#### Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs on Wednesday night. It is the 14th-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and eighth-of-12 in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Portland last season 11-9, with a 5-3 record at home, and 6-6 on the road. The teams play next at Portland from July 19-21. Portland currently leads the season-series 10-3.

#### First Game Defeat

A season-high seven pitchers threw for Reading, as the Fightin Phils fell 9-5 on Tuesday night to Portland. Eury Ramos was the stand out of the bunch with two-scoreless frames. Phillies' pitchers Michael Rucker and Luis Ortiz both appeared in the game on their rehab assignments. Carlos De La Cruz had two hits, including two home runs, and Robert Moore had two hits, which featured a double. Cade Fergus also hit his first Double-A home run in the loss.

#### Carlos De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz continued to stay red-hot on Tuesday night. He had his second two-homer game of the season, along with matching season highs with two runs and three RBI. De La Cruz has been on a roll in June, as he is slashing .364/.475/.818, with a 1.293 OPS in nine games this month. He's added nine runs, three doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI. In June, his .364 average ranks eighth in the Eastern League (minimum 20 at bats). He also ranks tied for first with four home runs, third with 10 RBI, third with nine runs and fourth with a 1.293 OPS this month. It was the sixth multi-homer game of the season for Reading.

#### **Bombs Away**

The Fightin Phils have been hitting home runs at a much-higher clip as of late. After hitting three home runs last night, Reading has now homered in seven-straight games, dating back to June 4. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are now tied for second in the Eastern League with 57 home runs hit this season. In June, Reading has hit 15 home runs, which ranks second in the league, behind only Erie, who has 16 this month.

#### Nice To Meet You

Reading has welcomed a trio of players to Baseballtown over the last few days, all of which played most of the season with High-A Jersey Shore previously. Cade Fergus joined the Fightin Phils last Saturday, while Otto Kemp and Andrick Nava were each called up on Tuesday. Fergus hit his first Double-A home run on Tuesday night, and also scored two runs. Kemp walked twice and scored a run in his Double-A debut on Tuesday night.

#### Into the Wishing Well

Lachlan Wells makes his first start since nealry being perfect over six innings against Harrisburg on June 6. In that start, Wells went six hits, allowed one hit and one run, with five strikeouts. His lone blemish a solo home run from CJ Stubbs in the sixth inning. Wells retired the first 16 hitters he faced and 18-of-19 Senators's batters overall. It marked Wells' first winning-decision since Apr. 10 against Portland. The last Reading pitcher to carry a perfect game pat five innings was Tyler Phillips, who retired 15-stragiht to start the game against New Hampshire on May 10, 2023. Wells' 5.1 no-hit innings were also the most no-hit innings since Phillips went six no-hit innings on June 14, 2023, against Hartford. This season against Portland, Wells is 1-0, with a 0.82 ERA over two starts.

#### Shutout Streak Snapped

After allowing three runs in the top of the third on Tuesday night, Reading pitching's shutout streak was snapped at 13 innings, the longest mark of the season.

#### Sea Dogs Synopsis

Portland enters tonight in first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison with a 32-26 record. Portland most recently split a series at home against the Akron RubberDucks. Following this week, Portland returns home and welcomes Richmond to Hadlock Field. Portland's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Luis Pereles (9), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbs (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

#### **Portland Pitcher**

Righty Hunter Dobbins makes the start tonight for Portland. This will be Dobbins' 10th start this season, and e is 3-1, with a 4.34 ERA (45.2 IP, 43 H, 21 BB, 43 SO). Dobbins last pitched June 6 against Akron in a no-decision. He allowed four runs on seven hits, with eight strikeouts, over six innings. Dobbins has pitched against Reading twice this season (4/13 and 5/3), combining to go 1-0 over nine innings (7 H, 2 ER, 5 BB, 9 SO). Dobbins split 2023 between High-A Greenville and Portland, combining to go 9-6, with a 3.67 ERA over 20 games and 19 starts. Dobbins pitched against Reading once last season on June 23, allowing one run over five innings. The Red Sox drafted Dobbins in the eighth round in 2021 out of Texas Tech and he be-gan his pro career in 2022.
