### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay Rays affiliate) gear up for the start of a six-game series on Tuesday. Round Rock is coming off a 10-3 loss to Oklahoma City on Sunday. LHP Blake Snell made a rehab start for Oklahoma City on Sunday at Dell Diamond. Round Rock jumped ahead early on a two-run homer from LF Michael Helman in the first. The Comets got one back in the second, then broke it open with a seven-run sixth highlighted by RF Jack Suwinski's two-run shot and a trio of RBI singles. The Express added a run in the eighth on Helman's third RBI, but Oklahoma City tacked on two more in the ninth to seal a 10-3 win and take the series finale.

### ABOUT LAST WEEK

The Express dropped five of six against the Comets last week at Dell Diamond and have lost four consecutive games for the first time since March 28-April 3... are now 3-9 against Oklahoma City this season and 0-9-2 in six-game sets vs the Comets since the start of the 2023 season ...are tied for a season-high 7 games below .500 (4-11 on April 21; 5-12 on April 15)...the 13-20 start is the third worst through 33 games in club history and the worst since 2018 (12-21).

### RUNAWAY BRIDE

INF Jonah Bride has hits in 8 of his last 10. Bride is 8th in the PCL in OBP (.432) and T-9th in RBI (23). He is 1 of 23 qualified players in the PCL hitting over .300 (.303). He leads all of Triple-A in batting average with two strikes (.314/22-70). The PCL average batting average with two strikes this year is .179... he is 2nd in the PCL in pitches per plate appearances (4.54).

### WALK IT OUT

Round Rock's 13.8% walk rate is the second-highest in the PCL and fourth in Triple-A. Saturday's 13 walks are tied for the second-most in a game in the Express Triple-A era (2005-2026). They walked 10+ times in a game only three times all of last season and have done it four times this year.

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE

LHP Thomas Ireland owns a 1.86 ERA (2 ER/9.2 IP) with four walks to 13 strikeouts after 3.1 innings of one-run baseball with two hits, no walks and six strikeouts on Saturday... among 42 pitchers age 24 or younger with at least 7.0 Triple-A innings this season, Ireland (23 years, 310 days) has the fifth-lowest ERA—and the lowest in the Pacific Coast League (18 qualifiers). His fastball has a 40.0% whiff rate which is 4th among PCL pitchers (min. 100 pitches).

### LOOKING FOR THE LONG BALL

Round Rock is 30th in Triple-A in home runs (22) and 29th in slugging percentage (.350). They have three extra-base hits in the last three games and have hit four home runs in their last 11. They are averaging 4.5 runs per game.

### HERE COMES HELMAN

LF Michael Helman (3-for-4, HR, 3 RBI, R) tallied Round Rock's only multi-hit game Sunday with a home run and two singles...drove in all 3 of the E-Train's runs...3 hits are a season-high...also his 4th multi-hit game this year.

### THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, MAY 5, 1972

The Milwaukee Brewers had no answer for Nolan Ryan, who tossed a complete-game shutout for his second in four starts since joining the California Angels. He allowed just three hits, walked five and struck out 14. The outing came after Ryan failed to get out of the third inning in each of his previous two starts. Angels manager Del Harder said after that outing, "We'll decide in the next few days if Nolan will stay in the starting rotation. We can't keep him there if he's going to walk five or six every time." While the walks remained, Ryan overpowered Milwaukee. He admitted after the game that he dialed back his velocity. According to the Associated Press, pitching coach Tom Morgan spoke with Ryan the night before: "I just told him he'd have to sacrifice velocity for control."

The Angels provided early support against Ken Brett. Leo Cardenas tripled home Sandy Alomar in the second and later scored on a wild pitch, while Ken Berry and Vada Pinson added sacrifice flies in the third. At 25, Ryan understood the stakes. "I've decided this is the pivotal year. If I don't get into the regular rotation and win, I'm going to consider retiring. I don't want to be an in-and-out pitcher. I'm thinking of going into the real estate business back home."
