.0 innings in Boston's 2-1 walk-off victory. The right-hander has pitched in seven games (one start) this season for Boston, going 1-0 with one save and a 3.57 ERA (7 ER/17.2 IP) while also posting a 3.32 ERA (22 ER/59.2 IP) in 14 games (13 starts) for Worcester. Originally selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 13th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, the Georgia native owns a 4.48 ERA (77 ER/154.2 IP) in 45 career Major League games (21 starts) with the Angels (2021), Tampa Bay Rays (2022-23), and Red Sox (2024-25).

Worcester has made 105 player moves since June 1 (including 49 in June & 44 in July).

The WooSox have used 68 different players already this season (37 pitchers and 31 position players). Reliever Brennan Bernardino (just down from Boston) will soon add to that total when he makes his 2025 WooSox debut. At the trade deadline last year (July 31, 2024), the WooSox had employed 64 different players (36 pitchers and 28 position players) on their way to a Red Sox Triple-A record 84 players used during the 2024 season. They are ahead of that pace this season with 68 employed thus far.

Since the start of the season the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock (twice), C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, INF Nick Sogard (three times), RHP Luis Guerrero (three times), RHP Cooper Criswell (six times), INF Abraham Toro, RHP Nick Burdi (twice), INF Marcelo Mayer, RHP Zack Kelly (twice), INF/OF Nate Eaton (twice), RHP Brian Van Belle, OF Roman Anthony, RHP Richard Fitts (twice), RHP Isaiah Campbell, and INF David Hamilton to Boston. Stock, Sogard, Eaton, Isaiah Campbell, and Fitts are all back with Worcester. The Red Sox have also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito, C Connor Wong, INF/OF Romy Gonzalez, OF Willyer Abreu, LHP Chris Murphy, RHP Jordan Hicks, and RHP Tanner Houck directly from Worcester this season.
