Tonight the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, play the second in a six-game series; Great Lakes won the opener yesterday and is 1-0 in the 24-game season series and 169-166 against the Lugnuts all-time.

Last Night: Loons 4, Lugnuts 0. In exactly 120 minutes, the quickest nine-inning game of the year, Zach Root (7 IP), Robby Porco (8th) and Dilan Figueredo (9th) tossed a combined two-hit shutout, with Root striking out nine in his finest professional outing. Great Lakes only managed three hits itself, but Eduardo Quintero doubled in two and Chuck Davalan and Emil Morales supplied sacrifice flies for the more-than-adequate offensive support..

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Loons play one another at 7:05 p.m. each of the next three nights before wrapping up the series with a Sunday matinee. The Nuts then return to Michigan's state capital for a six-game homestand against the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

The Next Big League Nut: Yesterday, the A's promoted right-hander **Kade Morris** (2024 Lugnut) to the Major Leagues with the intention of either using him out of the bullpen or starting him tomorrow at Chicago. When Morris makes his debut, he will become the 205th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the fifth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**).

Gage This: Speaking of the Jump Man, the 2025 Lugnuts Opening Day starter dazzled in his second MLB start with seven innings of one-run ball last night at Wrigley Field, walking one and striking out five, to help the A's tip the Cubs 2-1 in two hours and 19 minutes. 2022 Lugnuts lefty **Hogan Harris** recorded the final out of the game, while fellow former Lugs **Colby Thomas**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Henry Bolte** appeared in the field/at the plate. The A's 18-14 road record is third best in the A.L. behind only Cleveland (18-13) and New York (19-14).

Depth Perception: **Steven Echavarria** worked six innings in the losing cause last night, the 13th time this season that a Lugnuts starter has pitched at least six innings in a game (Echavarria 3, **Nathan Dettmer** 3, **Tzu-Chen Sha** 2, **Zane Taylor** 2, **Samuel Dutton** 2, **Jackson Finley** 1), including a combined 42 2/3 innings in the last seven games. For Great Lakes in comparison, Zach Root's seven-inning outing was the fourth time that a Great Lakes starter has gone at least six innings. Last year, Nuts pitchers posted 29 outings of six innings or more.

The Amazing Otto: 2019 Lugnut and current Miami Marlin **Otto López** leads the Major Leagues with a .335 batting average and 80 base hits. López's manager is 2008-2009 Lugnuts skipper **Clayton McCullough**.

- **Zane Taylor** is 4th in innings (44 2/3) and 4th in ERA (3.22).

Roll Call: Lansing has used 38 different players this season, including 21 pitchers (excluding position player pitching **Gunner Gouldsmith's** scoreless inning) and 17 position players. Only **Devin Taylor** has taken part in all 52 games, a mark that leads all of High-A.

Speaking of Devin Taylor: The Indiana Hoosier leads the Midwest League with six outfield assists and leads all of Minor League Baseball in seeing pitches outside the zone than **Devin Taylor** (457 in 231 PAs, an average of 1.98 balls per plate appearance). Taylor has received 1015 pitches overall, leading all of Single-A, High-A and Double-A.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 64 double plays (in 52 games), which leads Minor League Baseball (2nd - El Paso Chihuahuas, 60 in 58 games) and Major League Baseball (1st - SF Giants, 62 in 61 games).

JUNE 3 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2006: The Lugnuts won a 17-inning marathon for the second time in 2006, pulling out a 5-3 victory at the South Bend Silver Hawks. The score was tied at 2-2 through seven innings, with both teams scoring a run in the 15th. Nuts manager Ken Joyce was ejected in the 11th and center fielder Luke Hetherington was ejected in the 17th. The game took four hours and 36 minutes to complete, decided by a two-out, two-run triple from Jacob Butler.

2017: 9-year-old Bo Bichette went 4-for-5 with two singles, a double and a triple, to raise his batting average to .390 in a 7-3 loss at West Michigan.

In a Nutshell: In first full season in pro ball after getting drafted last year in the 10th round, War Eagle... debuted in relief on Opening Day (4 IP, 9 H, 6 R, took loss in 8-7 defeat to Dayton)... enjoys fishing... wears Oakleys during the game in order to see the signs from his catcher; does not wear glasses otherwise in life.

Looking for Relief: Two starts ago, allowed one unearned run in 5 2/3 innings at Lake County, departing in line for the win, but Lugnuts blew a 3-1 lead by allowing one in the 8th and two in the 9th in 4-3 walkoff loss... in last start, tossed seven scoreless innings against West Michigan, departing with 4-0 lead, but pen allowed two in the 8th and two in the 9th before losing in 12 innings, 6-5.

Stats Dive: After posting 6.65 ERA in April (17 R/16 ER in 21 2/3 IP), impressed with a 1.14 ERA in May (4 R/3 ER in 23 2/3 IP)... has a 1.33 ERA / 1.03 WHIP / .173 OBA on the road compared to 5.76 / 1.88 / .369 at home.

Before College: Batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI as a senior at Westbrook Christian High School, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K... Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American... pitched for 2019 USA Baseball 16U National Team Development Program.

College: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.

Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 as the 290th pick in 2025, the fifth pick of the 10th round... one of seven Tigers drafted, led by Orioles first-rounder Ike Irish... made pro debut on August 21, 2025, vs. Lake Elsinore with one hitless innings, one walk, two strikeouts... after two scoreless relief appearances, finished the year with three short starts, fanning five in 1 2/3 innings vs. Visalia on September 7 in final appearance... right-handers were 3-for-17 (.176) with eight strikeouts, lefties went 4-for-12 (.333) with five strikeouts.
