#### Serving Up Today's Showdown

Reading begins a six-game series in Hartford tonight. The team's each have nine wins in the season series. Tonight will feature the Reading Hot Dogs and the Hartford Steamed Cheesburgers in an epic food showdown. Reading won last year's battle in Reading 6-3 on Aug. 7, 2022.

#### Firing Up A New Grill

The Hot Dogs will look for a fresh start in Hartford after a 1-5 week against Binghamton. Reading fell 4-3 Sunday, but the bullpen was spectacular. The Hot Dogs bullpen threw 4.2 shutout innings, allowing just three hits and has nine strikeouts. Reading pitching in total had 15 punchouts. Cam Cannon and Jhailyn Ortiz each homered in the defeat, while Ethan Wilson had a double and run scored.

#### A Thousand Hot Dogs Would be A Lot, But A Thousand Wins is a Milestone

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just seven wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (39).

#### Cannon is Cookin'

Cam Cannon had a red-hot week against Binghamton. Overall, he hit .353 with four home runs last week. Cannon entered the week with just one home run, then hit two Tuesday, and one-each Thursday and Sunday. Tuesday was the first multi-homer game of his career.

Overall, Reading went 10-13 in July, but from July 4-22, the Hot Dogs had a 9-4 record, which featured series wins over first place Somerset and second-place Portland. Reading's pitching was stellar in the month, posting a 2.91 ERA, which ranked first in the Eastern League. The Hot Dogs' bullpen also led the Eastern League with a 2.93 ERA. The bats for Reading were more quiet in the month, hittng just .214.

#### Who are the Hot Dogs?

Reading introduced their Hot Dogs alter-ego in the summer of 2020, to begin play in 2021. It pays homage to famous Berks Hot Dogs and of course the famous Crazy Hot Dog Vendor. Reading also sells the most hot dogs in Minor League Baseball. Now, Reading typically wears its Hot Dogs uniforms on Sunday and holds a 3-7 record in the uniforms in 2023, after going 5-6 in them in 2022.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies defeated the Marlins 4-2 thanks to a two-run double from Johan Rojas and big game from Alec Bohm. Lehigh Valley is set to begin a series at home against Buffalo tonight. Jersey Shore is back home to begin a six-game set with the Brooklyn Cyclones. Finally, 65-30 Clearwater returns to BayCare Ballpark to open a series with Lakeland.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

August 1, 1995: At New Haven, the Reading Phillies and New Haven Ravens do battle for the final time in the 1995 regular season, with the Phils scoring two in the 9th to pull out a 5-3 win. The next time the teams would meet would be in the best-of-five EL Championship Series.

#### What's a Steamed Cheesburger?

Hartford, playing tonight as the Steamed Cheesburgers, enter tonight with a 12-13 second-half record, and are 41-51 overall in 2023. Last week, the Steamed Cheeseburgers took three-of five from New Hampshire. Next week, Hartford heads north for a series ar Portland. A "Steamed Cheeseburger," also known as a "steamer" or "cheeseburg," is a burger cooked via steaming and was originally served by restaurants in Central Connecticut. It was invented at Jack's Lunch in Middletown, CT, in either the 1920's or 30's. Hartford began playing as the Steamed Cheeseburgers for a game in 2018. Ted's Restaruant served Steamed Cheeseburgers at the game and are the most-know Steamed Cheeseburger establishment.

#### Flipping Patties and Throwing Baseballs

Nick Garcia may not be a fry cook, but he will get the start tonight for the Steamed Cheesburgers. It's his fourth start against Reading and he is 0-1 with a 6.98 ERA (19.1 IP, 25 H, 6 BB, 15 SO). Overall in 2023, Garcia is 2-8 with a 6.92 ERA (78 IP, 95 H, 32 BB, 72 SO). Garcia last pitched, July 23 against Somerset, earning a loss, while allowing four-earned runs on eight hits in 3.1 innings of work. Garcia spent 2021-22 in the Pirates system (high-A Greensboro in '22 and single-A Bradenton in '21). He was traded from the Pirates to Rockies last December for 3B Connor Joe. Garcia was drafted in the third-round in 2020 out of Chapman in California. It is not known whether Garcia enjoys steamed cheesburgers.

Has been on-and-off Development List in 2023. Best start of season on May 28 against Harrisburg, where he threw five-shutout innings en route to Reading's only shutout of opponent this season. Allowed season-high four home runs on June 11 vs Binghamton. Since returning from triple-A, has thrown five innings in three-of-four starts. Last time out, he allowed no-hits and just one-run against Binghamton, but did struggle with command, issueing a season-high five walks in no-decision.
