QUEENS OF THE CASTLE: The Cyclones made it two victories in a row in Friday's 2-0 shutout victory over the Dash. LHP **Keyshawn Askew** made his Brooklyn debut, striking out six over 4 1/3 innings with just three hits allowed and no walks. Brooklyn OF **Stanley Consuegra** tripled in the second inning against Winston-Salem starter RHP **Karan Patel** before INF **Jose Peroza** ripped an RBI double. Following Askew's start, RHP **David Griffin** chipped in 3 2/3 innings and RHP **Dylan Hall** fired a scoreless ninth in the triumph.

SOME GIRL FROM LONG ISLAND: Tonight marks *Seinfeld Night* at Maimonides Park: "The Night About Nothing." The first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Marble Rye figurine, while "The Wiz" and "Dolores" bobblehead packages are available, Angela Dohrmann who played Donna Chang in the episode "The Chinese Woman" will be today's celebrity guest.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn's run differential in the second half stands ahead of first-place Hudson Valley at +21 into Friday. The Cyclones have allowed just 120 runs over 34 games (3.5 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

PEROZA: REAL & SPECTACULAR: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .879 over his past 20 games. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 18 of the past 20 games, hitting .306 with a .393 OBP.

"GIDDYUP" GADDIS: Since June 21, Mets 2019 draftee C/INF **Nic Gaddis** has been on base in 28 of his past 33 games, posting a .399 OBP and a .809 OPS. For his career, Gaddis has a .360 OBP and a .738 OPS.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox affiliate comes to Maimonides Park for the first matchup in history. The Dash host White Sox No. 1 prospect SS Colson Montgomery, No. 8 INF Bryan Ramos, and No. 10 RHP Matthew Thompson. In total, the Dash is home to seven of Chicago's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Winston-Salem ranks seventh with a .741 OPS and eighth with a 4.70ERA among the 12-team South Atlantic League.

JUST THE TREES, JOHNNY: With Tuesday's trade between the Mets and San Francisco Giants, Brooklyn LHP **Nick Zwack** and RHP **Carson Seymour** were sent west along with INF **J.D. Davis** and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** for Giants 1B/OF **Darin Ruf**. The Cyclones have received Double-A RHP **David Griffin** and Low-A LHP **Keyshawn Askew** as reinforcements to the arms.

"GA-GA" FOR RA-RA RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** leads all Mets minor league players with 106 hits. With St. Lucie, Ramirez posted a .802 OPS through 67 games. In just 23 games at High-A, Ramirez has a .875 OPS. The 19-year-old Dominican is two years younger than league average.

PRETTY BIG MATZO BALL: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 54 home runs in the past 65 games (0.8 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

SPONGEWORTHY: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects. OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

LAST TIME OUT: Junior responded in a big way against Hudson Valley, tossing five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts on Sunday after lasting just two outs into Tuesday's start earlier in the week.

HIGH-RANKING MEMBER: Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

BREAKOUT: The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

VALUED MEMBER: Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

WEIRD START: Santos struggled in his first start of 2022, lasting just two innings in game one of a doubleheader and 5-1 loss to the Wilmington Blue Rocks on April 9. Santos' clunky start may have been affected by Friday night's postponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and "wet grounds."

OPENING DAY STARTER: Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
